

On 02/28/2020 at approximately 0106 hours, I was conducting routine patrols on S.R. 706 (E Indiantown Rd.) in the area of Intracoastal Pointe Dr. in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, FL. At the time, I was driving an unmarked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle (vehicle 1916), I was wearing a JPD uniform clearly identifying myself as a Jupiter Police Officer, and I was wearing my department-issued Axon body camera.

I observed a black 2016 Honda Pilot bearing FL tag # CRVJ12 traveling northbound, exiting the Waterway Park (3630 E Indiantown Rd.). I know this roadway to be a one-way, one lane trafficway for vehicles only traveling south, into the park. I observed the vehicle turn right (east) onto S.R. 706, in the outside eastbound lane. I followed behind the vehicle as it traveled eastbound over the Intracoastal Waterway bridge and it was traveling unusually slow (approximately 20 MPH in a posted 45 MPH speed zone).

I activated my overhead emergency lights and siren to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle and the vehicle stopped, facing east, in the outside eastbound right turn lane of S.R. 706 just west of the intersection with S US Highway 1 (S.R. 5).

I approached the vehicle on the driver side and made contact with the driver and sole-occupant of the vehicle. I identified the driver to be Sergio Acebal (w/m; 09/23/1962) by his valid Class E Florida driver license. Acebal spoke little English and I attempted to have a translator respond, but no Spanish-speaking units were available. When I advised Acebal the reason for the traffic stop, he advised he was following his GPS and repeated that the "park is closed." I attempted to explain to Acebal that he was traveling the wrong way on the road and he became increasingly more and more agitated. Acebal provided me with his driver license and registration documentation but did not provide his insurance.

I returned to my patrol vehicle and generated a citation for traveling the wrong way on

a one-way roadway. I walked back up to the driver side of the vehicle and attempted to hand Acebal his license and registration back. Acebal was visually upset and took several seconds to take the paperwork from my hands. Acebal eventually took the documentation and I began explaining the citation to him. Acebal began screaming that the "park is closed" and, due to his argumentative nature, I dropped the citation and Traffic Citation Guide in his lap.



Acebal grabbed both documents and violently threw them on the ground, out the open driver window. I advised Acebal he needed to pick up the paperwork or he would be cited for littering as well. Acebal became increasingly more aggressive, swinging his arms violently inside the vehicle and yelling. Acebal threw the gear shifter of his vehicle into park and exited his vehicle, still yelling.

Due to Acebal's behavior, I ordered him to turn around. Acebal refused. I grabbed Acebal's left wrist and he began actively resisting me by tensing the muscles in his arm and pulling away. I attempted to perform an arm bar takedown but lost my grip on Acebal's sweatshirt, as he was continually pulling away from me, attempting to get back into his vehicle.

Due to Acebal's actions, Officer Andreasen (my backup unit) deployed his taser (see supplement from Officer Andreasen). Both prongs struck Acebal in the front and, due to the taser deployment, I was able to gain Acebal's compliance. I escorted Acebal to the ground, on his chest, and secured him in handcuffs behind his back which were ultimately checked for proper spacing and double-locked to prevent tightening.

Palm Beach County Fire Rescue was called due to Acebal initially refusing to cooperate with my efforts to place him in the recovery position. Eventually Acebal complied and I was able to sit him up prior to Fire Rescue arriving. Due to the fact that Acebal was now being somewhat compliant, Fire Rescue was cancelled, as I was preparing to transport Acebal to the hospital myself.

Due to the aforementioned facts resulting from my investigation, I find Probable Cause to charge Sergio Acebal with Resist Officer without Violence pursuant to FSS 843.02.





On 02/28/2020 at approximately 0106 hours, I was conducting routine patrols on S.R. 706 (E Indiantown Rd.) in the area of Intracoastal Pointe Dr. in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, FL. At the time, I was driving an unmarked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle (vehicle 1916), I was wearing a JPD uniform clearly identifying myself as a Jupiter Police Officer, and I was wearing my department-issued Axon body camera.

I observed a black 2016 Honda Pilot bearing FL tag # CRVJ12 traveling northbound, exiting the Waterway Park (3630 E Indiantown Rd.). I know this roadway to be a one-way, one lane trafficway for vehicles only traveling south, into the park. I observed the vehicle turn right (east) onto S.R. 706, in the outside eastbound lane. I followed behind the vehicle as it traveled eastbound over the Intracoastal Waterway bridge and it was traveling unusually slow (approximately 20 MPH in a posted 45 MPH speed zone).

I activated my overhead emergency lights and siren to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle and the vehicle stopped, facing east, in the outside eastbound right turn lane of S.R. 706 just west of the intersection with S US Highway 1 (S.R. 5).

I approached the vehicle on the driver side and made contact with the driver and sole-occupant of the vehicle. I identified the driver to be Sergio Acebal (w/m; 09/23/1962) by his valid Class E Florida driver license. Acebal spoke little English and I attempted to have a translator respond, but no Spanish-speaking units were available. When I advised Acebal the reason for the traffic stop, he advised he was following his GPS and repeated that the "park is closed." I attempted to explain to Acebal that he was traveling the wrong way on the road and he became increasingly more and more agitated. Acebal provided me with his driver license and registration documentation but did not provide his insurance.

I returned to my patrol vehicle and generated a citation for traveling the wrong way on a one-way roadway. I walked back up to the driver side of the vehicle and attempted to hand Acebal his license and registration back. Acebal was visually upset and took several seconds to take the paperwork from my hands. Acebal eventually took the documentation and I began explaining the citation to him. Acebal began screaming that the "park is closed" and, due to his argumentative nature, I dropped the citation and Traffic Citation Guide in his lap.

Acebal grabbed both documents and violently threw them on the ground, out the open driver window. I advised Acebal he needed to pick up the paperwork or he would be cited for littering as well. Acebal became increasingly more aggressive, swinging his arms violently inside the vehicle and yelling. Acebal threw the gear shifter of his vehicle into park and aggressively exited his vehicle, still yelling.

Due to Acebal's behavior, I ordered him to turn around. Acebal refused. I grabbed Acebal's left wrist and he began actively resisting me by tensing the muscles in his arm and pulling away. I attempted to perform an arm bar takedown but lost my grip on Acebal's sweatshirt, as he was continually pulling away from me, attempting to get back into his vehicle.

Due to Acebal's actions, Officer Andreasen (my backup unit) deployed his taser (see supplement from Officer Andreasen). Both prongs struck Acebal in the front and, due to the taser deployment, I was able to gain Acebal's compliance. I escorted Acebal to the ground, on his chest, and secured him in handcuffs behind his back which were ultimately checked for proper spacing and double-locked to prevent tightening.

I transported Acebal to the Jupiter Medical Center where he was medically cleared for transport to jail. I ultimately transported Acebal to the Palm Beach County Jail where he was booked for Resisting Arrest without Violence without further incident.

On 02-28-2020 at approximately 0106 hours, Officer Yochum initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle bearing Florida tag CRVJ12. I responded to back up Officer Yochum. It should be noted I pulled over the same vehicle and driver at 0040 hours. The driver identified as Sergio Acebal, 09-23-62, FL DL# A-214-792-62-343-0, was visibly agitated when I stopped him and using Google translate explaining what he did wrong and that he was not getting a ticket, Acebal was still agitated.

Officer Yochum went to issue Acebal a citation as I was standing on the passenger side of Acebal's vehicle. Acebal starting yelling, flailing his arms around, then throwing the ticket and citation pamphlet out the drivers window. Acebal then slammed the vehicle into park. I then started around the rear of the vehicle toward the drivers side. Acebal was still yelling and Officer Yochum told Acebal he was going to pick it up. As I approached the drivers door, Acebal was still yelling and seemed even more agitated. Acebal was now standing outside of the vehicle yelling and leaned toward Yochum. Yochum told Acebal to turn around and used his hand to guide Acebal.

Acebal then pulled away yelling more. Yochum told Acebal several more times to turn around. Then Yochum attempted to take Acebal to the ground simultaneously I powered on my taser. Acebal tensed and pulled away from Yochum defeating Yochum's control. I then stated taser and deployed my taser striking Acebal in the left thigh and left chest/rib area. The taser caused Acebal to fall back in his vehicle. After the cycle ended Acebal stood up as Yochum took Acebal to the ground. Acebal yelled and was not totally compliant, therefore i cycled my taser again. It appeared a probe dislodged however Acebal went to the ground. Due to Acebal's proximity to the open door, I used my foot to control Acebal's legs near his calves keeping the Taser a safe distance from Acebal. I called out taser deployment on the radio and asked for a Supervisor. Officer Yochum was then able to handcuff Acebal. I broke off the leads near my taser as Acebal was now in custody.

I then called for a tow truck by rotation, East Coast Towing responded. I completed a vehicle tow slip with inventory. This completes my involvement.
