On the 24 day of March, 2020 at 06:27 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 03/24/2020 at approximately 0030 hours I responded to 2150 N. Ocean Blvd in reference to a burglary. The caller stated that he observed someone on the second balcony that he believes does not live there.

Upon arrival I met with W/F Elda Bustos who lives in apartment 2S. Bustos stated that while she was sleeping, she heard someone on her patio. She then looked out onto her patio and observed a male wearing all black run on her patio towards the beach. Bustos stated that once the subject ran off, she went back to bed. A few minutes later, Bustos heard someone again but, on the patio, right above her. Bustos then walked out of her apartment and observed a white male running on the patio right above her. Bustos then ran into her apartment out of fear. Once inside of her apartment, Bustos observed out of her patio window a white male jump from the above patio onto hers. Bustos described the male as a young white male, with no shirt on, possibly holding a gray shirt in his hand. The white male also was holding what appeared to be a box of miscellaneous items in his hand.

While speaking with Bustos, two BRPD officers stated that they observed one male walking down A1A matching the description of the suspect and he was about 300 feet north from the scene. The officers stated that they observed a white male wearing a gray t-shirt, a black zip up jacket, pants and tennis shoes (later identified as Zachary Charlton). While speaking with the W/M, another W/M walked out from the beach through the shrubs and approached officers. The W/M that walked out from the beach knew the subject the officers were talking too. The second W/M was wearing a t-shirt, shorts and adidas sandals with three white stripes on them (later identified as Jed Schneiderman).

It should be noted that the officers made contact with both subjects near a 2016 gray Honda Accord bearing Florida tag # Z55CLV that was parked in the grass on the roadside. The vehicle is registered to Jedd Schneiderman out of Boca Raton.

I then went to meet with the two W/M suspects. Upon arrival I met with W/M Zachary Charlton and W/M Jed Schneiderman, both identified by their FL DL. Prior to my arrival, both Charlton and Schneiderman were read their constitutional warnings from a pre-printed BRPD card by Officer Jalil. Both subjects advised they understood their rights and wished to speak with me.

I first spoke with Charlton. Charlton stated that he was currently homeless and sleeps out of his vehicle. Charlton stated his vehicle was currently parked on A1A north of our location in Delray Beach. Charlton stated that he is currently dating Schneiderman and that they drove out to Boca Raton to walk the beach. Upon further questioning, Charlton advised they drove to Boca Raton to walk the beach for new scenery. Charlton confirmed that the Honda Accord parked on the side of the road was Schneiderman's. Charlton also stated that while walking the beach with Schneiderman they lost each other while he was about to use the bathroom.

I then met with Schneiderman. Schneiderman stated that him and his friend, Charlton, decided to come to Boca Raton to walk the beach. When I asked Schneiderman where Charlton parked his vehicle, Schneiderman stated that he parked it south on A1A. When I originally talked to Charlton, he advised he parked his vehicle north on A1A. Schneiderman advised that he picked up Charlton and they drove out to Boca Raton to walk the beach. Schneiderman advised that while on the beach he heard Charlton yelling for him, because they lost each other. Once again, when I asked Schneiderman why he and Charlton were on the beach this late, he could not provide an answer.

While speaking with both subjects, a victim that lived in 3S stated that he had video footage of two subjects inside of his apartment with a flashlight at 2239 hours. The victim was able to send screen shots of the subjects to officers on scene. In the picture, I observed a male wearing a black hat, a black zip up jacket with the hood up, and black pants. I also observed a second male with shorts on wearing adidas slides with three white stripes on them. The description in the picture matched the description of Charlton and Schneiderman.

After reviewing the pictures that clearly identified both Charlton and Schneiderman, I placed both subjects under arrest for burglary.

It should be noted, that once Schneiderman was placed under arrest he was cooperative with police and walked officers around the area to collect evidence around the property. While Schneiderman was walking around with officers, he admitted to officers that he and Charlton jumped on someone's roof who lived off A1A in Boca Raton attempting to break in earlier in the evening, see report #2020-003935. Schneiderman also located his phone in a sea grass area that also had other items that were taken from apartment 3S.

While collecting evidence, one white latex glove was collected from a bush that was

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located to the south side of the building. In the same area, multiple stolen items were collected that were confirmed stolen out of apartment 3S. Search incident to arrest, Charlton possessed a white latex glove that was found in his pocket, which matched the glove that was found with the stolen items.

Based on my investigation, I placed Charlton and Schneiderman under arrest for burglary to an occupied dwelling per F.S.S 810.02(1), burglary to residence possessing a firearm therein per F.S.S. 810.02(2B), and possession of burglary tools per F.S.S. 810.06 after they attempted to break into victim Bustos apartment (2S) and gained entry by an unlocked slider to the second victim, David Flinn, apartment (3S) and stealing multiple items including a firearm. Schneiderman was charged with burglary to an occupied dwelling per F.S.S 810.02(1), and burglary to residence possessing a firearm therein per F.S.S. 810.02(2B).

Detective Alvarez arrived on scene to interview the suspects. Charlton admitted to her that he was in the area with Schneiderman walking the beaches. Charlton did not have a reason to be in the City of Boca Raton. Charlton stated that Schneiderman drove them to this location. Charlton was adamant that Schneiderman stayed in the vehicle, but then changed his statement stating the Schneiderman came looking for him because their phones died. Charlton advised that any evidence that could be incriminating to him was never in the possession of Schneiderman.

Upon Detective Alvarez speaking to Schneiderman, he admitted that Charlton told him to drive with him north to go to the beach and "mess around". Schneiderman advised that he believed Charlton meant to go swimming or take a surf board that they would find on the beach out into the water.

Schneiderman advised that when they arrived at 2150 N Ocean Blvd and parked off the road in the grass, they walked behind what he believed was a hotel. Schneiderman admitted to climbing onto the balconies with Charlton and watching as Charlton entered into one of the rooms. Schneiderman advised Charlton exited the residence with what appeared to be a medium sized possibly tan handbag containing unknown items. Schneiderman denied knowing any of the contents taken from the residence, including the firearm taken. Schneiderman advised they both jumped down from the balcony at which time he lost sight of Charlton and began running along the beach. Schneiderman stated that he fell into the bushes which was where he dropped his cell phone. It should be noted that the stolen items from the apartment mentioned above were also found with his cell phone in the bushes. Schneiderman advised that he ran out to the street looking for Charlton, at which time he found him speaking with a police officer by his vehicle.
