The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did

On the above listed date and time, at the listed location, the defendant was stopped subsequent to a lawful traffic stop. Corporal Baldwin was operating in-car radar unit (BEE III S/N REM979000563) and observed the defendant's vehicle approaching his vehicle at, or around 45mph. This was in a posted 35mph zone. Corporal Baldwin activated his FRONT radar antennae and received an audible tone which was consistent with his visual estimate. Upon reviewing the heads up display of the radar unit, he discovered the defendant was traveling at 46mph. The affiant initiated a traffic stop and upon activating the emergency lights, the defendant failed to maintain her lane almost striking the raised curb. Upon contact with the defendant, I approached on the passenger side window and attempted to make contact with the defendant by tapping on the closed window. The defendant proceed to pass her driver license out the driver side window. The defendant then rolled the passenger side window down and the affiant smell an odor of alcoholic beverage emanating for the defendant expelled breath. The defendant was also advised to show proof of insurance and continued to fumble with her phone in attempts to gather her insurance from her application. The defendant advised she did not have anything to drink.

The affiant asked the defendant to consent to field sobriety exercises to which she initially declined. After careful explanation of the next actions the affiant would be taking, the defendant agreed to complete field sobriety exercises for her benefit. When exiting the vehicle, the defendant placed both feet on the floor and stumbled as she walked across the street. While in the starting position, the defendant was swaying as she stood. During the HGN exercises, I observed lack of smooth pursuit, Distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and distinct nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. She was also unable to follow the stimulus as requested, taking her eyes off of it.

During the walk and turn exercise, the defendant could not stay in the starting position and began the exercise numerous times before being asked to do so. During the exercise, the defendant stepped off the line numerous times, could not touch heel to toe, used her arms for balance.

During the one-leg stand, the defendant was swaying as she stood, only counted to six, placed her foot on the ground numerous times, and did not complete the exercise once she begun.

I observed numerous clues of impairment during the exercises and I believed the defendant was operating a motor vehicle in this State while under the influence of alcohol. I placed the defendant under arrest and informed her she would have the opportunity to provide a sample of her breath. The defendant refused on scene and I transported her to Central Breath Test at ORJ. While at Orient Road Jail, I afforded her the opportunity again to provide a sample to which she declined again. I read Implied Consent for a sample of her breath and she refused. The defendant was issued a D.U.I. Citation (ACHRZTE) and a written warning for her speed.
