D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

ON THE 08 DAY OF August 2020 AT 1149 A.M P.M.

PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I responded to the parking lot of 1501 Corporate Dr in reference to a Hit and Run Vehicular Crash. This incident occurred within the City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida.

Upon arrival I observed a Blue Honda Accord bearing Florida tag ELSV55 and a Gray Dodge Ram 1500 bearing Florida tag DGFS30. I made contact with the driver of the Honda, B/M Henry, Darius (12/09/93) who advised that while he was parked within the parking lot of 1601 S. Federal Highway (S. SR 5 – Marathon Gas Station) the Dodge backed up and struck the left front fender of his vehicle with the rear of the Dodge. Henry advised that the Dodge, later learned to be operated by W/M Rapposelli, Randy (10/19/87), failed to stop after the crash and fled westbound on Woolbright Rd. Henry advised that he had to follow Rapposelli in an attempt to stop him. When Rapposelli stopped at the red traffic light at Woolbright Rd and I-95, Henry advised that he was able to get Rapposelli's attention and both agreed to pull over. Henry advised that while speaking with Rapposelli he detected the odor of alcohol on his breath. Henry did not sustain any injuries. See BWC statement for further.

I then made contact with Rapposelli, who was sitting on the curb of the parking lot. Upon speaking with Rapposelli, he stood up at which time I noticed he had a difficult time keeping his balance. I asked Rapposelli if he was okay as a result of the crash, which he denies being involved in a crash. Rapposelli stated that he was coming from Saltwater, local Boynton Beach brewery; and denied being in the parking lot of Marathon. When I questioned Rapposelli about the damage to the rear of his vehicle, he denied that the damage was from the crash. Rapposelli was uncooperative with the crash investigation and denied the event. While speaking with Rapposelli, I detected the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath, which intensified as he spoke. Rapposelli's speech was thick and slurred and his eyes were bloodshot/glassy.

After inspecting both vehicles, the rear bumper of the Dodge was very dirty. There was new damage to the rear bumper, where the dirt was wiped off and blue paint transfer was attached to the chrome bumper. The Honda had front fender damage. The height of the Honda's fender was the same as the rear bumper of the Dodge. The damage was consistent to one another. Photos were taken of the damage to both vehicles.

Due to the above facts, I escorted Rapposelli to the front of my vehicle. I explained to Rapposelli that this investigation was being audio/video, which he stated that his understood. I attempted to gather further information in reference to the crash, but Rapposelli did not want to speak. At that time, I advised Rapposelli that I've concluding my crash investigation and was now conducting a DUI investigation, which he stated that understood. I read Rapposelli his Miranda Warnings, which he stated that he understood. Rapposelli advised that he was coming from his residence, which is across the street from the Marathon Gas Station. Due to the odor of the unknown alcoholic beverage, I asked Rapposelli has he consumed any alcoholic beverage today, which he stated yes. Rapposelli stated the he consumed four Corona beer cans between 2100hrs and 0000hrs. At this point I asked Rapposelli if he would Submit to a Series of Standardized Field Sobriety Task, which Rapposelli questioned why due to the fact that he was not driving. When I advised Rapposelli that Henry observe him driving at the time of the crash and on Woolbright Rd, he stated that Henry was lying. When I questioned how did his truck or how did he arrive to the parking, he couldn't recall. I then asked Rapposelli again, which he stated no. I then advised Rapposelli of his Taylor Warnings, which he stated that he understood. I then ask Rapposelli again, which he stated yes. Prior to beginning I asked Rapposelli if he had any disability and/or injuries I should be aware of, which he stated no.

Pen Exercise: During the task Rapposelli swayed in a circular motion.

WALK AND TURN:

The following task was demonstrated and explained to Rapposelli, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Rapposelli started too soon numerous times. Rapposelli had a difficult time keeping his balance. Rapposelli stated "I've done this before" and "I can't do this". During the walking stage, Rapposelli took 9 steps forward, missing heel to toe, stepping off the line and used his arms for balance. Rapposelli then took 7 steps back, missed heel to toe, stepped off the line and used his arms for balance.

ONE LEG STAND:

The following task was demonstrated and explained to Rapposelli, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Rapposelli swayed side to side. During the balancing stage, Rapposelli used his arms for balance, swayed, leaned, hopped and dropped his legs numerous times.

FINGER TO NOSE:

The following task was demonstrated and explained to Rapposelli, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage, Rapposelli swayed side to side. During the exercise stage, Rapposelli did not touch his nose on the first LEFT command, he held his arm to his side. Rapposelli missed his nose on the second LEFT command. Rapposelli swayed during the task.

ROMBERG/ALPHABET:

The following task was demonstrated and explained to Rapposelli, which he stated that he understood. During the instructional stage and exercise stage Rapposelli swayed side to side.

Based on the above facts Rapposelli was placed into handcuffs (D/L and Spaced) and arrested for suspicious of DUI. Rapposelli was then placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle (#4734) and transported to the Palm Beach County BAT facility. I arrived at the facility at 0100hrs, started my 20 minutes observations at 0109hrs and completed it at 0129hrs. Upon completion I requested Rapposelli to provide a sample of his breath to determine the alcohol content, which he refused. I then read Rapposelli Implied Consent, which he stated that he understood. I then asked Rapposelli a second time, which he refused again. I then read Rapposelli his Miranda Warnings again, which he stated that he understood. Q&As were completed.

During the tow inventory, three Corona beer cans were located in the back seat of the vehicle.


Driver license check on Rapposelli revealed that he had two prior DUI convictions in 2008.

Based on the above facts, Rapposelli was charged with 1M count of DUI W/ Property Damage pursuant with F.S.S. 316.193.3.C.1 and Leaving the Scene of Accident W/ Property Damage with F.S.S. Rapposelli was processed and later TOT PBCJ.
