The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe, and does believe that the above named Defendant committed the following violation of law. On the 14 day of March, 2021 at 00:48 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 3/13/2021, at approximately 2354hrs, I was dispatched to a minor traffic crash in the area of 5 N Ala, Jupiter, Palm Beach County, Florida. While enroute, Northcom advised the driver of the at-fault vehicle was trying to leave the scene but that the vehicle ended up staying. Upon arrival, I made contact with Officer Schneider, who advised that the driver was going eastbound into the parking lot when it struck a vehicle going westbound. The at-fault vehicle made a u-turn before stopping near the exit of the resort. I then made contact with the driver and passenger of the second vehicle, who told me a similar story of the crash. At this point, I made contact with the driver of the at-fault vehicle, who was positively identified as WM Ryan H. Borchers by his Florida Drivers License. Borchers explained he was pulling into the resort and wasn't very sure where he was but was trying to follow his GPS. Borchers explained he hit the other vehicle and turned around to make contact with the driver of the other vehicle. For more information regarding the traffic crash, see Jupiter Police Crash Report #21-000898. After the conclusion of the traffic crash investigation, I informed Borchers that I had completed the traffic crash investigation, and I found him to be at fault. Borchers was read his Miranda Warnings from a preprinted card. Borchers was then asked where he was coming from, and he showed me an address from West Palm Beach, Florida, and stated he was on his way to Boynton Beach, where he lives. Borchers explained that he only had one drink tonight, which he described as an 8oz Bud light. Borchers stated he was at a 1 on a scale of 1-10, with 1 being completely sober and 10 being the most drunk he has ever been. Borchers explained that he started drinking around 5 pm and only had one drink. Borchers stated it was about 10 or 11 pm when the actual time was after midnight. Borchers explained that he was taking blood pressure medication and had anxiety. While speaking with Borchers, I noticed the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his person. Borchers was unsteady on his feet and was swaying while standing still and was unsteady on his feet. Based upon my investigation up to this point, including Borchers getting into a crash, driving in the wrong direction (from West Palm to Boynton Beach), statements made by Borchers, my

<p> observations, and the totality of the circumstances, I believed that Borcherds might be too impaired to be driving. Borcherds was asked to conduct Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks to help make a determination if he was ok to be driving. Borcherds agreed to conduct SFSTs. Borcherds denied having any medical issues or injuries that would prevent him from doing SFSTs. Borcherds stated he was not under the care of a doctor or a dentist in the last 24 hours but did state he took blood pressure medication. While completing HGN, Borcherds failed to keep his head still and was not focusing on the light as instructed. Borcherds had to be reminded several times to keep his head still, follow the light with his eyes only, and keep his arms down by his side. Borcherds showed lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at max deviation, and onset of nystagmus prior to approx. 45 degrees. Borcherds was also swaying during the task. During the instruction phase of the Walk and Turn, Borcherds was unable to maintain the starting position and was stating he was too anxious to do the task. After attempting to give the instructions several times, Borcherds stated he was unable to do the task. Borcherds was advised that his failure to do the SFSTs could be used against him in any criminal proceeding and that he would be forcing me to make a determination on if I believed he was too impaired to be driving based upon my investigation to this point. Borcherds stated he understood and refused to continue with SFSTs. Based upon my entire investigation up to this point, I developed probable cause to arrest and charge Ryan H. Borcherds with DUI pursuant to Florida State Statutes. Borcherds was placed into two sets of handcuffs which were double locked and checked for spacing. Borcherds was advised he was being placed under arrest and was placed into the back seat of my patrol vehicle. During a search of his vehicle, I noticed a case of hard seltzer in the back seat floorboard, which appeared to have three cans missing. Located in the center console was one completely empty can consistent with the drinks from the box. Borcherds was later transported to Jupiter Medical Center for medical clearance. After a short time, Borcherds was cleared for transport to jail. Borcherds was asked to provide a lawful sample of his breath for the purposes of determining the alcohol content. Borcherds refused and was read implied consent from a preprinted paper. During implied consent, Borcherds stated he wanted a lawyer and that I no longer needed to read him implied consent. Borcherds was explained I had to finish reading, and once completed, Borcherds stated he understood and still refused to provide a sample of his breath. Borcherds was transported to the Jupiter Police Department temporary holding facility while the appropriate booking paperwork was completed. Borcherds was then later transported to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident. Borcherds vehicle was removed from the scene by East Coast Towing. </p>
