The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did: On, 11/05/19 at approximately 2207 hours, I conducted a traffic stop on a white in color Ford Taurus bearing Florida tag... #GNMI11, VIN #1FAHP24W18G135327 at the intersection of Brandon Bl W / Hilltop Rd S. The traffic stop was in reference to the listed vehicle failing to use a turn signal to change lanes from the number three lane to the number one lane. Upon contact with the driver, later identified as Mason McGowan, I immediately observed the odor of vegetative marijuana emanating from within the vehicle. The defendant was starting to sweat profusely and very nervous during the traffic stop. The defendant started to shake vigorously as he looked for his driver's license. The defendant was asked to exit the vehicle due to the odor of marijuana being present along with his mannerisms. During a search of the vehicle, I located two clear plastic bags containing a green leafy substance consistent with marijuana. A marijuana field reagent test was conducted which yielded positive results for THC. Post Miranda warning, the defendant admitted the marijuana was his and that he just purchased an ounce. The defendant was positively identified via valid Florida driver's license and later transported to the Orient Road Jail without further incident.
