COUNT ONE

NAJOUA RAHLI, on the 10th day of February, 2020, in the County of Hillsborough and State of Florida, did knowingly use intimidation or physical force, or threaten another person, to-wit: SOUKAINA CHARRADI, or attempted to do so, with the intent to cause or induce said SOUKAINA CHARRADI to hinder, delay, or prevent the communication to a law enforcement officer or judge of information relating to the commission or possible commission of an offense or violation of a condition of probation, parole, or release pending a judicial proceeding, where the official investigation or official proceeding affected involves the investigation or prosecution of a misdemeanor.

COUNT TWO

NAJOUA RAHLI, on the 10th day of February, 2020, in the County of Hillsborough and State of Florida, did actually and intentionally touch or strike SOUKAINA CHARRADI against the will of the said SOUKAINA CHARRADI; or did intentionally cause bodily harm to SOUKAINA CHARRADI. Contrary to the form of the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.

The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County Florida did On 02 10 2020 at approximately 1600 hours at the shared residence at 5402 Sandy Shell Dr the defendant and the victim were engaged in a verbal altercation. The altercation turned physical when the victim attempted to call law enforcement but the defendant grabbed the victim's right wrist and twisted it around with the intent of the victim dropping her phone so she was not able to. The victim was not given the phone back until multiple days after the incident. The victim had pain in her right wrist but had no visible marks from the altercation. The defendant is the victim's sister in law and the two live together with multiple other family members at the same residence. The victim positively identified the defendant as the person who committed the offense and was confirmed via her Florida DHSMV photograph.
