The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did The defendant was operating a white 2019 Volkswagen Jetta, 4 door, Florida temporary tag AB57668. The defendant struck a curb as she attempted to turn onto an interstate on ramp lane. This caused the vehicle to jump the curb, strike a black 10 foot metal pond retention fence, then strike a street illumination light pole. The light pole fell onto the top of the vehicle. The estimated damage to the fence is \$1000.00, while then estimated damage to the street illumination light pole is \$5,000.00 (both owned and maintained by the Florida Department of Transportation. TPD Officer S. Smith (72971) responded to the crash and observed the defendant in the driver seat of the vehicle, with the engine running, and no other occupants present. Officer Smith noted signs of impairment. I responded to the crash scene in my capacity as a DUI Investigator. I informed the defendant that the civil crash investigation was complete, and I was transitioning into a criminal DUI investigation. I read the defendant her Miranda Rights, to which she understood and agreed to speak to me without an attorney. The defendant stated that she had been driving. The defendant stated that she had consumed "four" alcoholic beverages today. The defendant had a strong and distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage on her breath. The defendant's eyes were bloodshot, glassy, and watery. The defendant's face was flushed, and her speech was moderately slurred. The defendant swayed while standing. The defendant agreed to perform Field Sobriety Exercises. The defendant exhibited signs and clues of impairment, and based on a totality of the circumstances she was arrested for DUI. The defendant provided breath samples of .243% BrAC and .236% BrAC. The defendant was positively identified by her Florida DL.
