The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

The defendant was caused a crash when she left her designated lane of travel and crash into a legally parked vehicle. The defendant was driving her 2014 Jeep Latitude, bearing IL tag #BA13048, and was still in the driver's seat upon police arrival. The defendant was also positively identified by a witness as the driver at the time of crash. The defendant exhibited multiple signs of impairment, including: slurred speech, a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on her breath, a distinct odor of burnt marijuana emanating from within her vehicle, bloodshot/glassy eyes, sluggish reflexes, crying for no apparent reason, unsteady on her feet, she urinated on herself, and was swaying as she stood. The defendant performed poorly on HGN and Walk and Turn, but then refused to perform the One Leg Stand. The defendant was arrested for DUI with property damage and later refused to submit to the breath test, despite acknowledging the Implied Consent Warning.

A search of the area around the drivers seat incident to her arrest, revealed the defendant had two pills in the arm rest console. The first pill was a beige diamond shaped pill with the "punisher" emblem stamped on it. The pill had the appearance of Ecstasy and field tested positive for Ecstasy. The second pill was contained in a plastic Ziplock sandwich baggie and was a green a white capsule, marked "S489 40mg", which was identified via Drugs.com as Vyvanse 40mg, a schedule 2 controlled substance.

The defendant identified herself via her IL driver's license.
