

Upon searched the rear left passenger area of the vehicle, I located a multi colored purse on the seat where Garcia-Obrien was sitting.

The main compartment of the purse contained a large amount of suspected narcotics to include the following:

- Ten identical clear plastic baggies containing a fine white powder, which was later field tested positive to be cocaine using a cocaine quick check test kit. The weights of the baggies were as follows: 0.59 grams, 0.66 grams, 0.71 grams, 0.72 grams, 0.62 grams, 0.70 grams, 0.67 grams, 0.67 grams, 0.66 grams, and 0.63 grams.
- Ten small clear plastic baggies each containing a small amount of a rocky tan/brown substance that I believed to be Hashish based upon my training and experience. The weights were as follows: 0.52grams, 0.49 grams, 0.55 grams, 0.62 grams, 0.60 grams, 0.57 grams, 0.54 grams, 0.49 grams, 0.47 grams, and 0.47 grams. The hashish is to be sent to the laboratory for testing.
- Approximately eighty empty small clear plastic baggies, which were identical to the baggies containing the cocaine and suspected Hashish.
- A small clear plastic baggie containing a round blue pill labeled "C1". The pill was identified as Colnazepam 1 milligram, a schedule 4 controlled substance under the controlled substance act.

-The large green pill bottle also contained three round white pills labeled "10 325 RP" and one yellow/white round pill labeled "230". The pills were identified as Acetaminophen and Oxycodone Hydrochloride 325 milligram/10 milligram, a schedule 2 controlled substance under the controlled substance act.

-6.38 grams of a green leafy substance in a clear plastic baggie, that I believed to be marijuana, based upon my training and experience. The suspected marijuana is to be sent to the laboratory for testing.

Garcia O'Brien was placed into handcuffs which were checked for proper spacing and double locked. She was read her Miranda rights from a Miranda card, and she stated that she understood her rights.

I told Garcia O'Brien about the many narcotics located in the purse on the rear left passenger seat. The purse also contained Garcia O'Brien's identification card, and many of her credit cards, house keys, and other personal effects. Garcia O'Brien verbally confirmed that the purse belonged to her, and she confirmed that it was her wallet and personal effects inside. Garcia O'Brien was aware of the narcotics located in her purse, and she stated that they were indeed packaged for sale, and they belonged to her. Garcia O'Brien stated that some of the prescription pills packaged for sale were stolen from her brother, Mark Fuller.

Garcia O'Brien stated that the only prescription medication she currently has is a thyroid medication. Garcia O'Brien stated she sometimes uses cocaine, and works as a Bartender at Uncle Mick's bar in Jupiter, where she sells narcotics.

Garcia O'Brien was advised that she was under arrest. She was searched incident to arrest with negative results for contraband by Officer Shaff.

Garcia O'Brien and Logan Child were each transported to the Jupiter Police Dept. for processing, and then to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident.

Based upon the above aforementioned facts I find probable cause to charge Michelle Garcia O'Brien with the following:


