On the <u>27</u> day of <u>June</u>, <u>2021</u> at <u>03:58</u> (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.) This vehicle v. pedestrian collision occurred on June 27th, 2021 at approximately 3:58 a.m. It occurred just West of the intersection of Okeechobee Blvd. and Spencer Dr. within the city limits of West Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida. Vehicle 1 (V-1) was a 2017 Black Audi A6, bearing Florida license plate Y51TIP. The driver of V-1 was Robert Gannon III (White Male, Date of Birth 10/21/1992). The pedestrian was Geraldo Vazquez (Hispanic Male, Date of Birth 7/27/1992). On June 27th, 2021, at 4:00 AM, West Palm Beach Police officers were dispatched to a vehicle versus pedestrian, hit and run collision in the eastbound lanes of the 2600 block of Okeechobee Boulevard. Upon arrival Ofc. Beesley #2220 located the pedestrian victim in the inside middle lane just West of Spencer Drive. Ofc. Beesley was approached by a witness who stated the first three characters of the license plate attached to the vehicle that struck the pedestrian was "Y51" and the vehicle was a black Audi. Shortly after Ofc. Beesley's arrival West Palm Beach Fire Rescue arrived, and trauma alerted the victim to St. Mary's Medical Center. Ofc. Conchoso #2143 made contact with a witness who would only give the first name of Amer. Amer stated the vehicle was a black 4 door Audi and he chased the vehicle to the entrance of City Side. The vehicle went inside the complex and they returned to the scene. Ofc. Skotske #2188 made contact with witness Ziad Qasim. Qasim stated he was stopped at Okeechobee Blvd. and Spencer Dr. facing West. He observed a black Audi collide with the victim and continue East on Okeechobee Boulevard. Qasim stated he made a U-turn and attempted to follow the Audi which continued to flee and run every red light. Qasim stated the Audi got to Congress Ave. and made a left running the red light. They continued to follow the Audi until it reached City Side and turned left into the community. Qasim stated he was able to get the first three characters of the license plate which was "Y51." After the Audi turned into City Side Qasim returned to the scene to provide aid to the pedestrian.

At 4:13 AM, As I began my preliminary walk through, I started West of the collision location and walked in an Eastern direction. I located three broken front grille pieces in the left turn lane and one front grille piece in the inside lane. A red right shoe was in the inside lane to the West of the vehicle parts. A red left shoe was in the inside middle lane to the East of the vehicle parts. I took a closer look at one of the broken grille inserts located in the left turn lane. The part had an imprint on the back with a part number. The part number was 4G0.807.681.AF LH. I researched this part number which came back to a 2016 to 2018 Audi A6 left side bumper grille. I completed a DAVID search for all Audi's registered in Palm Beach County with the first three license plate characters of Y51. This search revealed a black 2017 Audi A6 registered to 1730 Borrego Way, Apt. 1, West Palm Beach, FL 33401. The registered owner listed was Robert Hunter Gannon III (W/M 10/21/1992.) The address was confirmed to be inside the City Side development. I obtained a taped and sworn statement from Zyad Qasim. After being sworn in Qasim provided the following information. Qasim stated he and his friends were traveling West on Okeechobee Blvd., stopped in the left turn lane, waiting to make a U-turn at Spencer Drive. Qasim stated he saw a black Audi approaching Vazquez and they watched as the Audi struck Vazquez causing him to fly in the air. Qasim stated the black Audi slowed down after the collision then took off East. Qasim stated they made the U-turn and followed the Audi to get the tag number. Qasim stated the Audi was speeding and running red lights to get away. Qasim stated they got close enough to the Audi to get the tag but could only get the first three, "Y51" because it turned into City Side. Qasim stated they turned around and went back to the scene to check on Vazquez. At 6:14 AM Traffic Homicide Investigators cleared the collision scene and responded to 1730 Borrego Way, Apt. #1. Upon arrival I walked up to the sidewalk on the West side of the building and could see through the glass window. I could see two vehicles in the garage. The vehicle furthest from the window was a white Infinity Q50 and the vehicle closest to the window was a black Audi A6. The Audi had substantial damage to the windshield. At 6:32 AM Inv. David Streigold and I knocked on the front door of apartment 1. An unknown male answered the door. I stated I needed to speak with Mr. Gannon or the owner of the black 2017 Audi. The male resident stated it was his roommate's and went back upstairs to get him. Several minutes later Mr. Gannon came down to the first floor and made contact with us. As he walked down the stairs he stated, "Ah man." I asked him to step outside to talk to us and he complied. I asked Mr. Gannon if he knew why we were there and he stated, "yes sir." I notified Mr. Gannon I was asking for his consent to his vehicle. I advised him I would in no way force him to and it would be totally his decision. I asked Mr. Gannon where the keys to the vehicle were, and he stated in his pocket. At that time, Mr. Gannon reached into his left pocket, removed the keys, and handed them to me. Mr. Gannon escorted us into the house and straight into the garage.

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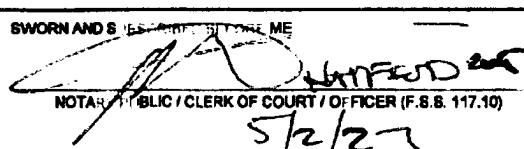
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Mr. Gannon opened the outer garage door. I asked Mr. Gannon if he would voluntarily come with us to police headquarters to discuss the incident and he replied, "yes sir." Inv. Streigold transported Mr. Gannon to the detective bureau. The vehicle was removed by Sheehan's Towing and towed to the West Palm Beach Police Department for processing. While at the West Palm Beach Police Department Detective Bureau Gannon was placed into interview room 2027. Inv. Streigold and I conducted the interview. Prior to any questions being asked Gannon was read the Miranda Warnings from an issued West Palm Beach Police Department Miranda Warnings card. Gannon verbally stated he understood and signed the Miranda card. I asked Gannon where he was coming from. Gannon stated he really did not know if he should say anything. He stated he really wanted to say everything but did not know if he should. Gannon requested to call his father at which point myself and Inv. Streigold stepped out of the room to allow the phone call. Gannon proceeded to make a phone call and stated, "Dad, I'm in trouble." "I'm at the police station right now." "I hit somebody with my car." "No, he's at St. Mary's." "I'm at West Palm, I haven't said anything, but I'm at West Palm." "I'm in the investigation room right now." "Dad, I can't say anything right now." "I don't know what to do man." "No" "They allowed me to call you." "They allowed me to call you so, I don't know what to do." "I don't know." "They read me the rights and started questions so I don't know if I should answer anything, and I asked if I could call you." "There was a pedestrian in the middle of the road." "I don't know if I should say anymore." "I don't know I just wanted to talk to you first." "Should I ask if you should come down here or a lawyer or something?" "Or should I start talking?" "Well, someone called it in and they came to the house this morning." "I didn't even know what hit me." "Yeah, I was alone." The rest of the conversation was the person on the other end of the phone asking if Gannon could get someone to talk to him on the phone. After the conversation Inv. Streigold and I went back into the room. Gannon stated his father wanted to know if he could come down. I advised Gannon that if his father came to the station either myself or Inv. Streigold would talk to him, but he would not be able to talk to Gannon in person and the only person he would be able to talk to was legal counsel. After consoling with his father, Gannon declined to give a statement. Gannon did sign the consent forms for us to obtain an oral buccal DNA swab, search the Audi, and download the EDR. Inv. Streigold obtained 2 oral buccal DNA swabs from Gannon. The swabs were placed into evidence. CSI Aisha Eckroth #2081 met with Inv. Streigold and Gannon in the booking area on the first floor. CSI Eckroth obtained 2 duplicate fingerprint standard cards, one left palm print card, and one palm print card from Gannon. Inv. Ingrassia made contact with St. Mary's Medical staff who advised the pedestrian was pronounced deceased at 8:58 AM. The Palm Beach County Medical Examiner's Office was notified. Elite Body Removal arrived and transported Ped1 to the Palm Beach County Medical Examiner's Office.									
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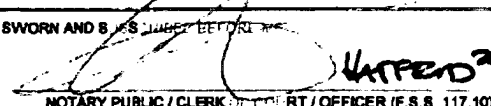

	On June 28th, 2021, I met with CSI Keith Kendrick #2014 in the basement of the West Palm Beach Police Department. CSI Kendrick processed the Audi, taking DNA swab samples from the interior driver door, steering wheel, gear shifter, and windshield. CSI Kendrick also processed the vehicle for latent prints. The processing of the vehicle was photographed by Kendrick. Once the processing was complete, I was able to match up the parts left at the scene to the front grille of the Audi. These comparisons were photographed by CSI Kendrick. Once the vehicle was processed completely, I conducted an EDR DLC download. The report concluded that no events were recorded. On July 8th, 2021, the following items were transported to the Palm Beach County Sheriffs Office Forensic Biology Unit: 2 DNA swabs from interior driver door, 2 DNA swabs from steering wheel, 2 DNA swabs from gear shifter, 2 DNA swabs from windshield, and 1 buccal swab from Gannon. On July 15th, 2021, Latent Print Examiner Ashley Perkins #2242 examined the latent cards submitted by CSI Kendrick and compared the cards to the fingerprint & palm print cards obtained by CSI Eckroth. The following results were reported by Perkins: Latent card numbered 1 is from the exterior top of the hood. The latent is identified as the right palm of Gannon. Latent card numbered 2 is from the exterior top of the hood. The latent is identified as the right palm of Gannon. Latent card numbered 3 is from the exterior top of the hood outside. The latents labeled A and B were both identified as the left palm of Gannon. Latent card numbered 4 is from the exterior top of window strip outside driver's door. The latent is identified as the right palm of Gannon. Latent card numbered 5 is from the exterior upper A pillar outside drivers' door. The latent is identified as the right palm of Gannon. Latent card numbered 6 is from the exterior outside lower A pillar. The latent is identified as the right palm of Gannon. The 7 positive identifications of Gannon possess ridge formations in sequence having sufficient and detectable uniqueness for individualization. The latent cards were retained in the crime scene investigations unit latent file for future reference. On October 6th, 2021, I obtained Padl's Pericardial DNA from the Palm Beach County Medical Examiner's Office. This item was brought back to the West Palm Beach Police Department and played into evidence.								
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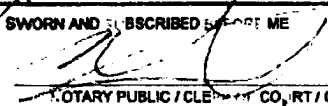
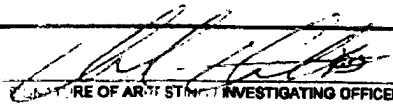
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On October 21st, 2021, Ped1's Pericardial DNA was transported to the PBSO Forensic Biology Unit by CSI Fisher. On February 23rd, 2022, I received the DNA analysis report from Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Forensic Scientist Marcel Burton. The results were as follows: Submission 1: Swabs from interior driver door Number of contributors: 2 A. Cannot be excluded: Robert Gannon III The DNA profile obtained is approximately 2E14 times more likely if it originated from Robert Gannon III and an unknown individual than if the DNA profile obtained originated from two unknown individuals in the population. This statistical result provides very strong support for the proposition that Robert Gannon III is a contributor to the DNA profile obtained. Submission 2: Swabs from steering wheel Number of contributors: 3 A. Cannot be excluded: Robert Gannon III The DNA profile obtained is approximately 3E9 times more likely if it originated from Robert Gannon III and two unknown individuals than if the DNA profile obtained originated from three unknown individuals in the population. This statistical result provides very strong support for the proposition that Robert Gannon III is a contributor to the DNA profile obtained. B. Cannot be excluded: Geraldo Vazquez The DNA profile obtained is approximately 3E14 times more likely if it originated from Geraldo Vazquez and two unknown individuals than if the DNA profile obtained originated from three unknown individuals in the population. This statistical result provides very strong support for the proposition that Geraldo Vazquez is a contributor to the DNA profile obtained. Submission 3: Swabs from gear shifter

This statistical result provides very strong support for the proposition that Geraldo Vazquez is a contributor to the DNA profile obtained. B. Excluded: Robert Gannon III Based on the facts and statements Robert Gannon III did drive a motor vehicle involved in a crash that occurred on public or private property which resulted in the death of Geraldo Vazquez or Robert Gannon III did willfully fail to immediately stop the vehicle at the scene of the crash or as close thereto as possible, or did willfully fail to remain at the scene of the crash until he or she fulfilled the requirements of Florida Statute 316.062, contrary to Florida Statute 316.027 (2) (a).
