The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:
 On 08/21/2020 at approximately 0926 hours, a citizen contact was made at 2625 I-75 S on a vehicle that had been reported as driving erratically by the complainant. Contact was made with the driver, Sean Michael Geisley, the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle. An odor associated with marijuana was detected emanating from the vehicle. There was a small clear plastic bag with a green leafy substance in plain view in the front cup holder of the vehicle and the driver was actively rolling a marijuana cigar (blunt). During the investigation, the driver asked to step out of the vehicle and was allowed to do so, at which point a clear plastic baggie containing two large brown crystal substance (pieces) fell out of the driver's front left shorts pocket. A search of the vehicle incident to arrest revealed a ziploc baggie with a large amount of green bars (pills), another small bag with brown crystal substance, and a digital scale and grinder. Post-Miranda, the defendant admitted the crystal substance was MDMA and the bars (pills) were Xanax. The defendant also admitted there was a shotgun and an AK-47 in the trunk of the vehicle and gave verbal consent to retrieve the firearms. The brown crystal substance tested positive for Methamphetamine/Ecstasy content via a field reagent test kit. The green bars (pills) were confirmed as Alprazolam via Poison Control Opr#33972. The defendant admitted he purchased the drugs with the intent to sell them. The defendant admitted the drugs and AK-47 belonged to him. The driver's identity was confirmed via his FL driver's license.
