was observed by **KATHRYN DEITER** who told **OFC. M. OWEN 331** that he/she saw the arrested person commit the below acts.

was found to have committed the below acts, resulting from my (described) investigation.

On the **18** day of **September**, **2021** at **17:15** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On Saturday, September 18, 2021, Northcom Dispatch received a call from a male identifying as Jason Morley. Mr. Morley stated to the call taker a crash with no injuries occurred in the parking lot of Carlin Park East, located at 400 S A1A Jupiter, FL. There was no other information provided. When I arrived to the scene, directly in front of the Lazy Loggerhead Café, I observed a white Ford 4-Door vehicle still stopped in the travel lanes with a crowd standing around it. Near it was a silver Chevy utility vehicle properly parked facing west bound in the parking lot. I began speaking with the parties, which did not include the caller, Jason Morley, or the female he was with identified later as Lauren Woodard (WF 4/3/1983). I was advised they left the scene and walked towards the Civic Center where a birthday party was happening. I was advised by the driver, WF Kathryn Barbara Deiter (9/7/2003) of the white Ford, bearing FL tag DFFC06 the following:

She was backing her vehicle, which was facing east bound, from her parking space and began hearing a lot of yelling and observed an unknown to her white male banging on the back of her vehicle while screaming at her. She stopped her rear movement while the male continued this action. The male was described as wearing a white button down shirt and grey shorts and was with a female wearing a white romper style outfit. It should be known, when Mr. Morley and Ms. Woodard were located they were wearing the clothes previously described. While this male, later positively identified as Morley continued his actions, Deiter stated she was scared of him. Her front seat passenger, WF Ava McRae Saunders (7/20/2006) advised the male was acting violently during this altercation. Ms. Deiter later told me that the male was claiming she struck them with her car, but claims she never felt her vehicle strike a person or vehicle (FL tag IVAQ29). At the end of this altercation, prior to the male and female leaving the area, Deiter's vehicle sustained damage to the driver side of the vehicle, the passenger side of the vehicle and the driver side mirror had been kicked off and remained hanging to the car by wires.



Two independent witnesses to the altercation remained at the scene to speak with officers. The witnesses BF Lisa C. Garner (5/11/1973) and WM David Michael Garner (9/22/1974) advised the following:
While walking in the parking lot, near the scene, they observed a white male (Morley) began screaming and the white Ford and banging his fists on it. They advised the male was being violent with the vehicle and with his language and observed as the female (Woodard) was attempting to pull the male away from the vehicle. They stated they saw the entire incident and at no time observed the white Ford strike Morley, Woodard or the silver Chevy SUV owned by Morley. Mr. and Mrs. Garner advised they saw Morley break the driver side mirror during the altercation.

Of everyone we spoke with, the only people who claimed the vehicle driven by Deiter struck anybody or anything was Mr. Morley and Ms. Woodard, but they both refused to make a report of the accident after being asked numerous times if they wished to.

I then walked to the Civic Center with Ofc. Stan to see if we could locate Mr. Morley. Based on his Driver's License photo attached to his vehicle registration and the physical description provided by the victim and witnesses, we located Mr. Morley standing near the bar within the Civic Center drinking from a blue canned beverage, which he later stated was Bud Light. I approached Mr. Morley and requested to speak with him outside. Ms. Woodard followed. When we were away from all the other attendees at the party, I explained to Mr. Morley who I was and why I was speaking with him. Prior to any questioning, I read Mr. Morley his Miranda Warnings which he stated he understood. When I completed, he told me he did not want to speak with me without a lawyer present. I had him take a seat at that point. While he was seated, he initiated conversation about the incident and we began to speak. I asked him about the reason he called the police and he began to tell me that his friend, Woodard, was struck by the white Ford. I asked him why he did not stay at the scene to complete a report and his said they did not want a report. This was later stated by Woodard that she did not want to report it either. During our conversation, Mr. Morley stated at times that they were almost hit, then stated they were both struck. He then elaborated that he became upset at this and was yelling at the driver. He continued his statements and eventually admitted to striking her vehicle with his fist. It should be known that on his right hand there is a minor scratch on his knuckles. He declined needing any medical attention when asked. Ofc Stan brought Ms. Deiter to the scene for a show up and she positively identified Mr. Morley as the male who caused the damage to her vehicle. She also identified Ms. Woodard as the female who was with Mr. Morley during the incident. After speaking with Mr. Morley and his admission to striking the vehicle, I placed him into custody with my department issued handcuffs, which were double locked and checked for proper spacing. While speaking with Mr. Morley, I could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitted from his body and breath. His eyes appeared glossy and bloodshot, although he did not appear to be overly intoxicated. The odor grew

stronger while we was detained in the back of my patrol vehicle.

I later spoke with another witness, WF Michelle Suzanne De Maria (6/11/1976), who was standing at her vehicle, approximately 100 yards north of the altercation. She stated he could clearly hear the white male (Morley) yelling towards the vehicle and driver and could clearly see his aggressive actions of destruction directed at the vehicle. She stated she could not clearly see his face, but his actions were clear to her.

The white Ford driven by Deiter sustained heavy body damage, estimated at \$4,000.00 in total damage. The damage was seen all around the vehicle and was captured by body worn camera and photos.

Based on my interview with Mr. Morley and the statements from the victim, witnesses and the observations of the vehicle, I believe I had Probable Cause to arrest and charge Mr. Morley with Criminal Mischief because he did willfully and maliciously injure or damage, or place graffiti thereon, or commit an act of vandalism to the vehicle in possession and control of Ms. Deiter and is the registered property of her mother WF Georgina Capote Oliver (12/5/1966) causing damage in an amount of \$1,000.00 dollars or greater contrary to Florida Statute 806.13(1)(a)(b)3 (3 DEG FEL).

Furthermore, based on the observed actions by Mr. Morley by the victim and witness, I believe there is probable cause to charge Mr. Morley with Disorderly Conduct because he did commit such acts as are of a nature to corrupt the public morals or outrage the sense of public decency, or affect the peace and quiet of persons who may witness them, or engaged in brawling or fighting, or engaged in conduct constituting a breach of the peace or disorderly conduct, contrary to Florida Statute 877.03. (2 DEG MISD).

Mr. Morley was transported to the Jupiter Police Department while paperwork was completed. All statements from the victim, witness and offender were captured on body worn cameras. Photos were taken at the scene by Ofc. Stan and submitted to evidence. Ofc. Stan completed a supplemental narrative of her involvement as well. Mr. Morley was later transported to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident.
