PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I responded to the 200 block of NE 18th Ave in reference to a Traffic Stop conducted by PTO Officer Rivera (#901) and OIT Officer Drury. This incident occurred within the City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida.

Upon arrival I made contact with Officer Rivera who advised that while she and Officer Drury were traveling together in fully marked patrol vehicle #4544 southbound on NE 1st Ln, approaching the intersection of NE 19th Ave, she observed a Gray Toyota Tacoma (later learned to be bearing Florida KXGN93) traveling eastbound at a high rate of speed. Officer Rivera advised that by utilizing the pace method, they maintain a consist speed of 50mph behind the Tacoma. The speed limit in the residence area is 25mph. Officer Rivera advised that while activating their emergency lights and sirens, the Tacoma had already begun to slow down to a stop. Officer Rivera advised that she then made contact with the sole occupant/driver W/M Barreto Colon, Miguel (09/14/89); identified via Florida Driver's License. Officer Rivera advised that while speaking with Barreto Colon she detected the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from Barreto Colon's breath and within the vehicle. Officer Rivera advised that Barreto Colon's speech was thick and slurred, and his eyes were bloodshot/glassy. Officer Rivera advised in the rear seat she observed an opened case of Heineken beer. Officer Rivera advised that while Barreto Colon was looking for his documents, he was very stable and disheveled. Officer Rivera advised based on her investigation at this point she contact me to assist with a possible DUI Investigation. See Officer Rivera's supplement for further.

I then made contact with Officer Vazquez, who arrived on scene as a back up officer for Officer Rivera. Officer Vazquez advised that while standing near the rear passenger door, which the window was lowered, Barreto Colon requested Officer Vazquez to assist him with gathering his documents from the glove box. Officer Vazquez advised when he opened the front passenger door he observed an empty Heineken beer bottle on the passenger front floorboard. Officer Vazquez also advised he detected the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from Barreto Colon's breath and from with the vehicle. Officer Vazquez advised that Barreto Colon's speech was thick and slurred and his eyes was bloodshot/glassy. Officer Vazquez advised that he also observed the case of Heineken beer in the rear seat compartment and a case in the bed of the truck. See Officer Vazquez' supplement for further.

I then made contact with Barreto Colon, who was still occupying the driver seat of the vehicle. While speaking with Barreto Colon he advised that he was trying to locate a residence to a close friend, where his wife was currently at. Barreto Colon advised that he was told by Officer Rivera the reason for the traffic stop but he did not think he was traveling more than 25-30mph. While verifying his address on his driver's license, Barreto Colon first advised that he still resided in Palm Beach Gardens. As the investigation continued, Barreto Colon advised that he resides in Lake Worth. Barreto Colon did not recall telling me he resided in Palm Beach Gardens. While speaking with Barreto Colon, I detected the odor of the unknown alcoholic beverage that Officer Rivera and Officer Vazquez detected. Barreto Colon's eyes were bloodshot/glassy and his speech was thick and slurred. In plain view I observed the case of Heineken beer in the back seat of the vehicle and the empty Heineken bottle in the passenger seat floor board. Based on my investigation at this time, I returned back to my vehicle to activate the in-car camera. I then requested Barreto Colon to exit his vehicle and walk towards the front of my vehicle, which he agreed. While walking Barreto Colon swayed side to side. While speaking with Barreto Colon face to face I still detected the odor of the unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. I asked Barreto Colon if he had consumed any alcoholic beverage today, which he stated yes. Barreto Colon advised that he did not want to lie, Barreto Colon advised that he had 12 beers. Barreto Colon advised that he had consumed 12 Heineken beers while he was at work between the hours of 2030hrs and 2200hrs. While trying to verify the amount of drinks Barreto Colon had consumed, he changed his amount to 6-7 beers. While standing Barreto Colon was still swaying. Based on the above facts I requested Barreto Colon to Submit to a Series of Standardized Field Task, which he advised that he has to he will do the task. I then explained to Barreto Colon that I was not forcing him to complete the task and that it was his choice. I then advised Barreto Colon his Taylor Warnings, which he stated that he understood. I then requested a second time, which Barreto Colon agreed to complete the task. Prior to beginning I asked Barreto Colon if he had any disabilities and/or injuries; which he stated no. See the following:

Pen Exercise: During the task Barreto Colon swayed side to side and moved his head during the task. Barreto Colon had a difficult time following the stimulus with his eyes and while attempting to follow his eyes jerked side to side.

HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS:

- ☐ Left eye does not follow smoothly
- ☐ Left eye prior to 45 degrees
- ☐ Distinct jerking in left eye at maximum deviation
- ☐ Vertical Nystagmus in left eye

- ☐ Right eye does not follow smoothly
- ☐ Right eye prior to 45 degrees
- ☐ Distinct jerking in right eye at maximum deviation
- ☐ Vertical Nystagmus in right eye

WALK AND TURN:

Task was explained and demonstrated to Barreto Colon, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Barreto Colon lost his balance and started the task too soon. During the walking stage, Barreto Colon took 11 steps forward, stepping off the line on step #

4 and 6 and paused from balance on step #6. Barreto Colon completed a normal u-turn. Barreto Colon then took 9 steps back, missing heel to toe between step 1 and 2. Barreto Colon did not count out loud during the task. Barreto Colon used his arms for balance once during the task.

ONE LEG STAND:

Task was explained and demonstrated to Barreto Colon, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Barreto Colon swayed side to side and started too soon. During the balancing stage, Barreto Colon did not count out loud and did not watch his raised foot during the task.

FINGER TO NOSE:

Task was explained and demonstrated to Barreto Colon, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, swayed side to side. During the exercise stage, Barreto Colon missed the tip his nose on the 1st and 2nd LEFT hand command and the 1st RIGHT hand command. Barreto Colon did not return his arm to his side after every command. Barreto Colon swayed during the task.

ROMBERG/ALPHABET:

Task was explained and demonstrated to Barreto Colon, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Barreto Colon swayed side to side. Barreto Colon advised that he did not feel comfortable reciting the alphabet in English so he requested to recite them in Spanish. While doing so, Barreto Colon stopped and advised that he was having a difficult time. I then requested Barreto Colon to count from 26-51, which he stated that he understood. Barreto Colon counted to 50. Barreto Colon swayed during the task.


Based on the above facts Barreto Colon was placed into handcuffs (D/L and Spaced) and arrested for suspicious of DUI. Barreto Colon was then placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle (#4734) and transported to the Palm Beach County BAT facility. I arrived at the facility at 0054hrs, started my 20 minutes observations at 0100hrs and completed it at 0120hrs. Upon completion I requested Barreto Colon to provide a sample of his breath to determine the alcohol content, which he agreed to. Barreto Colon provide a sample of .128 at 0132hrs and .126 at 0135hrs. I read Barreto Colon his Miranda Warnings, which he stated that he understood. Q&As were completed.


Based on the facts, Barreto Colon was charged with Driving Under the Influence pursuant with F.S.S. 316. 193.1.A. Barreto Colon was processed and later TOT PBCJ. Incident was captured via BWC. Barreto Colon vehicle was removed from scene by his sister.

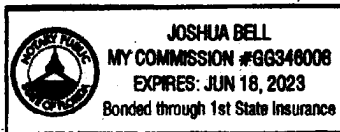
