### NARRATIVE:

On June 3, 2021 at approximately 10:45AM I responded to the parking lot of the Marshall's Department Store located at 8180 Glades Road Boca Raton, FL 33434 in reference to an animal neglect case. Palm Beach County Deputy Sheriff Oroz (ID#35677) told me the following: On 06/03/2021 at approximately 1001 hours I was dispatched to 8180 Glades Road in unincorporated Boca Raton Palm Beach County in reference to an animal call. Upon my arrival I made contact with a complainant who stated she wanted to remain anonymous involving what appears to be two white dogs found in a Black Audi SUV Q7 bearing Quebec tag FPP4711. I and Deputy Camelo ID 36166 were able to observe two white dogs inside the vehicle which appeared to be in distress and panting. I was able to observe the SUV have all four windows slightly open however it appeared that the two white dogs had a difficult time breathing. At this time Palm Beach County Fire Rescue Engine 53 (Run# 21061957) arrived on scene. Once on scene, Palm Beach County Rescue Engine 53 advised that removing the dogs from the vehicle would be a priority due to their signs of distress and panting from the heat conditions. At approximately 1018hours Palm Beach County Fire Rescue was able to gain access into the vehicle using lock out tools without damaging the vehicle during process. Both of the two dogs were then removed from the vehicle and were provided with water. Both dogs appeared to still be in distress for a period of time. At approximately 1030 hours a white female later identified as Kristina Kaliamova approached the scene to advise that the black Audi Q7 was her vehicle and was asking why her two white dogs were no longer in the vehicle. Myself, Deputy Camelo, and Palm Beach Fire Rescue advised her that due to the circumstances of the heat, and her two dogs appearing to be in distress, it was necessary to have the animals

removed from the vehicle to avoid any possible injuries caused by heat exhaustion and/or death. At this time Detective Eric Zadanosky ID 6531 arrived on scene to continue the investigation and interview Kristina Kaliamova. This concludes my involvement in this case to which it was turned over to Detective Eric Zadanosky.

On June 3, 2021 at approximately 10:50AM I met with Kristina Kaliamova for the purpose of conducting an interview. I read Mrs. Kaliamova her constitutional rights from a preprinted PBSO Miranda card which she stated she understood and signed. Mrs. Kaliamova told me the following: Mrs. Kaliamova and her mother, Zilia Sadretdinova, arrived at Marshall's at approximately 8:45AM to make a return and shop. Mrs. Kaliamova's stated she left her two Samoyed dogs in her car because she didn't think she could bring them in the store with her. Mrs. Kaliamova said her car does not allow her to leave the air conditioning on and lock the doors with the key in the ignition, so she opened the windows slightly and left water for the dogs. Mrs. Kaliamova further advised she was in Marshall's for approximately 40 minutes before she returned to her and noticed her two dogs standing outside with the police. After confirming the times with Mrs. Kaliamova she realized it was actually 9:30AM when she arrived at the Marshall's store. I advised Mrs. Kaliamova fire rescue had to remove her dogs from the hot car because they appeared to be in distress and were panting heavily. I explained to Mrs. Kaliamova the current outside temperature was approximately eighty-six (86) degrees Fahrenheit, and the temperature inside of her vehicle was much greater. I advised Mrs. Kaliamova leaving her dogs in the hot car for approximately 45 minutes without adequate air circulation can cause injury and even death to them. Mrs. Kaliamova said her Samoyed Cookie is a 4 1/2 year old female and Wolfie is a 3-year-old male. Mrs. Kaliamova said she did not initially hear Marshall's paging for the owner of a black Audi SUV to return to the vehicle.

Mrs. Kaliamova showed me her two dogs which were now lieing inside of her SUV in the airconditioning. The dogs appeared to be breathing normally at this time. I made contact with PBC Animal Care and Control Sgt. Jennifer Batchelor (ID#2110) who advised as long as the dogs appear to be ok, and they were not needed to take custody of the dogs, it was ok to release the dogs to the owner's designated caretaker. Mrs. Kaliamova requested her mother, Zilia Sadretdinova, take custody of the dogs.

## NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

Based on the facts provided, probable cause exists to believe Kristina Kaliamova (the owner of two Samoyed dogs; Wolfie and Cookie) neglected to provide or perform the legal obligations for care and support of an animal by keeping her two dogs in an enclosed vehicle without wholesome exercise and change of air. Mrs. Kaliamova is being charged with confinement of animals without sufficient food, water, or exercise; abandonment of animals, pursuant to Florida State Statute 828.13 (2b).
