On the 28 day of March, 2021 at 23:45 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On March 28, 2021 at approximately 2052 hours, I responded to the parking lot of Trader Joes located at 855 S Federal Hwy Boca Raton, FL in reference to a 3-year-old child walking in the parking lot alone. The 3-year-old was wearing a large t-shirt and no pants or underwear. While units were enroute, dispatch advised that _____ was passed out in the driver seat of a 2020 white Hyundai (FL Tag- IMIH45).

Upon police arrival, the 3-year-old later identified as _____ was observed running around the Trader Joe's Parking lot unaccompanied by any adult. _____ was wearing a blue shirt and had no underwear or pants on. _____ later identified as Rachelle Ginsberg was observed standing outside her vehicle by the driver door. Officer Desiderato arrived on scene first and observed _____ running around the vehicle and running back and forth on the driver side into the lane of travel in the parking lot. Rachelle had no urgency to stop _____. She told him to stop but her movements were very slow and without care or concern for _____ get hit by a car. Rachelle finally grabbed _____ arm after Officers had to stress the severity of stopping him from running around. _____ was secured in his car seat in the vehicle. It should be noted that this parking lot borders Federal Hwy which is an extremely busy roadway. The City of Boca Raton regularly receives complaints about vehicles speeding along this roadway.

Witnesses, Amanda Daugherty, Katie Burke, and Carlie Cavarough stated they all arrived in the same vehicle together. When they walked into the store they did not notice if Rachelle's vehicle was there. They estimated they were in Trader Joes for approximately 20 minutes. When they exited the store, they saw _____ running around the parking lot by himself with no adult around. They then saw _____ running around Rachelle's vehicle with the driver door open. They advised that they observed Rachelle passed out in the front seat. They then asked a store employee to call which was placed at 2052 hours. The first officer arrived on scene at 2058 hours at which time _____ was still running in the parking lot. Based on everyone's statements and the time stamps it is estimated that

was in the parking lot unsupervised for approximately 10-15 minutes. Amanda, Katie and Carlie all gave sworn taped statements which were taken by Officer Desiderato on his MVR.

I read Rachele her Miranda Rights from a prepared text. Post Miranda, Rachele stated that her and [redacted] came from Bedner's Farm in Boynton Beach. When asked why [redacted] wasn't wearing any pants, Rachele stated that he got them wet and took them off (Rachele was able to show me his bathing suit in the vehicle). When I asked Rachele why she fell asleep she stated that he is exhausted and has not slept in two days. She went on to say that she has no help with [redacted] and is the only one that takes care of him. She lives alone in her apartment. When talking with Rachele she appeared to be under the influence of alcohol or an unknown drug. Her movements were slow and lethargic and her speech was slurred. She would sway back and forth when standing. Rachele stated she did not have anything to drink or take any type of narcotic. She also stated she is not prescribed any medication. Rachele estimated that she fell asleep for approximately 15 minutes when I asked her that question.

After questioning Rachele further, it was discovered that she was lying. Rachele does not live alone and does have help with care for [redacted]. [redacted] with her and they each [redacted] on separate days. [redacted] also pays Rachele \$5,700 a month [redacted]. Rachele then stated that she did have a couple alcoholic drinks while at Bedner's Farm. [redacted] was contacted by telephone and he further stated that Rachele is an alcoholic and most recently went to treatment about a month ago. Rachele admitted she did go to treatment a month ago when questioned about it. She further stated that she does need help with her addiction. Rachele stated she is stressed with her life and she copes by drinking alcohol.

[redacted] advised that he is currently in the Dominican Republic. He advised that [redacted] could take care of [redacted] until he gets back in town tomorrow. [redacted] responded to the incident location.

Department of Children and Families was notified (Tony #548). DCF responded out to the incident location to see [redacted] and meet with [redacted]. While getting [redacted] some clothes from the vehicle, an empty wine bottle was discovered underneath clothes on the front passenger seat. This was in arms reach of Rachele. [redacted] background check was negative. DCF will follow up with [redacted] in the future.

Based on my investigation, I developed probable cause to arrest Rachele for Child Neglect (F.S.S 827.03-3c) due to her failure to provide [redacted] with the care and supervision to maintain his physical well-being and safety. Rachele was placed into custody and transported to Palm Beach County Jail.
