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On the above date and time, I Trooper Kuebler, I.D #1337, heard a BOLO over the radio by the Lake Worth Regional Communications Center (LWRCC), that there was a silver pickup truck that was traveling southbound on State Road 91 (Florida Turnpike) at the approximate 123 mile marker that was all over the road and swerving. I advised LWRCC that I was going to be at the 116 mile marker to keep a look out for the BOLO vehicle that was continuing south. LWRCC advised that the pick up truck had a bearing Iowa tag of (2DLAYK) which came back to a silver 2015 Toyota pickup truck. At around approximately 5:41 PM, I observed the silver Toyota pickup truck pass my location at the 116 mile marker. I advised the LWRCC that I was going to try to catch up to the pickup truck. At around approximately 5:43PM, I was able to catch up to the silver Toyota pickup truck, where then I began to observe the driving pattern of the vehicle. I observed the vehicle all over the road, swerving going from lane to lane. I observed the vehicle to go off the right hand paved shoulder of the roadway. At that time, I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle southbound on State Road 91 at the 113 mile marker off the right hand paved shoulder. I made contact with the driver, who I identified by his Iowa license (242AN0977) as Mr. Steven Matthew Matera. While making contact with Mr. Matera he had a hard time finding his license. I asked Mr. Matera if he had taken any medications and or alcohol. Mr Matera stated that he had taken medication a few hours prior to the time of making contact with him. While I was continuing to make contact with Mr. Matera I could smell a slight odor of alcohol admitting from the vehicle. Mr. Matera was traveling by himself with no other passengers in the vehicle. Shortly after, Trooper Leslie, I.D #1460 arrived on scene to assist. I asked Mr. Matera to step out of the vehicle so I could observe him better. As I was speaking to Mr. Matera outside of the vehicle he would stumble around and would at times appear to lose his balance while walking. While continuing to speak to Mr. Matera, I could smell a stronger odor of alcohol admitting from his body and person.

At this time, I asked Mr. Matera if he would be able to perform a series of Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's), to which he understood and also complied. During the SFSE's, Mr. Matera performed poorly throughout the investigation. Mr. Matera was unable to follow some instructions properly and poorly performed the

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series of SFSE's that he was instructed to perform, which were the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) and Vertical Gaze Nystagmus (VGN), Walk and Turn, and One-Leg Stand.

At the conclusion of my criminal investigation for DUI, I placed Mr. Matera under arrest for the suspicion of Driving Under the Influence of alcohol and or narcotics, at approximately 6:18 PM.

At approximately 6:37 PM, Mr. Matera was transported to the Palm Beach County Jail. I arrived at the Palm Beach County jail at 7:07 PM, where I conducted a 20 minute observation of Mr. Matera, where he did not drink or ingest any foreign objects. Mr. Matera consented to give a breath sample.

The first breath sample was 0.189 and the second breath sample was a 0.186.

Mr. Matera was finally processed and booked into the Palm Beach County Jail for DUI.

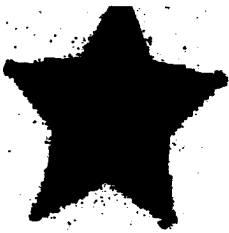

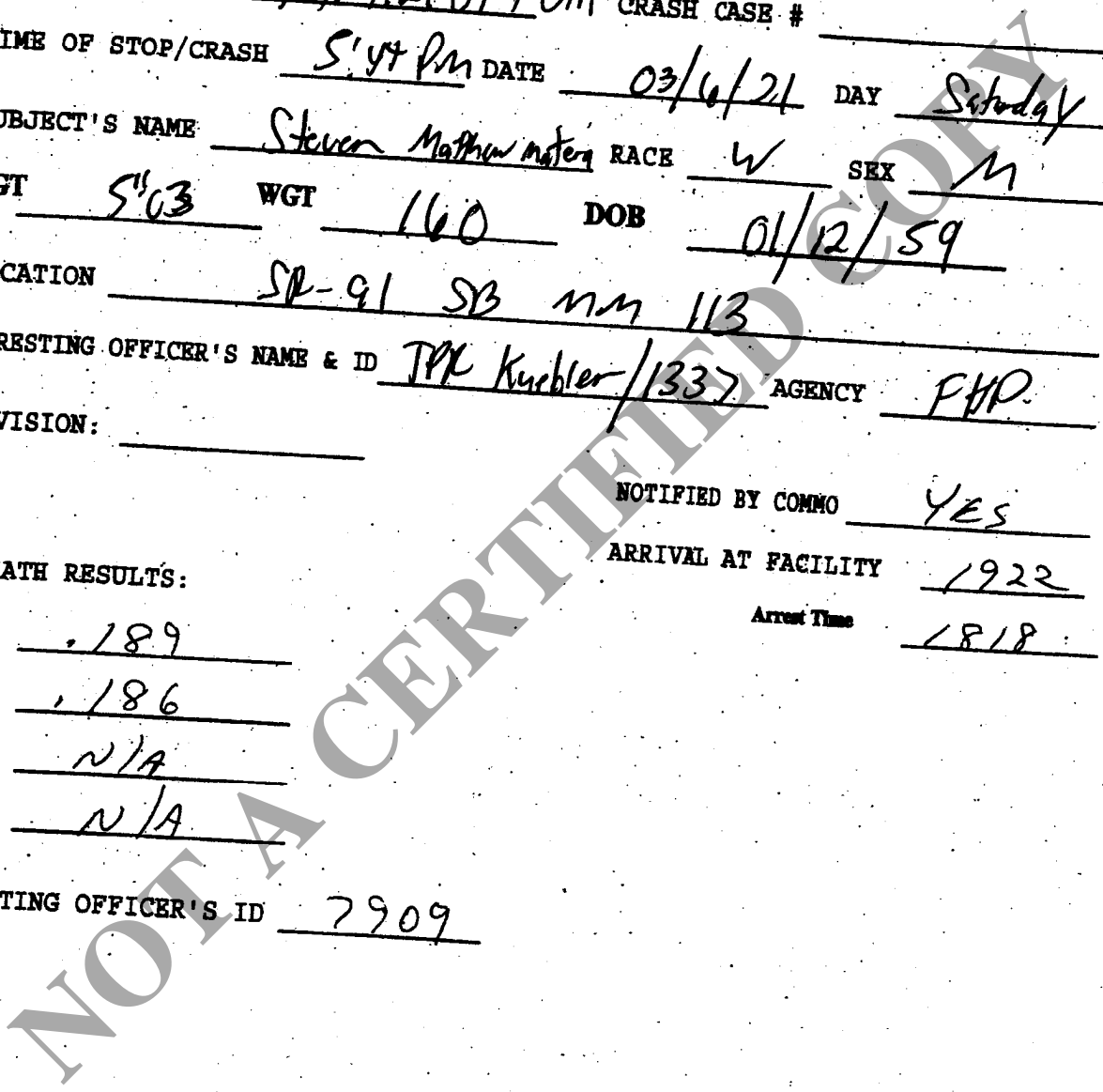
