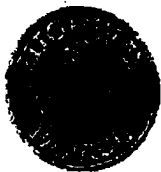

On 8/22/2021 I Trooper Masterson was dispatched to assist West Palm Beach Police Department (WPBPD) with a traffic stop southbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) south of State Road 80 (Southern Boulevard) on the right shoulder.

at approximately 5:38AM . I arrived on scene at approximately 5:48AM. Officer Beesley (02220) informed me he was traveling southbound on Interstate 95 in his marked patrol vehicle north of State Road 80. Officer Beesley stated he observed a white dodge charger driving in a reckless manner. Officer Beesley observed the white charger to change lanes improperly, fail to maintain a single lane, fail to use proper turn signals, and drive at a high rate of speed that caused the motoring public to take maneuvering actions to avoid an accident. Due to the multiple traffic infractions, Officer Beesley activated his emergency lights and conducted a traffic stop on the white charger. Officer Beesley informed me that upon contact with the driver he saw no other occupants in the vehicle and identified the driver by his Florida driver license (S-520-430-90-350-0) as JASPREET, JASON SINGH, SANGHA. Officer Beesley informed me that during conversation with Mr. Sangha he smelled an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage omitting from Mr. Sangha breath. Mr. Sangha was watched by Officer Beesley and another WPBPD officer before my arrival on scene to ensure he did not consume any substances during the traffic stop.

In front of the WPBPD patrol vehicles I observed a white dodge charger barring a FL tag of NLHR51. I approached the vehicle on the passenger side and observed the driver to be the only occupant in the vehicle. I introduced myself to the driver and asked if he was okay. Mr. Sangha stated he was fine. I asked Mr. Sangha if he knew why he was stopped. Mr. Sangha stated for cutting people off on the highway. I asked Mr. Sangha where he was going. Mr. Sangha stated he was going home from work. Mr. Sangha informed me that he worked at a Yacht club in West Palm Beach. I immediately could smell an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage omitting from Mr. Sangha breath while he was in the vehicle. I asked Mr. Sangha if he drank any alcoholic beverages prior to being stopped. Mr. Sangha state he had 2 Heinekens beer. I noticed Mr. Sangha had red and glossy eyes during the traffic stop. Mr. Sangha spoke with a slurred and slow cadence. Mr. Sangha had a lethargic and care free attitude toward the situation.

I informed Mr. Sangha that I was conducting a DUI investigation due to the indicators that I was observing. I asked Mr. Sangha to exit the vehicle to better observe him. Mr. Sangha stepped out of the car and stood at the rear of his

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vehicle. Mr. Sangha stood with an orbital sway and used his trunk for balance. Mr. Sangha still spoke with slow speech. I could still smell a distinct odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage omitting from Mr. Sangha breath. I asked Mr. Sangha if he would like to participate in voluntary Field Sobriety Exercises (SFST). Mr. Sangha asked what would happen if he refused to do the exercises. I informed Mr. Sangha that I would have to base my arrest off the indicators I observed during the traffic stop. I informed Mr. Sangha that the exercise are provided to assist in observing sobriety levels. Mr. Sangha agreed to do SFST. I asked Mr. Sangha if he was willing to be transported in my vehicle to a safe and more fair location to administer the SFST. I explained to Mr. Sangha that the shoulder we were currently on was at a decline and it is not safe on the highway with vehicles passing by the traffic stop. Mr. Sangha entered my vehicle willingly. I transported Mr. Sangha to the strip mall on State Road 882 (Forrest hill Blvd) just west of Interstate 95. I asked Mr. Sangha if he found the parking lot and parking line to be fair. Mr. Sangha stated it was fine and fair. The parking lot and line was illuminated by my patrol car lights and the parking lots natural lighting. Mr. Sangha state he could see the line fine. I asked Mr. Sangha medically based questions to determine if he had any conditions that would affect his ability to perform the exercises. I asked Mr. Sangha if he suffered from diabetes, strokes, seizures, recent crash, or injures. Mr. Sangha said no. I asked Mr. Sangha if he had any balance issues. Mr. Sangha stated no. I asked Mr. Sangha if he felt ill or in pain. Mr. Sangha stated no. I asked Mr. Sangha if he had been to the doctors recently or surgery. Mr. Sangha stated no. I asked Mr. Sangha if he felt healthy. Mr. Sangha stated yes. I asked Mr. Sangha if he thought he would be able to do the exercises. Mr. Sangha said yes. I asked Mr. Sangha if he needed contacts or glasses. Mr. Sangha said no.

The first exercise was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. Mr. Sangha was placed in the starting position of standing up straight with feet together and arms by his side. I instructed Mr. Sangha to keep his head and body still during the entirety of the first exercise. I explained to Mr. Sangha that I would move my pen from side to side and for him to move his eyes only. I asked Mr. Sangha if he understood the instructions. Mr. Sangha stated that he understood. Mr. Sangha had a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained

Nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Vertical Gaze Nystagmus was not tested. Mr. Sangha moved his head multiple times. Mr. Sangha anticipated the pens movement repetitively. Mr. Sangha swayed heavily in an orbital manner.

The second exercise was the Walk and Turn. I instructed and demonstrated Mr. Sangha to place his left foot on the parking line followed by his right foot in front of his left foot touching heel to toe. I explained and demonstrated to Mr. Sangha that his arms are to stay by his side and not to raise at any point during this exercise. I instructed and demonstrated Mr. Sangha to stay in that position (the starting position) while I give the rest of the instruction to the test. I specifically instructed Mr. Sangha to not begin the exercise until told to do so. I explained and demonstrated to Mr. Sangha, when I tell him to begin that his first step will be with his left foot. I instructed and demonstrated to Mr. Sangha that he will take nine heels to toe steps and to count out loud what number step he was on while looking at his step. I instructed and demonstrated the turn portion of the exercise that comes after the ninth step. I explained to Mr. Sangha the turn will consist of him keeping his lead foot on the ground and pivoting off it with a series of small steps using his other foot. I asked Mr. Sangha if he understood the instructions throughout giving the instructions. Mr. Sangha stated he did understand the instructions. Mr. Sangha failed to stay in the ready position during the period of instruction. Mr. Sangha did not walk heel to toe. Mr. Sangha stepped off the line. Mr. Sangha preformed an improper turn. Mr. Sangha stopped during the exercise. Mr. Sangha used his arms for balance.

The third exercise was the One Leg Stand. I instructed and demonstrated Mr. Sangha to stand with feet together and arms by his side; the same as the first exercise. I specifically informed Mr. Sangha to not begin the exercise until told to do so. I explained and demonstrated to Mr. Sangha that he will pick up any leg of choice and raise it above the ground approximately six inches and to look at his foot until told to place his foot back on the ground. I instructed Mr. Sangha to count out loud the seconds that pass by while his foot is raised above the ground. I informed Mr. Sangha to not place his foot on the ground unless he felt they were

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going to fall. I asked Mr. Sangha if he understood the instructions throughout giving the instructions. Mr. Sangha stated he understood. Mr. Sangha swayed. Mr. Sangha put his foot down. Mr. Sangha bent his knee to put his foot perpendicular with the ground. Mr. Sangha used his arms for balance.

I placed Mr. Sangha under arrest for DUI 316.193 at 6:22AM. Mr. Sangha stated he understood he was under arrest. Mr. Sangha was searched and placed in the back of my patrol vehicle. Mr. Sangha was transported to the BAT facility. Mr. Sangha underwent a 20 minute. I requested a breath sample from Mr. Sangha. Mr. Sangha initially refused. I read Mr. Sangha Implied consent. Mr. Sangha then agreed to give a breath sample. Mr. Sangha gave two valid breath samples of .227 and .227. Mr. Sangha was Mirandized on camera in the BAT facility after providing breath samples. I asked Mr. Sangha if he wanted to answer the interview questions. Mr. Sangha stated no. I walked Mr. Sangha to the PBSO jail. I released custody of Mr. Sangha to PBSO corrections. There were no further incidents with Mr. Sangha. All above events occurred in Palm Beach County. All video was recorded on in car camera FHP1388.

WPBD Officer Beesley issued the traffic stop citation for failure to use turn signal properly (316.155). I Trooper Masterson Issued the DUI citation 316.193.



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I, Officer M. Beesley # 2220 do hereby voluntarily make the following statement without threat, coercion, offer of benefit, or favor by any persons whomsoever.

On Sunday, August 22, 2021, at approximately 0531 hours, I was in my marked "West Palm Beach Police" vehicle traveling south bound on Interstate 95, when I observed a white Dodge Charger, bearing Florida license plate of "NLHR51" traveling southbound as well.

The Dodge Charger was unable to maintain a single lane and continuously changed lanes without using the appropriate turn signal. The vehicle was obstructing the flow of traffic and cut off other vehicles that had the right of way.

At this point in time, I conducted a traffic stop by activating my emergency lights and sirens. The Dodge Charger pulled over to the right shoulder. I approached the vehicle from the passenger side window and introduced myself and informed the driver the reason for the stop. The driver was identified by his Florida Drivers license as, w/m Jaspreet Sangha (09/30/1990). I asked Sangha for his driver's license, insurance, and vehicle registration.

Sangha provided me with only his driver's license. When I asked for the additional documentation Sangha provided me with an "eTags" receipt which is not the registration. I then had to remind Sangha to provide me with his insurance, which he eventually complied.

Sangha's movements were slow and delayed to my requests. At this point in time, I suspected Sangha to be under the influence of an unknown alcoholic beverage.

FHP was requested in order to conduct a DUI investigation. Once FHP arrived the scene was turned over to them.
