(Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)</p> <p><b>On the above date and time, I was dispatched to 91 Bridgette Blvd., Greenacres, Palm Beach County, FL 33463 (Lago Palma Mobile Home Park) in reference to a aggravated assault call (see PBSO Case #21-022083). While en route to the call, the caller (W/F Rosa M. Vasallo 04/04/1956 AKA Ro Jimenez 04/19/1957) advised PBSO Dispatch that her neighbor (W/M Edward J. Taylor 04/14/1946) tried to run her over with his vehicle (2001 Silver Ford Explorer Sport Trac FL Tag 033 RSS).</b></p> <p><b>Upon arriving in the area, I made contact with the Vasallo who provided me with the following information:</b></p> <p><b>Vasallo advised that she was in the roadway taking a photo of a posting to boil water that was set up by management within the Lago Palma Mobile Home Park. Vasallo continued to advise that while she was taking the photo, Taylor drove right next to her and swerved towards her and continued to his home. Vasallo stated that while Taylor was driving by, he shouted "you lesbian!" and pulled into his driveway. Vasallo advised that she was not hit by the vehicle and that she had to jump out of the way just in case. Vasallo stated that Taylor was traveling northbound on Bridgette Blvd heading to his home. There was no further information provided.</b></p> <p><b>After speaking to Vasallo, I made contact with a resident (B/F Juana D. Diaz 10/03/1958) who advised that she saw what occurred. Diaz provided the following information to me:</b></p> <p><b>Diaz advised that she was inside her residence (located at 89 Bridgette Blvd) looking out of her kitchen window which faces Bridgette Blvd. Diaz continued to advise that she was waiting for her ride to pick her up. Diaz stated that while she was looking out the window, she saw Taylor's truck swerve towards Vasallo and she went outside to see what happened. Diaz continued to state that when she came outside, Vasallo was asking her if she saw what happened and that she was calling the police. Diaz advised that she did not hear Taylor shout anything. Diaz stated that Taylor was traveling northbound on Bridgette Blvd heading to his home. There was no further information provided.</b></p> <p><b>After speaking to Diaz, I made contact with Taylor who provided me with the following information:</b></p> <p><b>Taylor advised that he was returning home after buying pizza from Papa John's. Taylor continued to advise that he turned off of Lake Worth Rd and into the east entrance to the community. Taylor stated that as he was driving towards his home, he saw Vasallo walking in the middle of the roadway towards the billboard that was in the middle of the road. Taylor continued to state that Vasallo was on the left side of his truck as he was turning right to enter his driveway, and that Vasallo was about 5-10 feet away from his truck. Taylor advised that Vasallo was yelling something at him and he yelled back to her saying "shut-up you crazy bitch!". There was no further information provided.</b></p> <p><b>After speaking to all parties involved, I provided each of them with sworn written statements to fill out. While they were filling out their statements, I observed a residence located at 90 Bridgette Blvd that had video surveillance cameras pointing towards the roadway. There was no answer at the door. I left my business card with the case number for this incident. After gathering the sworn statement, Vasallo advised that she had a photo of the billboard and the car. Vasallo showed me the photo and I observed a gray Infiniti SUV that was traveling northbound on Bridgette Blvd as Vasallo was in the roadway taking the photo. I confirmed with Vasallo if that was the car she was reporting that almost hit her. Vasallo advised that it was not and that it was Taylor's truck that almost hit her and it was behind the SUV. I did not see Taylor's truck in the photo.</b></p> <p><b>On Tuesday 01/05/2021 at 1728hrs, I conducted a follow-up investigation to this case where I met with the homeowner of 90 Bridgette Blvd who provided with a copy of the video surveillance. The homeowner wished not to be involved with this case. Upon reviewing the video surveillance, I observed Vasallo walk eastbound from her residence onto the roadway and in front of Taylor's vehicle as he was driving into the community from Lake Worth Rd. Taylor quickly swerved his car to the right to avoid hitting Vasallo. At the same time that Taylor swerved his car away from Vasallo, she quickly turned around and swung at his car. Taylor stopped for a second and continued to turn right and pull into his driveway. After swinging at Taylor's vehicle, Vasallo continued walk southbound in the middle of Bridgette Blvd and stopped to take a photo of the information board and then proceeded to walk towards Diaz' residence. There was no further information provided.</b></p>

(Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)</p> <p>On Friday 01/08/2021 at 1006hrs, I along with D/S Lutz #7687 conducted another follow-up investigation to obtain sworn audio/video statements of both Vasallo and Diaz. Utilizing D/S Lutz's in-car camera system, I was able to obtain a sworn recorded statement from Vasallo. After Vasallo was sworn in on camera, she provided the exact same statement that she wrote on the day of the incident. While conducting the interview, Vasallo walked me through the events to include where she was standing and where she states that Taylor was driving. It should be noted that Vasallo advised that Taylor was driving from south to north on Bridgette Blvd and turned left from where I was standing in the video. It should also be noted that D/S Lutz's vehicle was parked in the same direction as the video camera on 90 Bridgette Blvd, and during the interview several cars drove in the same direction that Vasallo described on the January 4th; which was contrary to what was observed on the video surveillance. Vasallo and I walked back to the D/S Lutz' vehicle and Vasallo stated that after she was almost hit by Taylor, she walked over to ask Diaz if she saw what happened and advised that Diaz told her she did. I again swore Vasallo into her statement and concluded my interview.</p> <p>After speaking to Vasallo, D/S Lutz conducted a audio/video recoded interview with Diaz, the aforementioned witness in this case. The following is a brief synopsis of the sworn video recorded interview D/S Lutz conducted with Diaz. For a verbatim account, refer to her sworn statement. Diaz identified herself and raised her right hand to swear the testimony she was about to give was sworn, true, and correct.</p> <p>Diaz originally stated in a sworn written statement that she was standing at her kitchen window (which faces east onto Bridgette Boulevard) and witnessed her neighbor driving northbound on Bridgette Boulevard. As he passed her residence, she said she noticed her friend Rosa standing at the end of the median taking a photograph with her cell phone of the sign that stated "Boil water order in effect". As her neighbor Edward Taylor 4/14/46 passed Rosa, she originally stated that Ed swerved his vehicle to hit Rosa, causing her to jump out of the way. At the time of the incident on January 4th, 2021, no other independent witnesses were known and no surveillance video was recovered from any of the neighboring residences. Bother alleged victim and witness alleged that an aggravated assault with a deadly weapon had occurred.</p> <p>Reiterating the details regarding the closed circuit video evidence of the incident that occurred on January 4, 2021, it was discovered that Taylor entered the community form the "north" off of Lake Worth Road, and as he passed Vasallo's residence, she was in fact walking in the roadway and he is seen swerving to avoid hitting her, contrary to her statement that he attempted to hit her. He was in fact driving in the complete opposite direction and at no time attempted to swerve to hit Vasallo.</p> <p>When confronted with the above described information, Diaz recanted her story and stated that she in fact never witnessed the incident. When asked how she learned of what had happened, she stated that Vasallo came to her residence after being passed by Taylor and informed Diaz her version of the story and told her she (Vasallo) needed a witness, and "he" was going to get in trouble. Diaz said she went along with her story and "believed" what she said, resulting in an identical and even verbatim account of the incident. Diaz stated she did "lie" and was "sorry".</p> <p>After gathering both sworn video/audio recorded statements, it was determined that probable cause exists to place Vasallo under arrest for filing a false report to Law Enforcement on two occasions, being the original date of January 4, 2021, and again today January 8, 2021, alleging she was the victim of an aggravated assault with a deadly weapon by suspect Edward Taylor. Vasallo was placed in handcuffs and they were checked for proper fitting and double locked. Vasallo was transported to county jail for booking and processing.</p> <p>Based on my investigation regarding PBSO Criminal Case #21-022083, I find that Rosa M. Vasallo 04/04/1956 did, knowingly give false information to D/S A. Gonzalez, a law enforcement officer, on January 4, 2021 and January 8, 2021, alleging that she was a victim of aggravated assault, Pursuant to F.S. 837.05(1).</p>
