Narrative:

On Sunday, the 14th day of February, 2021, at approximately 0010hrs I arrived in the area of 1605 Renaissance Commons Blvd #232 (Monte Verde in Renaissance Commons) in reference to a domestic dispute. Upon my arrival I met with the reporting party / victim (Paul Ruddy) who advised he was in an altercation with the mother (Melissa Carr) of his child (Capri Ruddy) that became physical over financial issues.

When I was trying to determine if the altercation had in-fact been physical, Paul was hesitant in speaking and it was obvious he was holding back. I explained to Paul that how I proceeded with my investigation was going to be dependent on the physicality of the event. Paul soon stated that he was backhanded by Melissa while he, Melissa and Capri were in Melissa's vehicle; Capri was asleep in the back.

I did notice a small lump on the cheek bone of Paul's left cheek which would be consistent with being backhanded by the driver of the vehicle, in this case Melissa. Paul stated he was tired of Melissa "getting away with everything" and she needed to be held accountable for her behavior. Paul soon realized where this investigation was going, ie: probable cause against Melissa, and he began to back peddle and say he did NOT want Melissa to get into trouble he simply wanted to get some belongings for work and leave for the evening.

Digital photographs of Paul were captured and submitted into B.B.P.D.'s electronic evidence database (A.D.A.M.S.) via the remote program Digital Acquire. When speaking with Melissa, she stated that at no time did the couples financial discussions escalate into a physical altercation; Melissa did not exhibit any physical injuries nor did she complain of any.

Based on the above facts, I find probable cause to charge Melissa with Simple Battery (Domestic) in accordance with F.S.S. 784.03(1)(a)(1). Melissa was placed into handcuffs, double locked and checked for tightness, and transported to the B.B.P.D. for processing. Once cleared from having any active wants or warrants, Melissa's care and custody was turned over to the Palm Beach County Jail.

A Digital Request in regards to the 911 call along with the radio traffic will be submitted and once obtained, attached to this case. This investigation, in its entirety, was captured on my AXON body worn camera.


