The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did Ybor Garage Security observed the defendant stumbling to her vehicle while appearing to be extremely intoxicated. They made contact with the defendant, they attempted to convince her to call a ride, but she instead became irate and refused. The defendant then got into her vehicle and began driving through the garage in a reckless manner, and nearly crashed her vehicle. Security called police, and officers made contact with the defendant as the garage exit. Upon making contact with the defendant, she was still in the driver's seat of her vehicle with the engine running. The defendant displayed several indicators of impairment, including: slurred speech, a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on her breath, bloodshot/glassy eyes, swaying as she stood, and unsteady on her feet. The defendant performed poorly on the SFSEs and was arrested for DUI. The defendant later submitted to the breath test, which had a BrAC of .193/.213. A computer check revealed the defendant was also driving in violation of her BPO only license. A search of the defendant's purse incident to her arrest, revealed a small torn corner of a sandwich baggie, containing one and a half rectangular yellow pills, stamped "R 0 3 9", which affiant recognized as Alprazolam 2mg, a scheduled controlled substance. Affiant confirmed the pill's identity via Drug.com. The defendant identified herself via her FL driver's license.
