On 11/15/19, I was assigned an animal cruelty case that occurred at 883 E Palmetto Park Rd (Poochie Couture) in the City of Boca Raton. I reviewed the initial report completed by Boca Raton Police Officer Forbes. The following is a synopsis of the case:



"On 11/12/2019 at 1855 hours, Officer Forbes responded to 883 E Palmetto Park Rd, Boca Raton FL (Poochie Couture), in regard to a female caller advising she was concerned about the puppies inside, as she believed the business had been closed since 2000 hours on 11/10/2019, and has not seen any employees since.

Officer Forbes located the business and could see that the lights were off inside. There are 2 entrances to this business, one being on the south side of the building and one on the north side. Officer Forbes could see what appeared to be mail belonging to the business stuck in the handle of the north side door, as well as a "sorry we missed you" letter from FedEx, stuck to the south side door. Officer Forbes could also hear dogs barking inside. Officer Forbes contacted the owners, Natalie and Marc Rosenbluth over the phone. Marc Rosenbluth answered the phone and advised they were actually on their way to the store.

Officer Forbes contacted Palm Beach County Animal Control and explained the circumstances of the investigation. It was advised that animal control already had a case open in regard to this location, reference their case number of A19014029, but they would be sending an officer to further investigate.

Marc and Natalie arrived on scene and Officer Forbes explained the situation to them. Marc stated that there was an employee at the store on 11/11/2019 and he and Natalie had come to the store on 11/12/19 at approximately 1130 hours. Officer Forbes asked if officers could walk through the store and also check on the puppies, at which Marc advised they could and opened the door. Officers walked to the back of the store, where

<p>the puppies are kept, when they are not on display. In this back room, there were several cages. While looking through each of the cages, Officer Forbes noticed one puppy that was lying down and was not moving. Due to how excited all of the other puppies were, it was then clear to Officer Forbes that this puppy was deceased.</p> <p>Once Officer Forbes pointed this out to Marc, he advised they just got this puppy in, and did not know if the puppy was going to make it when they purchased the puppy. This was the only puppy found deceased during Officer Forbes` walk through. Natalie advised the puppy was a "Morkie" (Maltese/Yorkie), and was approximately 3 months old.</p> <p>Officer Forbes requested some type of documentation or proof that an employee had been with the puppies, and they had not been left alone for an unreasonable amount of time.</p> <p>Natalie stated she could prove that an employee had been at the store on 11/11/2019, as they "clock in" using the computer inside, and she can see their time stamps using an application on her phone. Natalie advised the employee who was working on 11/11/2019 was Shane, and showed Officer Forbes the application, where Officer Forbes could see he clocked in at 1357 hours on 11/11/2019 and clocked out at 2150 hours on the same date.</p> <p>Officer Forbes spoke with Shane Walsh, who confirmed Marc and Natalie`s statement, where he advised he had been at the store during the time frame listed. He advised when he was at the store, he ensured all of the puppies were fed, cleaned if needed, and there was water prior to him leaving for the night. He advised there is always an employee who checks on the puppies each day, and they never go without care.</p> <p>Officer Forbes was contacted by Officer Kovacs (ID #2134) with Animal Care and Control (ACC), who advised he was responding to remove the deceased puppy. Upon Officer Kovacs` arrival, it was then advised that his supervisors were responding, and they may be removing all of the puppies from the store. Sergeant G. Cueto (ID #2210) with ACC arrived and explained he would be going through all documentation the business had regarding the puppies, and he was aware of this business, as there have been other complaints."</p> <p>The following are a synopsis of Officer Kovacs` report from 11/12/19:</p> <p>On 11/12/19 at approximately 2046 hours, Officer Kovacs responded to Pochie Couture Pet Store (883 E Palmetto Park Rd) in reference to an animal cruelty/abandonment animal complaint. Officer Kovacs was informed over the phone by Officer Forbes that there was a deceased puppy found during his initial walk through. Officer Kovacs informed Lt. McCaffrey-Edler of the incident and it was determined that Officer Kovacs would be responding to the scene.</p> <p>Upon arrival, Officer Kovacs made contact with Marc and Natalie Rosenbluth, who he</p>

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

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observed providing food to all the puppies, and conducting general cleaning of the cages. Officer Kovacs observed the deceased animal (A1977908) to be a three-month-old black with tan Maltese/Yorkshire Terrier mix male puppy (photographs secured). The deceased animal was in a plastic bag, in a freezer located in a back room of the store. Natalie Rosenbluth provided Officer Kovacs with the deceased animal's Official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection ("OCVI"), dated 11/07/19 (photographs secured). Officer Kovacs verified the OCVI belonged to this animal by scanning for a microchip (photograph secured).

Natalie Rosenbluth stated the same statements to Officer Kovacs that she had earlier to Officer Forbes about the staff coming in to care for the puppies daily and she showed Officer Kovacs the employee timecards (photographs secured). Officer Kovacs then inquired about the amount of animals in the store, and Natalie Rosenbluth stated they have approximately 56 puppies. There were three areas where the puppies were being kept; an isolation room at the front of the store, a general room in view of the public, and a back room by the rear entrance of the store. Officer Kovacs counted five puppies in the isolation room, twenty-two in the general room, and thirty in the back room (photographs secured). The deceased puppy was found inside one of the cages located in the general room, with two other live puppies with him. Officer Kovacs conducted a welfare check of the animals (photographs secured) until Sergeant Cueto and Sergeant Kelso arrived.

The following are a synopsis of Sergeant Cueto's and Sergeant Kelso's report from 11/12/19:

On 11/12/19 at 2145 hours, Sergeant Cueto and Sergeant Kelso arrived at 883 E Palmetto Park Rd (Poochie Couture Pet Store) in reference to an animal cruelty investigation/abandonment. Upon their arrival they made contact with Officer Kovacs and was briefed on what has transpired so far on scene. Officer Kovacs advised he had taken custody of the deceased puppy, which was secured in his vehicle. Sergeant Cueto and Sergeant Kelso went into the store and made contact with the owners of the establishment Marc and Natalie Rosenbluth. Sergeant Cueto and Sergeant Kelso briefly walked around the store to see how many puppies were in the store. The count was fifty-seven puppies, not counting the deceased one that was in Officer Kovacs' vehicle. Sergeant Cueto and Sergeant Kelso made contact with Officer Forbes from the Boca Raton Police Department. Officer Forbes stated his department received a call that the store was closed, puppies were barking, and unclear if anyone was taking care of the puppies. Officer Forbes stated when the owners arrived, he gained access to the store. Officer Forbes walked inside the store and while assessing the store, he noticed a puppy not moving. Upon closer inspection, the puppy had expired. Officer Forbes did mention that when he gained access to the store the owners started cleaning and feeding animals quickly. Let it be known, this establishment has gone through renovations for the last couple of months. However, it was stated by Marc Rosenbluth on November 7, 2019 that they would have a

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soft opening on November 9, 2019, while Sergeant Cueto was on scene checking the store's progress.

The odor of ammonia within the entire store was clearly noticeable and above mild. The establishment owner stated that they were at the store cleaning earlier in the day at approximately 10 am and admitted that her cleaning method was primarily triage cleaning to the cages as needed and to make sure that the animals had proper food and water before they left. Natalie Rosenbluth added that no dogs are kept in the cages they classified as "Display Cages". Natalie Rosenbluth stated that she had been closed for business, however after Natalie Rosenbluth stepped away, Officer Kovacs advised Sergeant Cueto and Sergeant Kelso that Natalie previously told him that the business has been open since as late as this past weekend.

Sergeant Cueto and Sergeant Kelso proceeded to a small room that was used for isolation. This room contained five additional puppies that all appeared sickly with nasal discharge and through the cage a couple of these puppies in this room appeared to be thin as well.

Officer Kovacs and Sergeant Cueto conducted a thorough inspection of the puppies and their living conditions. The puppies were in small cages that were behind the display cages. Sergeant Cueto started on one side where the puppies were housed, the puppies did have access to portable water. However, no bedding was provided as well as the puppies were on a grated floor. This damages or hurts their appendages especially the smaller breed puppies. Sergeant Cueto was hands on with the longhaired puppies to confirm body weight was ideal satisfactory. Every cage had a catch pan that collects the feces and urine from puppies. However, most of the grates had what appeared to be dried feces stuck to the grates on the cages. Due to the significant amount of puppies in the establishment, animal husbandry would need to be seriously regimented. It appears the store has not established cleaning protocols as some previous conversations Sergeant Cueto had with the owners.

Sergeant Cueto noticed a female blue French Bulldog that appeared lethargic, dehydrated and unthrifty. Upon closer inspection, the puppy appeared to score a three on the TACC scale (one being ideal and five emaciated). Natalie Rosenbluth stated that the puppy would eat but was not getting better and she would be returning her to the breeder. This puppy and another sibling was the center of another investigation approximately twenty-one days ago. Sergeant Cueto issued an order to provide professional medical care for both pups due to the same condition Sergeant Cueto saw today (11/12/19). Sergeant Cueto was concerned for this puppy due to her appearing unhealthy. Sergeant Cueto and Sergeant Kelso then went into their isolation room where there were five French Bulldog pups. Sergeant Cueto assessed these Bulldogs and all appeared to have severe upper respiratory infection due to the yellow or milky discharge from their noses. In addition, they had yellow, dry crust around their noses and on their snouts. All five of

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them appeared lethargic, dehydrated and underweight. This room had an air purifier that was on, however Sergeant Cueto did not know how effective it would be. These puppies did not have any bedding, lying on grated floors. The catch trays did appear to have older feces than the ones observed in the other rooms. One other French Bulldog appeared to score a three on the TACC scale. This puppy appeared disoriented, as well as lethargic. Upon closer inspection, one of the puppy's snouts was red and inflamed and was missing fur on his snout. Images and video were taken throughout Sergeant Cueto's time on scene of the store and pups. Sergeant Cueto made the owners aware of the concerns for the puppies in isolation. Sergeant Cueto inquired on their OCVI for the puppies in the isolation room. The puppies all had current/valid Florida OCVI as well as their out of state OCVI. Sergeant Cueto was unable to locate any medical notes instructing the owners what to do in regard to the sick puppies. Sergeant Cueto also verified the deceased puppy's documentation, which the pup has been in the store's custody at least since October 10, 2019 or possibly earlier due to the puppy's exam date. The deceased puppy had two OCVI's that were signed by Dr. Daniel Sosa D.V.M. of Boca Palms Animal Hospital located at 950 N Federal Hwy Boca Raton, FL 33432. This means that on October 10, 2019 and on November 7, 2019 Dr. Sosa gave the puppy a clean bill of health. In addition, the deceased puppy's OCVI had two puppies on the form, which is a violation of Palm Beach County Ordinance. The other French Bulldogs that were the center of Sergeant Cueto's concerns had seen Dr. Sosa from October 23, 2019 and October 31, 2019 as per the OCVI's stated. No information was given that these puppies were unhealthy at the time of the exam or had a condition.



Sergeant Cueto, Sergeant Kelso, and Officer Kovacs believed it was in the best interest to remove the Bulldogs that were exhibiting numerous signs of sickness, so the six Bulldogs were removed from the establishment. The puppies were placed in Officer Kovacs vehicle and taken to Animal Control to receive medical attention.

The six Bulldogs and the deceased puppy arrived at ACC and they were examined by staff veterinarian Jane Teichner. Dr. Teichner observed the following for each dog:

A1977908 (Maltese): Post-mortem ~ 27 hours fair condition for necropsy. Morkie black/tan male 3 months old, microchipped with TACC 2 body condition score. Rigor mortis with RF leg extended caudally, body and legs fixed. Last noted alive between 11 AM-1 PM on 11/12/2019.

Hemorrhagic bile in stomach. Liquid mucoid feces throughout the GI tract. No normal ingesta of any kind in GI tract. Petechiae in greater curvature of stomach and distal lungs.

Submitted tissue samples of rectum, small intestine, stomach (greater curvature), heart (ventricle), lung and liver for histopathology. Gross and microscopic findings deemed by the pathologist to be unremarkable. Lung: moderate, diffuse, chronic-passive pulmonary

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congestion commonly attributed to left heart disease." Malformation of the mitral valvular complex is a common cause of left heart failure in younger dogs...and likely cause of death."

Internal parasite burden would cause the diarrhea (coccidia found on fecal), electrolyte imbalances, weight loss and malnutrition.

A1977909 (French Bulldog): PE: Underweight TACC 3/undersized with large rounded head, wide chested and bowlegged (chondrodysplastic). Temp: 99.5 F, HR 130, RR 56. Injected sclera. Wide-set eyes. Mucous nasal discharge. Potbellied. Dirty hair coat. Cracked, dry paw pads. Unable to eat without hand-feeding. Pronounced open fontanel. Diarrhea. Fecal: tapeworms, coccidia, giardia.

A1977910 (French Bulldog): PE: Quiet, mildly congested. TACC 2 Underweight. T 101.4, HR 120, RR 56. Pale pink mucous membranes. CRT= 2 sec. Serous nasal discharge. Stained, crusty tear tracks. Sneezing. Occasional cough. Potbellied. Hair thinning on head and back of ears. Dry, cracked paw pads. Dirty hair coat. Wide chested and bowlegged (chondrodysplastic). Good appetite. Diarrhea: fecal tapeworms, coccidia, giardia.



A1977911 (French Bulldog): PE: CIRRD. Quiet, inappetent. MM pale pink. CRT> 2 sec. Temp: 99.1, HR 140, RR 36 with increased effort. Given 20 cc SQ lactated ringers with B-Complex 0.15 cc. Bilateral purulent nasal discharge. Congested. TACC 2 Underweight. Potbellied. Dry, cracked paw pads. Dirty haircoat. Bowlegged (chondrodysplastic) and wide-chested. Diarrhea: fecal tapeworms, coccidia, giardia. Required 24 hour care at a private veterinary practice.

Laboratory Results: CBC: Leukocytosis WBC High 24.2 (reference 4.0-15.5) due to neutrophilia 18392/uL (reference 2060-10600) and a monocytosis 1452/uL (reference 0-840).

Canine Respiratory Disease Profile: Positive for Canine herpesvirus, Mycoplasma cynos and Bordetella bronchiseptica, although Bordetella was negative on culture. The health certificate states that the puppy had been vaccinated for kennel cough with a modified live vaccine.

A1977912 (French Bulldog): PE: Quiet, mildly congested. TACC 2 Underweight. T 101.1, HR 116, RR 36. Pale pink mucous membranes. CRT= 2 sec. Serous nasal discharge. Sneezing. Occasional cough. Potbellied abdomen. Dry, cracked paw pads. Dirty haircoat. Bowlegged (chondrodysplastic) and wide-chested. Good appetite. Diarrhea. Fecal: tapeworms, coccidia, giardia.

A1977913 (French Bulldog): PE: Quiet, mildly congested. TACC 2 Underweight. T 101.3, HR 148, RR 44. Pale pink mm. CRT= 2 sec. Right nasal purulent discharge. Tear staining and

A1977914 (French Bulldog): PE: Lethargic, congested. TACC 3 Underweight. HR 140, RR 36 with abdominal effort. Wheezes. Pronounced spine and dorsal ribs. Pale pink mm. CRT> 2 sec. Underbite. Eyes laterally placed- OD strabismus. Dome-shaped cranium with a large fontanel. Serous nasal discharge. Raspy breathing. Sneezing. Occasional cough. Potbellied abdomen. Dry, cracked paw pads. Dirty haircoat. Bowlegged (chondrodysplastic). Inappetence except coprophagy observed. Diarrhea. Fecal: tapeworms, coccidia, giardia. Required 24 hour care at a private veterinary clinic due to pneumonia and a ventrally displaced trachea (see Radiographs).

Dr. Teichner concluded: (also see full vet report)

Results: All puppies were sick on intake. They presented with respiratory signs, diarrhea and failure to thrive. Clinical signs included diarrhea, coughing, sneezing, nasal discharge and increased respiratory effort due to congestion. All puppies were exposed to a myriad of viral, bacterial and parasitic infections at Poochie Couture puppy store; also, they were possibly exposed at home and carriers of disease when transported from other states (Indiana and Missouri). These puppies did not have a patent immune system; they were too young and still dependent on maternal antibodies for protection. The vaccines given prior to departure couldn't guarantee protection. If stressed from travel and weaning, all puppies are vulnerable to infectious pathogens. They were not able to fight off disease. They may have carried contagions from their respective places of origin. Canine herpesvirus and mycoplasma, tested and confirmed by PCR, caused the respiratory signs: coughing, sneezing, nasal discharge, failure to thrive, inappetence, gastrointestinal distress. Brachycephalic breeds, like Bulldogs, with pushed-in noses, are more likely to get a more serious respiratory infection than dogs with normal muzzles. All puppies required nebulization and supportive care while at PBC ACC (subcutaneous fluids, antibiotics, probiotics) for upper respiratory congestion; 2 puppies required intensive care at a private clinic. One puppy progressed to pneumonia.

Two puppies had congenital malformations. A rounded head, a large fontanel, and inability to eat without being handfed, to learn basic commands and housetrain is consistent with congenital hydrocephalus. The Morkie puppy found dead at the site purportedly died from a congenital heart condition.

All puppies were underweight with protruding dorsal spines, ribs and prominent pelvic bones, but pot-bellied. Parasite burden also is cause for lethargy, failure to thrive/weight loss, skin lesions, colitis/diarrhea/distended abdomen, all due to lack of

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
veterinary care. They required treatment with praziquantel, ponazuril and metronidazole for internal parasites.

Cause of Injury: Lack of preventive and ongoing necessary veterinary care and infectious disease control, including parasite control. Some puppies had congenital malformations. Close contact of these puppies made it highly probable that they were exposed directly or by fomites to contagions.

Conclusion: It is within reasonable veterinary purveyance to consider neglect if a caretaker does not provide preventive and ongoing necessary veterinary care and quarantine for infectious diseases.

Based on my investigation, I have probable cause for the arrest of Marc Rosenbluth and Natalie Rosenbluth for 7 counts of confinement of animals without sufficient food, water, or exercise; abandonment of animals per F.S.S. 828.13. A warrant will be applied for.

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
