The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did
 On 01/11/2020, at approximately 0235 hours, at Providence Rd / Causeway Bl, Brandon, FL 33511, I observed a 2014 gray Buick Lacrosse FL tag: AEQC45 / VIN: 1G4GB5G38EF170290) in the middle southbound lanes of Providence Rd, facing northbound. I observed the vehicle to have disabling damage based on the driver's side front wheel axle and rotor behind destroyed, to include two shredded tires. I observed the driver (registered owner) to be the only person around the vehicle. The vehicle was running and the driver continuously entered the driver's side to gather his belongings, to include his cell phone and wallet. Deputy Ferguson #241762 arrived on scene and conducted the traffic crash investigation (see HCSO case #20-26496 and DHSMV traffic crash report #89133978-01). I observed the driver on many occasions, almost fall while standing still. I observed him to have a severe odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath, slurred speech, bloodshot watery eyes, and he was leaning while standing still, so much so that he almost fell multiple times. Based on the indicators of impairment observed, I advised the driver that the traffic crash investigation had concluded, and that I was a DUI investigator, now conducting a criminal investigation. I explained my observations to the driver, field sobriety exercises were conducted, further impairment was observed, and the defendant was subsequently arrested for DUI. While at CBT, the defendant provided two breath samples, yielding results of .178 / .176 BAC (after a twenty-minute observation period). The defendant was positively identified via his Florida driver's license.

Pursuant to Florida Statute §92.525 and under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing document and the facts stated in it are true to the best of my knowledge. For Notices to Appear, I also certify that a complete list of witnesses and evidence known to me is attached.
