He advised that he observed the vehicle strike the median in front of 2123 S US Highway 1 and continue southbound, dragging pieces of the vehicle behind it. A second caller, Jeremy Mathis (WITNESS-2), soon called about the same vehicle and advised that it had blown a tire out. Mathis was able to intervene and convince the driver of the Range Rover to pull over. Mathis was able to direct Juno Beach Police Department Officers to where the Range Rover was stopped, which was in front of 14327 S US Highway 1, Juno Beach, FL.</p> <p>I arrived on scene soon after and made contact with Juno Beach PD Officers. I advised them that due to the first harmful event taking place within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Town of Jupiter I was there to conduct an investigation. They advised me that the driver of the range rover, Lisa Madar (DEFENDANT), was about to perform field sobriety exercise. Due to the first event taking place in Jupiter and my specialty as a DUI officer, I took over the investigation.</p> <p>I made contact with Madar at the rear of her vehicle. I conducted a crash investigation, which I then concluded. While speaking with Madar she had slurred speech. She had glassy bloodshot eyes. Madar had an odor of unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her person, which intensified as she spoke. I informed Madar that the crash investigation was over and that I was not conducting a criminal DUI investigation. I read her her Miranda rights from a prepared card. She advised that she understood her rights.</p> <p>I asked her how much she had to drink and he said, "I didn't have a drink today". I asked her if she takes any medication and she stated that she takes Lexapro and Xanax, but denied taking Xanax today. I asked her why she smelled like alcohol if she had not</p>

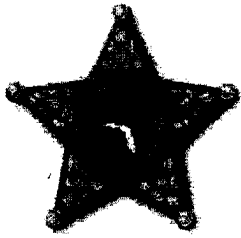

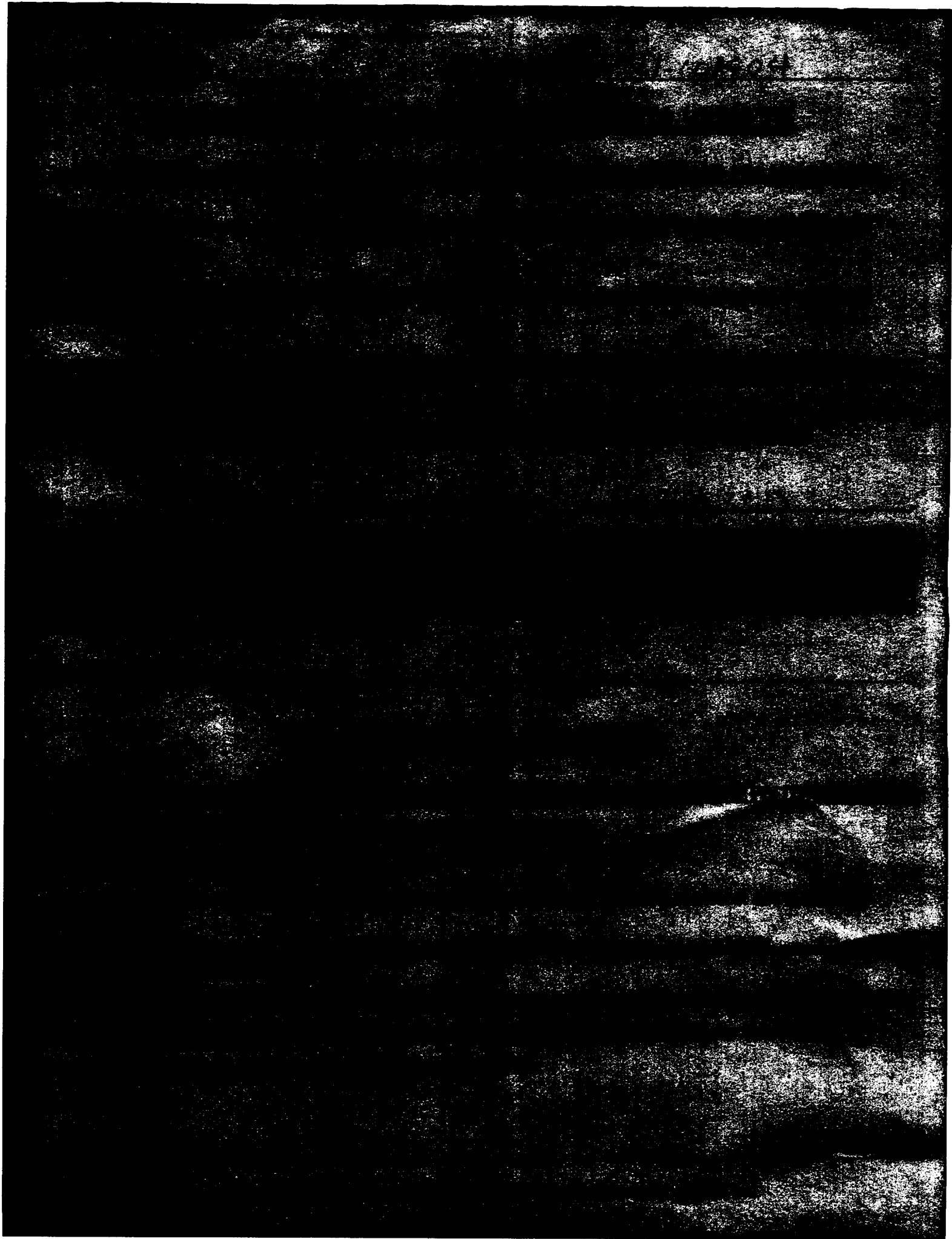
