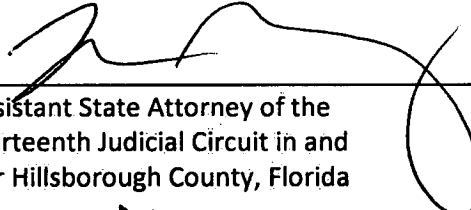

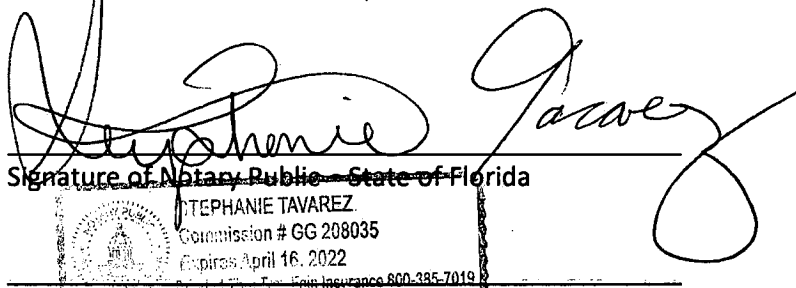

The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:
 On 12/31/2019 at approximately 0920 hours, certified K-9 handler Officer T. J. Donnelly (Delta 9) and K-9 Ikar conducted a random sweep of luggage at the Spirit Airlines ticket counter. During the operation, K-9 Ikar alerted on one (1) large black nylon luggage. This alert indicated the possible presence of narcotics. After the alert, Officer Donnelly called Detective Ewing, advising of the situation. Detective Ewing and the affiant responded to the location and met with the defendant later to be known as RYAN EDWARD MALONE. During the encounter, the affiant identified himself as a police detective and engaged in a consensual, non- custodial interview about his luggage. The affiant confirmed the listed luggage were in fact the defendant and explained to the him a police k-9 alerted on his bag for possible narcotics. The affiant asked the defendant if he would provide me consent to search the luggage in which he said "Yes". The affiant asked if he was in possession of any narcotics, defendant stated "Yes, a pen with THC". At the request of Detective Ewing, defendant opened the bag, retrieved a glass vial with a brown liquid (vape cartridge w/ possible THC) and handed the vial to Detective Ewing. Defendant confirmed the vape cartridge had THC and was the only narcotics he was in possession of. Defendant again gave consent for Detective Ewing to search his luggage to confirm his statement. A search of the luggage revealed no additional narcotics. Affiant requested the subjects identification in which he provided me a Florida driver's license issued to RYAN EDWARD MALONE, DOB 02/09/1990. The vape cartridge represented as containing the possible THC liquid was seized and a PL-84 property receipt was completed by the affiant and placed into evidence to lab test the THC level at a later date. Defendant continued with his travel.

On 01/10/2020, affiant removed the the vape cartridge from evidence for lab testing. The affiant transported the vape cartridge to ACS Laboratory to test for THC level.

On 01/14/2020, ACS Laboratory notified the affiant that the results were positive for liquid / oil THC at a 69.523% level.

Pursuant to Florida Statute §92.525 and under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing document and the facts stated in it are true to the best of my knowledge. For Notices to Appear, I also certify that a complete list of witnesses and evidence known to me is attached.
