The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:  
 On 05/28/2021 while backing up Tampa Master Patrol Officer Josh Baar(49754) at Fremont Av N just south of Kennedy Bl W the listed defendant, Kalee Lynn Barton, the passenger in Officer Baar's DUI suspect's vehicle, a 2013 black VW Beetle sedan, moved into the driver seat and proceeded to drive away as myself and Officer Baar repeatedly ordered her to stop the car. The driver side window was down and I made eye contact with her as she backed the car up and drove away. At this time I observed that she had bloodshot glassy eyes and a flushed face. As she drove away Officer Baar advised me that there was a child in the back seat. I then got in my patrol car and caught up to the defendant at Howard Av N and Arch St W. At which time she pulled over and I took her into custody. At this time I detected a very strong and distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage. The time of arrest of arrest was 2344 hours. I then transported the defendant to the HCSO/CBT Facility and she provided a breath sample. Her BAC .192/.181. The defendant's 4 year old daughter(victim) was in the back seat of the vehicle driven by the defendant. I identified the defendant with FL DL.
