	<p>I observed a gray pickup truck (FL Tag 4988YX) at the aforementioned intersection. The vehicle's tag light was not properly illuminated, making it dark and unreadable from less than 50 feet away.</p>								
	<p>I activated my overhead emergency lights and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle on West Indiantown Road at Interstate 95.</p>								
	<p>I made contact with the driver, who was later identified as B/M Trevon Brown (4/30/2002), and front seat passenger W/F Julianna Alba (5/9/2000).</p>								
	<p>I informed Brown of the reason for the traffic stop, and requested his license. Brown then informed me that he was knowingly driving without a valid license. As I was speaking with Brown, I detected the strong odor of what I believed to be marijuana, based upon my training and experience, coming from inside the vehicle.</p>								
	<p>I then instructed Brown to step out of the vehicle, and he was pat down for weapons as a precautionary measure. I informed him that the vehicle smelled like marijuana, and requested permission to search the vehicle, to which Brown gave verbal consent that I may.</p>								
	<p>Upon checking Brown in FCIC/NCIC, I was advised that he had an active PALMS warrant. Brown was detained, and placed into handcuffs which were checked for proper spacing and double locked.</p>								
	<p>Alba was advised to step out of the vehicle, and she was given a coat due to being cold.</p>

Upon searching the glove compartment of the vehicle I located a small gray scale with apparent green leafy marijuana residue on the surface. Based upon my training and experience I recognized that the scale to possible be a tool for weighing marijuana prior to packaging for sale.

I also located a clear plastic baggie in the center console area, within arm's reach of both Brown and Alba. The bag contained several small tan seeds that I believed may be marijuana seeds.

I then located a brown backpack positioned directly behind the driver's seat, within arm's reach of Brown. The main compartment of the bag contained two large plastic bags of a green leafy substance that I believed to be marijuana, based upon my training and experience. There were also many empty small plastic baggies in the same compartment, and a separate baggie of marijuana seeds identical to those located in the center console area, along with tampons and additional feminine products. A black plastic name tag of "Julianna" was also located in the brown backpack.

I also located a black ski mask in the brown backpack, and an orange ski mask under the center console.

I read Brown his Miranda rights from a Miranda card, and he stated that he understood his rights. I informed him that I discovered marijuana in the vehicle, and he said that it did not belong to him. Brown was aware of the brown backpack being in the vehicle, and he stated that it belonged to a friend who he was just with minutes before the traffic stop.

I asked Brown the name of the friend, and he refused to provide it. He told me I didn't need to know the name of the owner of the marijuana. Brown became uncooperative and refused to provide further information about the marijuana.

I then spoke with Alba. I read her Miranda rights from a Miranda card, and she stated that she understood her rights. I informed her of the marijuana located in the vehicle, and she stated that it was left in the vehicle by a male friend several days ago. Alba admitted that the feminine products inside the bag where the marijuana was located, belonged to her, and that she put them in the backpack. Alba did not provide further information about where the marijuana came from.

The total weight of the marijuana located in the brown backpack was 131.35 grams (approximately 4.6 ounces).

Based upon the location of drug paraphernalia and marijuana seeds located near Brown and Alba, Alba's belonging's being in the bag with the marijuana, and the proximity of the marijuana to Brown, I determined that there was probable cause to arrest and charge both Brown and Alba with possession of marijuana with intent to sell, as there were 15 empty plastic baggies and a scale present with the large quantity of marijuana.

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The PALMS warrant of Brown was found to be inactive and resolved. He was advised he was under arrest for possession of marijuana with intent to sell, drug paraphernalia, and driving with a suspended license with knowledge. He was searched incident to arrest with negative results for further contraband.

Brown became insulting and belligerent after he was advised of his charges. He cussed at Officers calling them "Bitch", said "Fuck You" several times, and bragged about previously fleeing from police. Brown also said that he intended to steal a police motorcycle, and said he would be out of jail very soon.

Brown was initially going to be released from the Jupiter Police Department with a juvenile referral, however due to his demeanor he was not afforded the opportunity and was transported to the Juvenile Detention Facility in West Palm Beach.

Prior to being transported, Brown attempted to place his handcuffs in the front of his body, and said that he was going to defeat the handcuffs and make the officer's job more difficult. He was subsequently seat belted, and an additional restraint was placed over his chest area to prevent his attempts at defeating his handcuffs.

Alba was searched incident to arrest with negative results for further contraband by Officer Shaff. The truck was towed by rotation. The marijuana and paraphernalia were placed into the Jupiter Police Dept evidence facility, and the marijuana is to be sent to the laboratory for testing.

Brown's mother B/F Stephanie Lee (2/15/1976) was informed of his arrest via phone. Brown was later transported to the Juvenile assessment center in West Palm Beach without incident.

Alba was transported to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident.

Based upon the above aforementioned facts I find probable cause to charge Trevon Brown with the following:
