The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:
 On 05/12/20, at approximately 1224 hours, Nicklaus Lee Williams attempted to enter into the Sonic Restaurant located at 1515 Brandon BL E. The restaurant was closed due to the Governor's Emergency declaration. The employees of Sonic, Alexander S. Ramirez (victim #1) and Brandon L. Sanders (victim #2) told Williams he could not enter he raised his fist and threatened to hit them if they did not let him in the restaurant. Williams's actions caused the victims to have a well-founded fear that they were in imminent danger of being struck by Williams. They had to forcibly shut the door to keep Williams out. Deputy D. Jones #45311 and Lt. A. McCullough #2694 responded to the Sonic. Upon sight of law enforcement Williams fled south across Brandon Bl. Deputy Jones located Williams behind the Chili's Restaurant. Deputy Jones exited his patrol car and instructed Williams to place his hands on the push bumper of his patrol car. Williams walked away from Deputy Jones as I arrived on the scene. I exited my vehicle and instructed Williams to "Stop, Sheriff's Office," to which Williams replied, "Fuck

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you!" As I closed the distance on Williams he bladed himself and assumed a fighting position. Fearing Williams was going to hit me, I grabbed his left arm. Williams pushed off of me and began to run away from me across the Lowe's parking lot. Williams ran towards Deputies D. Samos #250516 and R. Stewart #4998 as they were arriving on scene. When deputies attempted to take Williams into custody he began to violently resist their efforts. Williams struck Deputy Jones in his arm with his elbow. Williams struck Deputy Stewart in the head (eye/nose area) with his elbow. He also kicked Deputy Samos in his legs. After a violent struggle, Williams was finally taken into custody. All the deputies involved in this incident were driving fully marked HCSO patrol vehicles and wearing the HCSO uniform which clearly identified them as law enforcement officers.
