On the 12 day of April, 2022 at 21:40 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.) On 04/12/2022 at approximately 2140 hours, this Officer was conducting speed measurement enforcement in the area of the 12200-block of N Military Trl, PBG, FL, when a vehicle was observed traveling at an increased rate of speed south bound. Body worn camera and in car video were used in the investigation. This Officer's initial visual estimation of the vehicle, was 95 MPH in a posted 45 MPH zone. Using RADAR Stalker DSR2X (DB001317), front antenna (KC086606) this Officer received a steady tone and reading of 95 MPH. The RADAR calibration was last checked on 11/19/2021 and was due on 05/19/2022. Prior to this tour of duty on this date, this Officer ensured the RADAR was in working order, to confirm the accuracy of the unit. At the end of this tour of duty, this Officer did the same. This Officer received RADAR/LIDAR certification on 05/31/2008, in Cannon AFB, NM. This Officer entered the lane behind the vehicle and observed the vehicle immediately press the brakes to decrease in speed. This Officer caught up to the vehicle, a Lexus utility vehicle (EQM12/FL) in the area of N Military Trl, just north of Kyoto Gardens Av and attempted to initiate a traffic stop on same by activating overhead red and blue lights. The vehicle continued south bound at approximately 30 MPH with the right turn signal activated. The vehicle eventually stopped at a red light for the intersection of Garden Lakes Dr. This Officer approached the vehicle, which still had driver window closed. This Officer observed the driver forward and appeared spaced out. This Officer knocked on the window which startled the driver and asked her to put the window down, to which she complied. This Officer made contact with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, identified via Florida Driver License photo, Stephanie Coe (OF) while she was still in actual physical control of same. Coe had glassy watery eyes, flushed red face, and appeared disoriented and confused. This Officer was also able to detect the obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage

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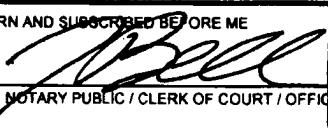

emanating from her breath at conversational distance. Coe argued traveling 95 MPH and said she was coming from work. Coe then said she was coming from "1000 North". Coe denied consuming alcohol on this night. Based on this Officers observations, Coe was asked to exit the vehicle to participate in Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises, to which she complied. Coe said she did not have any medical conditions which would affect the exercises performed. This Officer afforded Coe the opportunity to remove her high-heeled shoes, to which she declined. The first exercise conducted, was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. The stimulus used, was a Toxoptix X3 with an illuminated red light. This Officer observed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes and sustained involuntary jerking in both eyes at maximum deviation. Coe also had Vertical Gaze Nystagmus in both eyes. The second exercise conducted, was the Walk and Turn. The line used was a strip of yellow tape placed upon the pavement by this Officer. Coe immediately started walking down the line before being told to do so. While this Officer was still instructing Coe, she exited the starting position and had to be told to get back into the position. During the first set of steps, Coe missed heel-to-toe once. Coe conducted an improper turnaround by spinning around rather than taking a series of small steps. During the return set of steps, Coe took eight steps rather than nine, however counted nine. The third exercise conducted, was the One-Leg Stand. Coe raised her right foot for the exercise. Coe raised her right hand more than six inches from her side and swayed. Coe also raised her foot less than six inches from the ground and was not looking at her raised foot. The fourth exercise conducted, was the Finger to Nose. During the exercise, the following observations were made: First command of Left, Coe used the pad of her finger to touch her nose. The first command of Right, Coe touched under the tip of her nose. The second command of Left, Coe used the pad of her finger to touch her nose and opened her eyes. All subsequent commands, Coe used the pad of her finger to touch her nose. This Officer also observed Coe to have eyelid flutters in both eyes as well as body tremors. Based on this Officers observations Coe was placed under arrest at 2154 hours. During a tow inventory of the vehicle, this Officer discovered contraband. In Coe's purse, located on the front passenger seat, this Officer located a clear vape cartridge containing a thick brown liquid. This substance later field tested positive for Tetrahydrocannabinol. Also located on the front passenger seat was a gray laptop bag. At the bottom of the bag, this Officer located a single blue oval pill stamped "b 972" and "10", this pill was determined to be Amphetamine and Dextroamphetamine 10mg.

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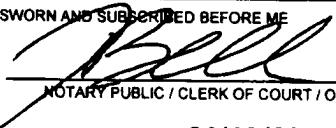

At 2258 hours she blew .077 and at 2301 hours she blew .077. It should be noted, these breath results were more than an hour after the arrest. This Officer then requested Coe to provide a urine sample for the purpose of detecting the presence of chemical or controlled substance(s), to which she agreed to do so. At 2307 hours, Coe provided a urine sample. Based on the results of the investigation, this Officer has probable cause to prove Stephanie Coe operated a motor vehicle, in the state of Florida, while under the influence of alcohol to the extent her normal faculties were impaired, in violation of FSS 316.193(1)(A). Coe was also in possession of two banned substances in violation of FSS 893.13(6)(A).
