The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did: The defendant was operating a black 2019 Toyota Camry, 4 door, Florida tag GPCC50. The defendant was stopped by TPD Officer M. Blasini (71552) for violation of right of way while entering a roadway from a parking lot. The defendant was very slow to respond to the indication given to stop, and ran over a raised curb during the stop. During the stop, the defendant presented his debit card when he had been asked for his driver license. Officer Blasini noted signs of impairment, and requested a DUI Investigator. The defendant had a distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath. The defendant's eyes were bloodshot, glassy, and watery. The defendant's face was flushed, and his speech was slurred. The defendant admitted to consuming alcoholic beverages tonight, but made confusing statements as to the amount consumed. The defendant's statements were contradictory as it related to times, locations, and consumption of alcohol, indicating perception and memory issues. The defendant was unsteady exiting the vehicle, and swayed noticeably while standing. The defendant agreed to perform Field Sobriety Exercises. The defendant exhibited signs and clues of impairment, and was arrested for DUI. Post arrest, the defendant continually asked repeating questions, even though the questions had been answered each time. The defendant provided breath samples of .201% BrAC and .216% BrAC. The defendant was positively identified by his FL DL.
