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On 01/11/2020, at approximately 0235 hours, at Providence Rd / Causeway BI, Brandon, FL 33511, I observed a 2014 gray Buick Lacrosse FL tag: AEQC45 / VIN: 1G4GB5G38EF170290) in the middle southbound lanes of Providence Rd, facing northbound. I observed the vehicle to have disabling damage based on the driver's side front wheel axle and rotor behind destroyed, to include two shredded tires. I observed the driver (registered owner) to be the only person around the vehicle. The vehicle was running and the driver continuously entered the driver's side to gather his belongings, to include his cell phone and wallet. Deputy Ferguson #241762 arrived on scene and conducted the traffic crash investigation (see HCSO case #20-26496 and DHSN V traffic crash report #89133978-01). I observed the driver on many occasions, almost fall while standing still. I observed him to have a severe odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath, slurred speech, bloodshot watery eyes, and he was leaning while standing still, so much so that he almost fell multiple times. Based on the indicators of impairment observed. I advised the driver that the traffic crash investigation had concluded, and that I was a DUI investigator, now conducting a criminal investigation. I explained my observations to the driver, field sobriety exercises were conducted, further impairment was observed, and the defendant was subsequently arrested for DUI. While at CBT, the defendant provided two breath samples, yielding results of .178 / .176 BAC (after a twenty-minute observation period).
