The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

On the listed date and time and at the above location, officers were on scene investigating an unrelated battery (under TPD report 21-290193). While attempting to obtain a statement from the victim in that report, who is the defendant's boyfriend, the defendant came outside numerous times causing a scene. The defendant was ordered no less than five times to go back inside, otherwise she'd be arrested for obstruction. At one point, the defendant went back inside of the apartment and began ruffling the blinds, causing such a distraction, that officers' attention had to be directed at her instead of the battery call for service. The defendant continued to come outside, each time yelling so loud that this affiant could not hear the victim's verbal statement. Additionally, the defendant placed a phone call to an unknown subject, alleging that officers were conducting a DUI investigation, which was not at all factual. The defendant's factitious claims could be heard from two apartments away, which was the position that this affiant and the victim took in order to create space from the defendant and properly conduct a battery investigation. The defendant had just got home from spending the evening at the City Dog Cantina bar, reeked of alcohol, and was obviously intoxicated during the encounter. Upon placing the defendant under arrest, she made her body limp, refused to walk on her own, and had to be physically carried to the patrol car.

At the time of this offense, I was operating a fully marked City of Tampa Police Ford Explorer equipped with an overhead light bar and siren. I was wearing standard Tampa Police Class "B" uniform equipped with badge, duty belt, and all related police insignia visible. I was equipped with an Axon Body 3 Body Worn Camera (BWC) which was mounted on the center of my chest and activated in accordance with TPD SOP.

The defendant was positively identified via DHSMV photograph.

Pursuant to Florida Statute §92.525 and under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing document and the facts stated in it are true to the best of my knowledge. For Notices to Appear, I also certify that a complete list of witnesses and evidence known to me is attached.
