The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did

The affiant witnessed the defendant in actual, physical control of a motor vehicle on North 56th Street northbound in the turn lane to turn West onto Fowler Avenue. The defendant was asleep at the wheel with his foot on the brake and his vehicle on, and in drive. From the open windows, the affiant could smell the strong apparent odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the interior of the vehicle. The affiant placed the vehicle in park, removed the keys and shut the door. None of these actions aroused the defendant. The affiant was able to wake the defendant up by opening the driver door and verbally announcing his presence. As the defendant spoke, the affiant smelled the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his expelled breath. The affiant also witnessed bloodshot, watery and glassy eyes on the defendant. As the defendant spoke, he slurred his speech and fumbled with his wallet. The defendant consented to Field Sobriety Exercises. The affiant fully demonstrated and verbally explained each exercise before asking the defendant to complete them. At the conclusion of the exercises, the affiant witnessed clue of impairment on each exercise which led him to believe the defendant was operating a motor vehicle in this State while under the influence of Alcohol. An inventory of the vehicle resulted in an open container of a self made alcoholic beverage. Through his training and experience, the affiant recognized the odor of the beverage to be apparent Vodka. The defendant was placed under arrest and transported to Central Breath Test, where he consented to a lawful sample of his breath. The results were 0.203 and 0.207, respectively. The affiant collected the defendant's driver license, issued a DUI Citation and completed the booking process.
