


P R O B A B L E C A U S E S T A T E M E N T	<p>said he put the gun down and was now in his room laying down. I asked Janet Boyd to place the gun in her room and lock the door, to which she did. Janet Boyd returned to the patio where she could see her son laying in his bed. I spoke with Janet Boyd while her son laid in bed. She told me that Jeffrey Boyd had been Baker Acted in the past and had his firearms confiscated but he was released and was given his firearms back. Janet Boyd stated that she was not overly familiar with firearms but believed that he had at least four or five (4 or 5) firearms in the house. She had told him in the past that she did not want to have any weapons in the house, so he hid them from her which is why she did not know how many there were in the home.</p> <p>Jeffrey Boyd returned to the patio and began arguing with his mother because she was still on the phone with me. J. Boyd asked his mother why she was still talking to me and when she replied that I requested that she stay on the line with me so that I could be sure that she was safe, he told her that he did not want to hurt her he only wanted to blow his brains out. The two spoke for a short time with Janet Boyd telling her son that he needed to get help with his depression. He acknowledged that he needed help and stated that he was waiting to talk to Cristy Boyd (his sister). I advised Janet Boyd that her daughter, Cristy Boyd would not be allowed to enter the area due to the status of the situation.</p> <p>At approximately 1632 hours, while I was speaking with Janet Boyd, I heard a gunshot in the background. Janet Boyd screamed "ouch" what are you doing? I immediately asked Janet Boyd what happened. She stated that her son shot off a round while in the patio. Janet Boyd told me that the gun was pointed away from everyone and that nobody was injured. Janet Boyd took the gun away from Jeffrey Boyd and scolded him for the irresponsible behavior. Jeffrey Boyd returned to his room to lay down. I convinced Janet Boyd to exit the residence and meet the SWAT officers waiting outside. Janet Boyd exited the home, met the officers, and was taken to the command post.</p> <p>Shortly after Janet Boyd arrived at the command center, Cristy Boyd was escorted to the command post as well. It was determined that a phone call would be placed to Jeffery Boyd by Cristy Boyd and he would be asked to exit the residence. Jeffery Boyd finally answered his phone to speak with his sister who managed to get him to exit. Jeffrey Boyd was taken into custody without further incident. J. Boyd was transported to the Palm Beach Gardens Medical center for a medical evaluation and clearance then brought to the Palm Beach Gardens Police Department for processing.</p> <p>Officer A. Wood, Officer Z. Zimandy and Officer M. McCray returned to the residence to collect the firearms and any additional evidence as well as to determine where the discharged round went and if anyone was injured by the bullet. It was determined that the bullet was shot through the patio screen and did not strike anyone.</p> <p>Officer Wood interviewed Janet Boyd who confirmed that Jeffrey Boyd discharged a firearm while she was on the telephone with me. Officer Wood was shown and documented the point of impact of the bullet and the location of the spent shell. Officer Wood collected the casing and took pictures of the scene. See Officer Wood's supplement for further details.</p> <p>Officer McCray spoke with a neighbor, Barbara Armstrong who resides at 11101 Myrtle Oak</p>

Officer McCray assisted in collecting additional weapons and firearms were also collected and placed into evidence. Jeffrey Boyd did discharge a firearm while in an occupied residence This was done in the home while occupied by Janet Boyd</p> <p>The defendant will be charged with shooting a deadly missile in violation of F.S.S. 790.19. Jeffrey Boyd was processed at the Palm Beach Gardens Police Department after he was medically cleared then transported to the Palm Beach County Jail for booking.</p>
