Probable Cause Affidavit

Before me this date personally appeared OFC R GUE, who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on the 17th day of March, (year) 2017, at (crime location) 10109 Cleary BLVD, the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe the same are as follows

On 3/17/17, I responded to 10193 Cleary BLVD (Shell Gas Station) in reference to a suspicious vehicle. The reporter (redacted employee) advised that a black vehicle (Black 4-door Acura, FL tag PG025J) was parked in front of pump 5 for approximately 30 minutes. (redacted) advised that she was concerned because of recent robberies of Shell gas stations. Upon arrival in the area, I observed the black Acura driving toward the dumpster on the east side of the gas station. The driver (later identified as Shelby McKinstry) exited the vehicle and noticed my marked police unit (965). She then immediately re-entered the vehicle. The vehicle backed up and parked in front of the gas station. The front passenger (later identified as Abby Redlawski) then exited the vehicle and walked to concession window of the Shell. As I begin to approach the vehicle, the passenger was returning to the vehicle.

**Probable Cause Affidavit
(Continuation)**

Before me this date personally appeared OFC R GUE, who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on the 17th day of March, (year) 2017, at (crime location) 10109 Cleary BLVD, the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe the same are as follows

I stood next to the right rear tire of the vehicle and issued loud verbal command to the driver to roll down the window of the vehicle for safety reasons, but she ignored my commands. At time, the passenger had already returned to the vehicle, and she opened the passenger door to enter the vehicle. As Redlawski opened the front passenger door, I could smell a strong odor of fresh cannabis emitting from the vehicle. Redlawski entered the vehicle, and the driver rolled down the front windows. I informed both occupants that I could smell the odor of cannabis emitting from the vehicle, and I asked them to exit the vehicle.

McKinstry complied and immediately exited the vehicle. However, Redlawski ignored my command and refused to exit the vehicle. I asked Redlawski to exit the vehicle again and informed her that she will be removed from the vehicle if she continued to ignore my command. Redlawski again refused to exit the vehicle. I reached into the vehicle and grab Redlawski's left arm in an attempt to help her out of the vehicle, however, she turned her body and purposely stuck my left upper leg against my will with the sole of her right foot. At the time, I was wearing my PPD issued police uniform which clearly identifies me as a police officer. Redlawski was then removed from the vehicle, she started to tense and pull her arm away in order to resist officers from placing her under arrest. She was then directed to a prone position in order to prevent her from injuring herself or officers as she was taken into custody.

Once in custody, Redlawski indicated that the cannabis was in the glove compartment of the vehicle. I looked in the area indicated by Redlawski and retrieved a ziplock-like bag containing a green leafy substance which I identified to be cannabis based on my experience. The substance was later field tested positive for cannabis using the Lynn Peavey Marijuana QuickCheck test kit. It was later weighed at 0.9 gram and placed into PPD Property as evidence. A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed five black garbage bags containing unopened mails from different cities.

Ofc K Maher read both McKinstry and Redlawski their Miranda rights. Redlawski advised that she did not want to speak with officers without a lawyer present. However, McKinstry agreed to speak with officers.

McKinstry advised that she knows Redlawski from Detroit. They both flew to Fort Lauderdale on Wednesday (3/15/17) and met with a black male (only known to her as Devin). Devin rented a room for them at a Sheraton Hotel and left the vehicle with them. McKinstry described Devin as a black male bald head, approximately 6'00" and 220 lbs, and no visible tattoos. Today, she drove to different neighborhoods that Redlawski directed her to, and Redlawski collected the mails from different mailboxes. McKinstry stated that she only drove the vehicle, and Redlawski was the one who collected the mails. McKinstry also later gave a voluntary sworn taped statement in reference to the incident. The statement was later uploaded to the PPD server for transcription.

Before me this date personally appeared OFC R GUE, who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on the 17th day of March, (year) 2017, at (crime location) 10109 Cleary BLVD, the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe the same are as follows

US postal Inspector Brian McCarthy (ID 5788) responded to the scene to collect the mail that was in the vehicle in order to continue his investigation (case 17-0297)

Ofc M lasillo selected several package that were inside the vehicle and responded to the addresses on the packages where he made contact with the following victims who reported that their mail were stolen

1) [REDACTED] (see case # 1703-000832) The packages contained a [REDACTED] Medecine (\$30 00), and 3 Apple USB cables (\$30 00)

2) [REDACTED] (See case# 1703-000833) The package contained an [REDACTED] pack (\$10 00)

3) [REDACTED] (See case# 1703-000834) The packages contained a phone case (\$30 00), a 3-pack glass protector (\$50 00), a custom piece of jewelry (\$5 00), and a baby outfit (\$10 00)

4) [REDACTED] (see case# 1703-000835) The package contained two Heartguard dog medicine (\$120 00)

5) [REDACTED] (see case# 1703-000838) The package contained six burlap sacks (\$30 00)

All victims advised that there were expecting their packages, and no one else had permission to remove their packages

Both McKinstry and Redlawski were placed under arrest and transported to the PPD jail for processing Postal Investigator McCarthy later took custody of Redlawski

McKinstry was transported to Westside General Hospital and later to BSO Main jail for Booking
