The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did: On Saturday August 29, 2020, I, Officer Malachi Wilkins of the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission was on state water patrol in Hillsborough County, Florida. At approximately 1815 hours I observed a camouflage vessel operating in Seddon Channel with the defendant in complete physical control of the vessel. I activated the emergency lights on my marked patrol vessel and stopped the defendant's boat in order to conduct a vessel safety inspection. The defendant's vessel did not have a valid safety inspection decal affixed to it. I identified who I was and the reason for the stop. During the vessel safety inspection, I observed the defendants eyes to be glassy and bloodshot and he also had the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person. At the conclusion of the safety inspection I asked the defendant if he would consent to perform Seated Field Sobriety Tasks (SFSTs) and he stated that he would do so. During the SFSTs I continued to smell the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person. The defendant performed poorly during the SFSTs and I placed him under arrest. Implied Consent was read to him and he stated that he would provide a sample of his breath. The defendant was transported to Hillsborough County Jail and after a 20 minute observation he provided samples of 0.171 and 0.172.
