On the 14 day of November 2020 at 8:28  A.M.  P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

I was initially dispatched to a traffic crash blocking the roadway on Interstate 95. When I arrived on scene, Ms. Maesel was standing by the driver's side door of her vehicle speaking to a West Palm Beach firefighter. As I approached the vehicle, I noticed a very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle. When I looked into the vehicle, the front passenger seat was drenched with a liquid that had a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage. When I approached the Ms. Maesel, she too also smelled of an unknown alcoholic beverage. She was at least 6 feet from her vehicle, so the smell did not emanate from inside the vehicle. When speaking to the 2 other drivers, and witness on scene, all three people identified Ms. Maesel as the driver. Ms. Maesel also had the keys to her car in her pocket (I had to ask where the key was as I was trying to remove the vehicle from blocking the roadway)

I observed that Ms. Maesel was wearing blue jean shorts and a tube top. While speaking to Ms. Maesel, I noticed that she seemed to be confused by my instructions. I had requested that she obtain her driver's license, vehicle registration and insurance information for the Trooper investigating the crash. I had to make the request 3 times before she finally collected all the requested paperwork. I also observed Ms. Maesel eyes and they appeared red and glassy. In addition, she was also slurring her words. At this time Trooper William Leon arrived to conduct the traffic crash investigation.

I then began a DUI investigation of Ms. Maesel.

I asked Ms. Maesel if she had been drinking or used any drugs. She said no (later admitted to drinking after being read the Miranda). I asked Ms. Maesel what medical problems she had. Ms. Maesel said she was on an insulin patch which better regulated her blood sugar levels.

I started with the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. Both Ms Maesel eyes had onset of Nystagmus as soon as they started moving (way prior to 25 degrees). Need more here (lack of smooth pursuit as soon as her eyes started moving)

Walk and Turn: I positioned Ms. Maesel on a painted white line which was on a smooth and relatively level surface, and free of any debris. I instructed Ms. Maesel to place her left foot on the line and her right foot in front of the left touching heel to toe (making sure to stress heel to toe). I instructed her that to keep her hands at her side and stay in this position until I instructed her to start the exercise. I instructed her to walk nine heel to toe steps counting out loud. On the ninth step she was to keep to turn around before walking nine heel to toe steps the opposite direction counting out loud also. I demonstrated the task while I was verbally instructing Ms. Maesel in the proper way to complete the task. During the task, I observed the Ms. Maesel swayed while balancing, did not touch heel to toe all 18 steps, and did not count out loud at all. Ms. Maesel also had a difficult time keeping balance without raising her arms all the way out.

One Leg Stand: I placed Ms. Maesel with her feet together and arms at her side. I demonstrated the task as I verbally instructed her to raise one of her feet (her choice) approximately six inches off of the ground, and count out loud 1001, 1002, 1003 or 1-1000, 2-1000 (again her choice) and so on until 1030. I asked Ms. Maesel understood the instructions and demonstration I provided. After Ms. Maesel stated she understood my instructions, she was told to start. While Ms. Maesel stood in the instructional position, I observed Ms. Maesel placed her foot back on the ground after approximately 6 seconds. I then gave her a second chance. On her second attempt, she counted to 14, and went back to 13. She also counted 22 twice Ms. Maesel also had a difficult time keeping balance through most of this exercise.

At this point, I placed Ms. Maesel under arrest and transported her to the Palm Beach County Jail. While at the Palm Beach county Jail, I conducted a 20min observation of Ms. Maesel. She did not take anything by mouth or regurgitate. After the 20min observation, Ms. Maesel was asked for two samples of her breath test for the purpose of determining alcohol content. She agreed. Ms. Maesel blew a (.205) and (.205).

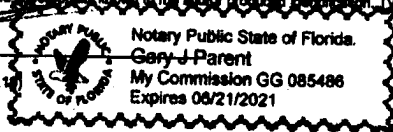

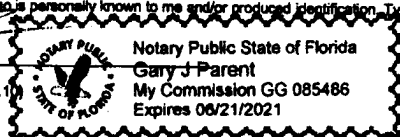
