Garcia was seated in the front driver's seat and the keys to the ignition were in the vehicle. I asked Garcia if she lived in Addison Reserve, and she said no. I asked Garcia why she had tried to get into the community, and she said she was trying to get back to see her girls. I asked Garcia if she could provide her driver's license to me. At that time, Garcia began to look into her pocket book that was in her purse. After over five minutes of Garcia looking in her pocket book and me repeatedly asking her to produce her driver's license, she was still unable to so. I asked Garcia what her address was as to where she lived. Garcia had a difficult time telling me her address as I asked her to spell the street name and city. It should be noted as Garcia spoke, I smelled the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath. Also, Garcia's speech was slurred and thick tongued almost to the point of me not being able to understand her. I also noticed Garcia's eyes to be blood shot and glassy.</p> <p>Based on my observations, I requested a DUI Unit respond to my location in order to conduct a DUI investigation. A short time later, D/S W. Amadon ID # 9440 responded to my location. Upon D/S Amadon's arrival, I informed him of what I was told by Tallman and my observations of Garcia.</p> <p>I conducted a sworn audio/recorded interview with Addison Reserve Security Officer/Paramedic John Dabady. Dabady informed me that he observed Garcia driving the aforementioned red Nissan, and she was attempting to drive under one of the gate's entrance/exit arms. Dabady stated he spoke to Garcia and told her to put the vehicle in park. Dabady stated Garcia was the only occupant and driver of the vehicle.</p> <p>The DUI investigation was turned over to D/S Amadon. PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: Actual physical control (physical evidence or statements putting def. behind wheel of vehicle)

On Friday July 9, 2021 at approximately 2125 hours I was dispatched to the hundred block of 7160 Addison Reserve Blvd in Unincorporated Delray Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida regarding a minor vehicle crash with a possible impaired driver. Upon arrival I met with D/S J. Coppola #36858 who provided me with a supplemental probable cause affidavit stating: "On 07-09-2021 at approximately 9:11 PM, I responded to 7160 Addison Reserve Blvd., in Delray Beach, Florida, unincorporated Palm Beach County in reference to a crash involving a possible drunk driver. Upon my arrival, I met with Robert Tallman who was the on duty Supervisor for Addison Reserve Security. Tallman informed me that a female who was driving a red SUV had driven into one of the gate arm sensors which caused it to break. Tallman estimated the gate arm sensor cost \$1,000 to replace. While speaking to Tallman, I observed a red Nissan SUV bearing Florida tag number HMKK98 parked facing North at one of the entrance/exit gates of Addison Reserve. I made contact with the female and sole occupant of the vehicle. The female was positively identified as Josie Garcia through her Florida driver's license photograph. Garcia was seated in the front driver's seat and the keys to the ignition were in the vehicle. I asked Garcia if she lived in Addison Reserve, and she said no. I asked Garcia why she had tried to get into the community, and she said she was trying to get back to see her girls. I asked Garcia if she could provide her driver's license to me. It should be noted as Garcia spoke, I smelled the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath. Also, Garcia's speech was slurred and thick tongued almost to the point of me not being able to understand her. I also noticed Garcia's eyes to be blood shot and glassy."

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon arrival I observed the defendant to be occupying the front driver seat of the vehicle registered to her. I approached the defendant to speak to her. I introduced myself and asked if she knew why Deputies were there. Her speech was slurred and her hair was disheveled and in her face. I immediately detected the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath that intensified when she spoke. I asked her to exit her vehicle and come speak to me further at my patrol car. The defendant exited her vehicle and was very unsteady on her feet. I asked her again to walk to my car since she stopped moving after exiting her car. She informed me she had to urinate. I asked if the Security Guard Gatehouse had a bathroom. Security opened the door and a female deputy stood by while the defendant relieved herself. She exited the door of the guard gate and stopped walking again. I told her to walk to my car. She looked at me with a distant gaze and said I am. As we passed her vehicle the defendant attempted to open her driver side door. I placed my hand in the middle of her back to guide her away from the car and told her again that I needed her to come to my vehicle. The defendant raised both her hands to her chest and tensed up while turning away and saying no. Fearing that she would try to enter the vehicle again and because of her pulling away, I placed her into handcuffs which I checked for proper fit and double locked. I removed a black purse that she was wearing and placed it on the roof of her vehicle. I escorted her to the front of my car and informed her that the crash investigation was complete. I read the defendant Miranda and informed her I was now conducting a criminal investigation. I told the defendant I would be removing her handcuffs but she could not pull away again. She said she understood and appeared calm. I removed the handcuffs and began asking pre roadside questions. I asked if she was willing to perform roadside. She hesitated in her response. I gave her Taylor Warnings. The defendant informed me she was Type 2 diabetic. I contacted Palm Beach County Fire Rescue and they responded and advised her blood glucose was 97. (Run Number 21-07604654). The defendant was unsteady on her feet. She could not walk straight and stumbled into parked cars and the open guard gate door. The defendant had a noticeable orbital away as she stood. The defendant's clothing was neat and properly worn. The defendant leaned on my vehicle after being told to do so. The defendant's eyes were red, glassy, bloodshot, and watery. The defendant's speech was slow, slurred, and labored with a noticeable accent.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

The defendant kept saying "really", "look at me", "I'm a mother"

ODORS:

I immediately detected the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the defendants breath, which intensified when the defendant spoke.

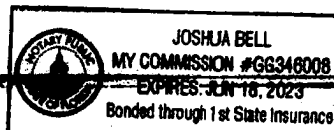

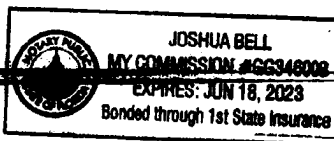

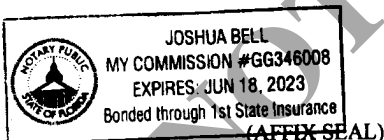
