## PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I responded to the 2500 block of Gateway Blvd in reference to a Traffic Stop conducted by Officer Drury. This incident occurred within the City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida.

Upon arrival I made contact with Officer Drury who stated the following: "On Monday, March 9, 2022, at approximately 2353 hours I was patrolling the area of 500 North Congress Avenue, Boynton Beach, FL 33426 when I witnessed a black Lexus SUV, bearing FL tag KVAS54, failing to maintain its lane. The vehicle was travelling northbound in the left lane. I observed the Lexus cross over the dotted white line into the middle lane and then come back into the left lane multiple times. I then paced the vehicle using my calibrated BBPD patrol vehicle (4741) and paced the Lexus from 800 N Congress Avenue to 2000 N Congress Avenue at 60 mph in a marked 45 mph area. The Lexus entered the left turn lane on the inside lane. I entered the left turn lane in the outside lane. While making the left turn, the Lexus was unable to maintain its lane almost side swiping my vehicle.

Due to the above aforementioned infractions, I activated my red and blue emergency lights on my marked BBPD patrol vehicle (4741) to conduct a traffic stop on the Lexus RX at the 1800 block of West Gateway BLVD. The vehicle slammed on its brakes in the left turn lane and then made a U-turn at Savannah Lakes Drive, eventually coming to a stop in the right lane of eastbound traffic. I made contact with the driver/sole occupant, identified by her FL Driver's license as W/F Judith Johnston (DOB: 9/11/57). She had obvious red and glossy eyes. Johnston sounded lethargic and was slow with answering my questions. When I asked for her driver's license, registration, and insurance; Johnston only provided me with her license at first. She kept checking her wallet for her registration and eventually handed me her insurance card instead. I asked Ofc. Alexis to attempt to obtain the vehicle registration from Johnston and he returned with her registration and a second insurance card. Due to the above clues, I suspected Johnston to be driving under the influence of an unknown substance. At this time, I requested Ofc. Castro to respond to conduct a DUI investigation.

I issued Johnston a citation for Unlawful Speed (citation # AE9KOKE) and Fail to Drive in a Single Lane (citation # AE9KOLE). Johnston gave approval for her boyfriend who was on scene to take possession of her vehicle. He did so, but left behind Johnston's

registration and two insurance cards. I submitted the documents to BBPD Evidence as prisoner property. This ends my involvement in this incident."

I then made contact with Johnston, who was still occupying the driver seat of her vehicle. I introduced myself and inqurie if she was aware of the reason why she was stopped; which Johnston stated no. After exlpaining the infractions observed by Officer Drury, Johnston denied speeding and failing to maintain her lane. Johnston advised that she was traveling to her residence from her boyfriend's residence. While speaking with Johnston the odor of a femaine fragence was overwhelming. Even with the fragence I still detected the odor of an unknown alcohlic beverage emeanting from Johnston's breath, which intestifed as she spoke. Johnston's speech was thick and slurred and her eyes were bloodshot/glassy. As Johnston spoke she smacked her lips. Based on the above facts I requested Johnston to exit her vehicle, so I that could speak with her face to face and away from the fragence. While walking to the rear of her vehicle, Johnston swayed side to side. I then informed Johnston the reason while I wanted to speak with her outside of the vehicle. At this point the odor of the unknown alcoholic beverage was stronger. Johnston admitted to consuming one glass of wine a couple of hours prior to the traffic stop. Based on the above facts, I asked Johnston if she would be willing to submit to a Series of Standardized Field Sobriety Task, which she agreed to. Prior to beginning I asked Johnston if she had any disabilities and/or injuries; which she stated yes. Johnston advised that she has hearing difficulties and therefore has balance issues. See the following:

Pen Exercise: During the task Johnston swayed side to side and had a difficult time not moving her head, after instructed not to. Johnston would look away from the stimulus at times.

## WALK AND TURN:

Johnston was placed into the instructional stance and told to remain in that position until I told them to move. Johnston was given instructions and demonstration numerous times. Johnston moved and lost her balance from the instructional position prior to me telling her to move. Johnston started numerous times before the instructions were complete. Johnston missed heel to toe on every step. Johnston stepped off the line on step #7. Johnston stopped walking after the first 9 steps and asked for additional instructions. Johnston performed an improper turn, as she walked around in a normal manner. Johnston failed to keep her arms to her side. Johnston had a noticeable orbital sway during this task.

## **ONE LEG STAND:**

Johnston was placed into the instructional stance and told to remain in that position until I told them to move. Johnston advised that she is unable to perform the task due to her hearing difficulty. Johnston advised that she did not want to try.

## **FINGER TO NOSE:**

Johnston was placed into the instructional stance and told to remain in that position until I told them to move. Johnston was given instructions and a demonstration. Johnston had to be reminded to keep her eyes closed. Johnston did not touch tip to tip as instructed. Johnston rasied her Right arm in a 90 degree and pointed up. Johnston then asked for further instruction. Johnston had a noticeable orbital sway during this task.

## **ROMBERG/ALPHABET:**

Johnston was placed into the instructional stance and told to remain in that position until I told them to move. Johnston was given instructions and a demonstration. Johnston recited the alphabet in a fast, singing manner.

Based on the above facts Johnston was placed into handcuffs (D/L and Spaced) and arrested for suspicious of DUI. Johnston was then placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle (#4734) and transported to the Palm Beach County BAT facility. I arrived at the facility at 0051hrs, started my 20 minutes observations at 0055hrs and completed it at 0115hrs. Upon completion I requested Johnston to provide a sample of her breath to determine the alcohol content, which she agree to. Johnston provided a BrAC sample of .151 at 0124hrs and .159 at 0127hrs. I then read Johnston her Miranda Warnings, which she stated that she understood. Q&As were refused.

Based on the facts, Johnston was charged with Driving Under the Influence pursuant with F.S.S. 316.193.1.A. Johnston was processed and later TOT PBCJ.

Incident was captured via BWC. Johnston's vehicle was removed by her boyfriend.
