The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did On the listed date and time, Deputy R. Jones # 252162, contacted the driver while investigating a crash with \$5,000.00 in property damage and minor injuries to the victim. The crash was investigated under HCSO report #19- 889038, DSHMV #87712654. The victim identified the driver as the person who was behind the wheel of the vehicle that rear ended the vehicle he was traveling in, as he observed the driver being pulled out of her vehicle immediately after the crash. She was the only occupant inside the vehicle. Deputy Jones observed indicator of impairment as he interviewed the driver. Upon contact with the driver, the driver emitted an odor of an alcoholic beverage from her breath, she had slurred speech, and bloodshot and watery eyes. The driver refused to perform Field sobriety exercises after being advised that Field Sobriety exercises are voluntary, and that the exercises confirm or dispel any suspicion of impairment. However, if she refused to perform the following exercises, she could be arrested for suspicion of DUI based on the totality of the circumstances, and that her refusal to perform the requested exercises will be used against her in a court of law. The driver acknowledged the warning and she was arrested for suspicion of DUI based on the totality of the circumstances. The driver refused breath test after Implied Consent warning was read and understood. Moreover, the driver was advised that her right to speak to an attorney had nothing to do with her submitting to any DUI test. The driver invoked her right to remain silent after being advised of her rights. The driver was identified via a valid Florida DL.
