NARRATIVE:

On June 30, 2020 at approximately 0830 hours, members of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Interdiction Unit were conducting parcel interdiction at the FedEx ground sorting facility located at 1145 Barnett Drive, Lake Worth, Florida 33461.

While there, Agents [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] located a suspicious parcel sent from a Jeffrey Codell with an address of 1200 S Brand Blvd., unit # 11, Glendale, California 91204 and a phone number of (818) 240-2448. The recipient was listed as Edgar Chavez with an address of 119 Two Pine Dr., Greenacres, Florida 33413 with a phone number of (323) 394-3706.

The parcel was heavily taped with clear packing tape. Your Affiant knows from training and experience that this is a common practice used by drug shippers in an attempt to conceal any odor coming from the parcel and avoid detection by law enforcement. The computer generated label had a tracking number of 3943 4470 8823, was shipped on June 29th, 2020 and listed the parcel weight as 45.69 lbs.

Agent [REDACTED] placed the parcel among other parcels of similar size, shape and color. Agent [REDACTED] brought in his trained/certified narcotic detecting canine partner [REDACTED] into the facility and conducted a free air sniff of the parcels. Agent [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED] sniff all the parcels and when he sniffed the suspected parcel [REDACTED] placed his nose on the seams of the parcels and took a deep respiratory breath. [REDACTED] immediately came to final response indicating he detected one or more of the odors he is trained/certified to detect.

NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

Due to this FedEx management was made aware that agents were seizing the parcel. Without asking, agents were advised by FedEx management that he would be opening the parcel in accordance with FedEx policy, procedures and shipping agreements to verify its contents.

Once the parcel was opened, agents noticed a second box heavily taped with clear packing tape. Upon opening the second box, FedEx management and PBSO agents located two large clear bags containing THC edibles. Total package weigh for both bags were 42.40 lbs. Within both bags agents observed numerous individually packaged bags of edibles, marked THC. This amount of illegal contraband is consistent with possession with intent to sell and from your Affiant's training and experience your Affiant knows it is not typical for a first time buyer to purchase this large of quantity of illegal narcotics.

Later that morning, your Affiant completed a residential search warrant for 119 Two Pine Dr., Greenacres, Florida (hereinafter referred to as the target residence). Said warrant was signed by the Honorable Judge Maxine Cheesman of the 15th Judicial Circuit In and For Palm Beach County, Florida.

At approximately 1333 hours, Agent [REDACTED] acting in an undercover capacity delivered the parcel to the front door of the target residence. With the assistance of video surveillance and members of the PBSO Interdiction Unit, units conducted surveillance in and around the target residence.

At approximately 1334 hours, via video surveillance, agents were able to monitor the front of the residence as a female later identified as Julia Jacobsen exited the residence, picked up a separate parcel and appeared to look at the suspect parcel law enforcement delivered. Julia Jacobsen returned inside the residence without touching the suspect parcel. At approximately 1358 hours, a white male later identified as James Jacobsen exited the residence, retrieved the suspect parcel and returned inside the target residence.

Approximately thirty minutes later, your affiant and members of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office knocked on the front door of the target residence and executed the lawful search warrant. Upon knocking on the front door, the following individuals exited the residence, Julia Jacobsen, Paul Jacobsen, Jillian Jacobsen, James Jacobsen and Zoltan Zelenak.

While searching the interior of the residence agents located the suspect parcel, open, adjacent to the front door on the floor. As previously noted, the suspect parcel contained approximately 42 pounds of THC edibles individually wrapped.



NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

While checking an upstairs bedroom identified as Jillian's room (Jillian Jacobsen), agents located the following items:

- Ten grams of marijuana in a plastic bag on a shelf next to bed (total package weight). NIK positive.
- Within a false book/safe located in top dresser drawer, sixty-two (62) Alprazolam pills contained in multiple mini zip lock baggies.
- In a designer purse located on the back of bedroom door, a clear plastic bag containing one gram of cocaine HCL, a white pill bottle containing three (3) amphetamine pills and two (2) partial Alprazolam pills.
- In a table drawer, a clear plastic bag containing .1 gram of Cocaine HCL.

Post Miranda, Jillian Jacobsen informed agents all of the items located inside her room was hers. Jacobsen further advised the items were at least two years old as she has been clean for two years.

Based on the totality of the investigation and the evidence seized, your Affiant feels probable cause exists to charge the defendant Jillian Jacobsen with Possession of Cocaine pursuant to FSS 893.13 (6)(a), Possession of a Schedule IV Substance Without a Prescription pursuant to FSS 893.13 (6)(a), Possession of a Schedule II Substance Without a Prescription pursuant to FSS 893.13 (6)(a) and Possession of Marijuana Under 20 grams pursuant to FSS 893.13 (6)(b).
