

On November 15, 2020 at 1600 hours, Officer Martel (ID 811) received a Department of Children and Family report about a possible child neglect. It was reported that, Dakota Hachimi's father, Oded Hachimi, has been growing marijuana plants in his house. The complaint stated that Dakota's parents are divorced and that Oded has a parenting plan with joint custody with Shane Rice, Dakota's mom. Officer Martel met with Shane and Dakota in the parking lot of 940 Sweetwater Lane to investigate the allegation. Officer Martel spoke with Dakota while Shane talked to Officer De La Rua (ID 758). Dakota advised that she visits her dad at his residence every Sunday and Tuesday between 1200 hours and 1530 hours. Dakota stated that she is concerned because Oded is growing marijuana plants in his residence and he insists Dakota help him with the cultivation process. Dakota explained that he asks her to water the plants with unknown chemicals and tells her to move plants/equipment around the room. Dakota explained that she believes the plants are marijuana because she has researched it on the internet. Dakota advised that she is unsure why Oded is growing marijuana but in November of 2019 she observed him sell marijuana to an unknown female in his residence. Dakota stated that the marijuana plants are in Oded's residence at 663 Dover Street in the city of Boca Raton Florida on the second floor in a bedroom on the southwest corner of the building. She noted that one window in the bedroom faces Dover Street. Dakota took a picture of the room today at 1512 hours. The picture shows Oded in a bedroom with the windows covered, holding a hose leading to multiple marijuana plants in individual buckets. Shane told Officer De La Rua that she is concerned for Dakota's well-being and does not want Dakota to be involved with Oded anymore. Shane explained that Oded has been growing marijuana plants for a while and provided pictures from last year at his residence. Shane noted that Oded works for a video surveillance company and has multiple surveillance cameras placed around the exterior of the residence.

<p>On November 15, 2020, Officer Martel contacted Investigator Shica (ID986) of the Department of Children and Families (DCF) who advised that a case will be initiated, and an investigation will be conducted.</p> <p>On November 16, 2020, Detective Peck responded to 940 Sweetwater Lane with investigator Victoria Diaz from DCF. While at the residence Detective Peck and Investigator Diaz spoke with Shane and Dakota. Shane stated that Oded has been growing Marijuana for a long time and stated that she had pictures of the plants from last year. Dakota provided Detective Peck with the picture which clearly shows Oded tending to six grown marijuana plants. Dakota advised that the picture was the same picture that she showed officers on November 15th, 2020.</p> <p>After speaking with Shane and Dakota, Detective Peck and Investigator Diaz responded to 663 Dover Street Apartment 1 to speak with Oded about the allegations. I responded to the residence to assist the investigators in identifying the possible narcotics inside the residence. It should be noted that the following events were recorded on Body Born Cameras and submitted under the case number. Upon our arrival we contacted Oded who walked outside and closed the door behind him. It should be noted that when the front door opened, I was able to identify the smell of fresh marijuana coming from inside the apartment. Detective Peck explained to Oded why we were at the residence and Oded stated that he does not have any marijuana inside the residence, and we can come inside and check. Oded invited us into the residence and we all proceeded into the downstairs living room. There was an overwhelming smell of marijuana as we entered the residence and the odor remained as we spoke with Oded. Oded was asked who else lives in the residence and he stated he has a roommate. When Oded was asked the roommates name, he began to fumble over his words and the stated "I have six marijuana plants upstairs."</p> <p>Detective Peck advised Oded of his Miranda constitutional warnings from a pre-printed department issued card. Oded stated he understood his rights and signed the Miranda warnings card. Post Miranda, Oded admitted that he is growing marijuana in his townhome for personal use and Dakota knew the plants were upstairs. Detective Peck explained to Oded that he had the right to provide us written consent to search the residence and he had the right to refuse consent, but we would request the court for a search warrant. Oded was assured that he can refuse and remove his consent at anytime during the search. Oded gave his consent to search and remove the contraband from his residence and completed a consent to search card. The consent to search card and the Miranda card were placed into evidence. A search was conducted of the residence and six marijuana plants with cultivation equipment were in an upstairs bedroom. It should be stated that the room was outfitted with hydroponics, grow lights, a filtration system and all the windows were foiled over. The operation filled the room and it appeared that Oded was expanding to the other spare bedroom. Pictures and video were taken prior to searching the residence and after the dismantle of the grow operation. The six (6) marijuana</p>

The following marijuana cultivation equipment was seized from the residence.

6 Grow Lights
2 Halogen lights
4 LED lights
Carbon Filter
Dehumidifier
2 Aerators / Compressors
2 Spare halogen light bulbs
2 Light Ballasts
Marijuana plant starter kit
6 Grow Blocks

While searching the rest of the house a zip lock baggy containing mushrooms was inside the top right upper drawer of the kitchen island. The bag of mushrooms was seized and when Oded was asked about the mushrooms, he stated that they were not the psychedelic kind. Oded was asked again about the marijuana plants and he stated that he only grew the plants so he would know what he was putting in his body. Oded advised that he only started growing marijuana four (4) months ago which was a false statement since there are pictures of Oded growing marijuana from a year ago. It is the belief of this officer that Oded is growing marijuana to supplement his income because of the numerous cameras around the residence including one inside the room he was growing marijuana, the elaborate operation including alterations to the ceiling and walls, and the past information provided Oded was growing and selling marijuana last year. All the facts above have demonstrated that Oded unlawfully and knowingly did cultivate cannabis, a substance classified within Schedule 1, Florida Statute 893.03(1)(C), commonly known as marijuana, a controlled substance, contrary to Florida Statute 893.13(1)(a).

On January 6th, 2021, the Palm Beach County Laboratory Senior Forensic Scientist Kelvin Morales-Colon confirmed that the green leafy material tested positive for Marijuana as listed in Florida State Statute as a schedule 1. The laboratory utilized Weight analysis, Macroscopic examination, Microscopic examination, and Gas Chromatography-Mass Spectrometry (GC-MS).

On April 13th, 2021, the Palm Beach County Laboratory Senior Forensic Scientist Kelvin Morales-Colon confirmed that the brown mushroom like material tested positive for psilocybin as listed in Florida State Statute as a schedule 1. The laboratory utilized Weight analysis, color test, and Gas Chromatography-Mass Spectrometry (GC-MS).
