



Upon approaching a third stop intersection indicated by a stop sign at S Federal Hwy, the vehicle again failed to stop at a clearly marked stop line and made a right turn to travel northbound on S Federal Hwy. The vehicle then stopped at a steady red light at the intersection of S Federal and E Palmetto Park Rd. When the light turned green, the driver accelerated quickly causing the front wheels to spin. The vehicle traveled northbound until NE 2nd St. It then made a left turn to travel westbound on NE 2nd St and approached a steady red light at the intersection with N Dixie Hwy. The vehicle continued straight through the intersection, making almost no effort to stop at the steady red indication. I initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle in the area of 400 NW 2nd Ave. The vehicle came to a final stop at 590 NW Crane Terrace.</p> <p>Upon approaching the vehicle, I immediately observed that the driver's eyes were red and glassy, his speech was slurred, and he had a strong odor of alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath when he spoke. The driver was identified as Julian Vega by FL DL.</p> <p>I asked Vega where he was coming from and he stated he was at One11 Boca which is a bar located at 111 SE Mizner Blvd. I then asked him where he was headed and at first he stated he was on his way to his home in Deerfield Beach. I questioned Vega as to why he was traveling northbound on 2nd Ave if his house was located to the south. Vega then changed his statement and said he was actually on his way to Brickyard which is a bar located along Palmetto Park Rd which is also located to the south of our location. I</p>

asked Vega how much alcohol he consumed prior to the stop and he stated he had two beers.

Based on Vega's driving pattern, my observations, his statements, and the overall totality of the circumstances, I asked him to step out of his vehicle and submit to standardized field sobriety exercises. Vegas agreed to participate.

Prior to beginning the exercises, I asked Vega a series of question. I first asked Vega if he was sick or injured and he stated he was not. I asked if he had any physical defects or injuries and he stated he did not. Vega claimed he did not limp and felt comfortable in the shoes he was wearing. He also stated he was not involved in a crash and had not hit his head recently. Vega said he had not seen a doctor or dentist today and was not taking any prescription medications or drugs. Lastly, Vega claimed he was not diabetic or epileptic and did not have anything wrong with his eyes that was not corrected by glasses or contacts. I then proceeded with the exercises.

The first exercise was Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. I administered the instructions and Vega stated that he understood. I observed that Vega momentarily took his eyes off the stimulus and swayed in a circular motion while the exercise was being conducted.




The second exercise was the Walk and Turn. I administered the instructions and demonstrated how the exercise should be completed. I noticed that Vega had some difficulty staying the starting position. Once the instructions were completed, Vega stated that he understood. Vega began the exercise prior to being instructed to begin, used his arms for balance, and made an improper turn.

The third exercise was the One-Leg Stand. I administered the instructions and demonstrated how it should be completed. Vega stated he understood. Vega swayed in a circular motion, used his arms for balance, put his foot down, and hopped while completing the exercise.

The fourth exercise was the Finger to Nose. I confirmed that Vega knew his left from his right by asking him to show me his left hand and then his right hand. I then administered the instructions. The pattern was L-R-L-R-R-L.

- L - Held his finger on his nose.
- R - Held his finger on his nose.

The final exercise was the modified romberg balance test. I asked Vega if he felt comfortable estimating the passage of 30 seconds and he stated he did. I demonstrated

the passage of 30 seconds using a stop watch. The instructions were administered, and the exercise was conducted. Vega estimated the passage of 30 seconds in 32 seconds. He also swayed in a circular motion while the completing the exercise.

Upon completing the exercises, Vega confessed to consuming two Heineken beers and two shots of Jagermeister.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, I found probable cause to believe that Vega was operating a motor vehicle within the state while under the influence alcohol or controlled chemical substances. Vega was placed under arrest for DUI per F.S.S 316.193(1a).

A search of Vega's vehicle incident to arrest revealed a 1.75L bottle of Jagermeister which was approximately 2/3 empty, an empty 23.5oz can of Mike's Harder Mango, and an empty 12 oz can of Heineken beer within the passenger compartment.

Vega was transported to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office DUI Testing Facility where Breath Operator Ragin (#16877) completed the BAT room procedures. Vega was asked to provide a sample of his breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content and he agreed to submit. Vega's first sample yielded a "volume not met" result (.118). I informed Vega of implied consent and ensured that he understood. Vega provided a second sample which again yielded and "volume not met" result (.118). A third attempt to collect a lawful sample of breath yielded a result of .119 and a fourth attempt yielded a result of .129. Vega was then advised of his constitutional warnings and stated he understood. Vega refused to participate in the Q&A portion of the interview. See DUI Influence Report for further.

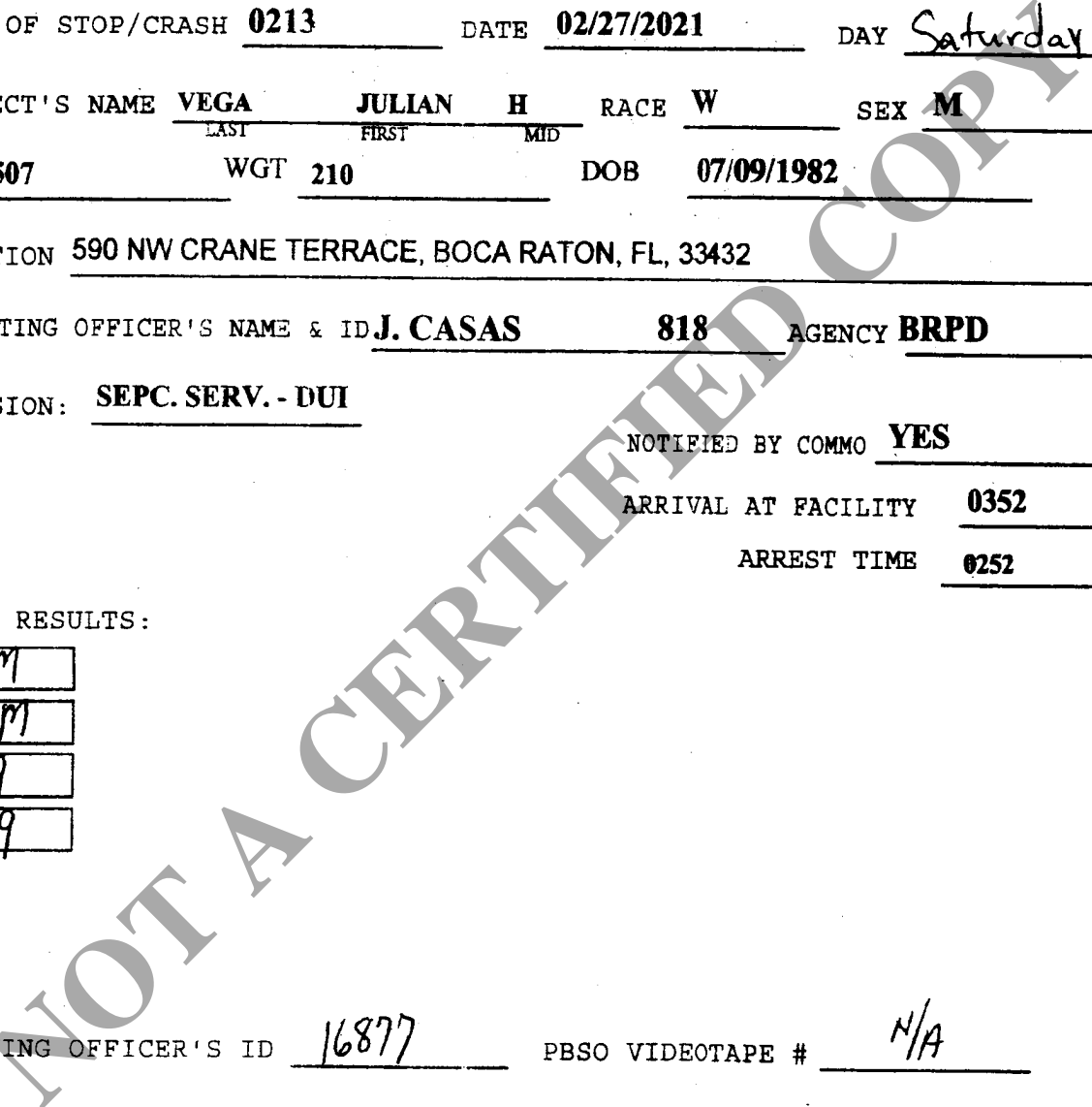
