The undersigned swears that he/she has reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant on the 01 day of JULY, 2020

at approximately 5:25 PM, at 447 LOCKLIE ST, in Pinellas County did:

ACTUALLY AND INTENTIONALLY TOUCH OR STRIKE HEATHER R. SICKLER GIRLFRIEND AND CO-HABITANT, AGAINST THE WILL OF THE VICTIM, TO-WIT: PUSHING THE VICTIM INTO A DOOR FORCEFULLY BREAKING THE DOOR, STRIKING HER IN THE FACE, AND THROWING HER ONTO THE COUCH RIPPING HER CLOTHING.

THE DEFENDANT AND THE VICTIM WERE ENGAGED IN AN ARGUMENT ABOUT THE DEFENDANT'S ALCOHOL PROBLEM. THE DEFENDANT WAS TAKING HIS DUI CLASSES ONLINE WHILE DRINKING ALCOHOL. VICTIM BECAME UPSET AND POURED THE ALCOHOL OUT ON THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT IN TURN STRUCK THE VICTIM HEAVILY IN THE FACE LEAVING MARKING ACROSS HER CHEEK AND JAW. THEN DEFENDANT DROVE THE VICTIM BACKWARDS INTO A DOOR SO HEAVILY IT CAUSED THE DOOR TO BREAK BOTH ON THE HINGES, AND ON THE BASE OF THE DOOR ITSELF. THE DEFENDANT THEN GRABBED THE VICTIM BY HER ARMS AND SHOVED HER OUT ONTO THE COUCH IN THE OTHER ROOM, PINNING HER DOWN AND TEARING AT HER CLOTHING. THE VICTIM'S CLOTHES WERE BADLY TORN IN THE PROCESS.

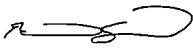

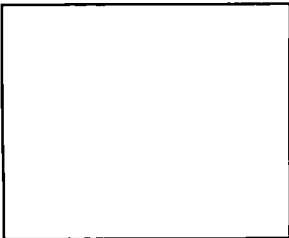
