The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did
 The defendant was operating a black 2013 Honda Odyssey van, Florida tag Z64GZH. A concerned citizen contacted the Tampa Police Department advising that the female driver of the vehicle was possibly impaired, and provided an exact description including a tag number. I located the vehicle and observed the defendant operating the vehicle in a manner in which she drove at slow speeds (more than 10 MPH below the posted limit), drifted onto and over painted lane markers several times, straddled a lane marker, accelerated and decelerated inconsistently, and drove at a speed of over 70 MPH in a properly posted 55 MPH speed limit. A traffic stop was conducted to check on the driver's condition and determine if she were sick, tired, distracted, or impaired. The defendant had a distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage on her breath. The defendant's eyes were bloodshot and watery. The defendant's face was flushed, and her speech was slurred. The defendant's actions and emotions were out of the ordinary as she ranged from crying, to claiming to be scared of police, to laughing and joking. The defendant fumbled greatly with her wallet trying to get her driver license, and was forgetful as to the other requested documents. The defendant stated that she drank 3 glasses of wine tonight, and spontaneously stated that she had drank too much to be driving. The defendant swayed while standing, was unsteady on her feet, and had great difficulty following simple instructions. The defendant agreed to perform Field Sobriety Exercises. The defendant exhibited signs and clues of impairment, she consistently interrupted, and she had great difficulty following simple instructions. The defendant was arrested for DUI. The defendant refused to submit to a lawful test of her breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content after being advised of the Implied Consent Warnings. The defendant was positively identified by her Florida DL.
