The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did On listed date and time the defendant driving a 2006 Mercedes bearing FL tag EXRJ46 VIN: WDBUF56J86A836492 (referred to as V1) was traveling westbound on Dr. King Bl. approaching Park St. in vehicle 1. Driver 2 was traveling westbound on Dr. King Bl. at Park St. in vehicle 2, directly ahead of vehicle 1. The front of vehicle 1 struck the rear of vehicle 2, causing front end damage and airbag deployment in vehicle one. The defendant's ten (10) year old child was in the front passenger seat of vehicle 1 and suffered abdominal pain and orbital bleeding from his eye, that was swelling shut. Vehicle 2 suffered rear end damage. The defendant was witnessed in actual physical control of her vehicle by driver 2 (witness) and a second witness. The defendant's ten (10) year old child exited the vehicle and flagged down other passing vehicles for help. The defendant told the witness who stopped to help not to call the police or ambulance. The defendant also had a four (4) year old child in her vehicle at the time of the crash. At no time did the defendant summon for medical assistance for her children in the vehicle. Affiant detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from the defendant's mouth when she was talking. The defendant's eyes appeared red and watery. The defendant had difficulty keeping her balance when she stood and appeared to be impaired. Affiant read the defendant her Miranda rights from a Constitutional Rights card. The defendant advised she had completed some college classes and understood her rights. The defendant refused to perform any Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises. The defendant was placed under arrest and transported to Central Breath Test where she refused to provide a lawful sample of her breath. The defendant had a previous DUI conviction on 11/12/06, Citation #508XDN. The defendant was positively identified via D.A.V.I.D.
