I saw a white pick up truck pull into the parking lot of the community pool. It stayed there for approximately 5 minutes and then started to come back out. I sat at the stop sign for several more minutes and I became concerned as there had been auto burglaries in the area recently. As Sgt. Pickert and I drove East on Woodlake Blvd, the truck made a left turn onto Woodlake Blvd (heading West). He drove fully onto the grass and sidewalk area on the right side of the road, and then returned to the roadway. I activated my emergency lights and the truck came to a stop.

I approached the truck and found a white male, later identified as Stewart Higgins 12/9/68 in the drivers seat. I immediately smelled the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the truck. I asked Higgins if everything was ok and he said yes. I asked him about driving on the grass and he said he was avoiding the other patrol car, which had never left its lane of travel. Higgins appeared to be slurring his words and fumbled with his wallet to produce his drivers license.

Investigator Lynch then responded to conduct a DUI investigation.

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: Actual physical control (physical evidence or statements putting def. behind wheel of vehicle)

On 3/17/20 I responded to Woodlake Blvd/ Jog Rd, in Palm Beach County, in reference to a traffic stop, with a possibly impaired driver. Upon arrival I met with Sgt. Aultman id 24978, who conducted the stop.

Sgt. Aultman advised that while on routine patrol he observed a white Chevrolet pick-up truck, bearing SC tag RXY172, pull into the parking lot of the community pool. It stayed there for approximately 5 minutes and then started to come back out. Sgt. Aultman became concerned as there had been auto burglaries in the area recently. As Sgt. Aultman and Sgt Pickert drove East on Woodlake Blvd, the truck made a left turn onto Woodlake Blvd. (heading West). The pick-up drove fully off the road, onto the grass and sidewalk area on the right side of the road, and then returned to the roadway. Sgt. Aultman activated his emergency lights and conducted a traffic stop. Sgt. Aultman made contact with the driver, Stewart Higgins. Sgt. Aultman immediately smelled the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the truck. Sgt. Aultman asked Higgins about driving on the grass and he said he was avoiding the other patrol car (Sgt. Pickert). Sgt. Aultman advised that Sgt. Pickert had never left his lane of travel. Higgins appeared to be slurring his words and fumbled with his wallet to produce his driver's license.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I met with Higgins, who was seated in the driver seat of his truck. Higgins advised that he had no medical issues and did not take any medications. Higgins admitted that he made a wide turn causing him to run off the road. I observed Higgins's eyes to be glassy and there was a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his breath, which got stronger when he spoke. Higgins admitted to drinking prior to driving and stated he had a couple drinks at dinner and then went out and had a couple more. Higgins stated his last drink was approximately an hour and a half prior. I had Higgins exit his truck and stand in front of my patrol car. While exiting Higgins used the door for balance. While standing still Higgins's exhibited a sway. Based on my observations and Higgins's admission to drinking prior to driving I asked him to perform standard field sobriety tasks.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Higgins stated he had a couple drinks at dinner and then went out and had a couple more. Higgins stated his last drink was approximately an hour and a half prior.

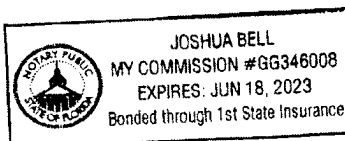

Other Observations:

Higgins was asked to stand with his feet together and place his hands by his sides. Higgins was asked to focus on the stimulus and follow it with his eyes. Higgins was told not to move his head to assist in following the stimulus. I observed a lack of smooth pursuit in both of Higgins's eyes and distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation. I observed onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. I observed no vertical nystagmus in either of Higgins's eyes. During the task Higgins had to be reminded not to move his head, and Higgins separated his feet for balance. Throughout the task Higgins exhibited a sway.

WALK & TURN:

I utilized a yellow duct tape to make a straight level, which was free of debris, that Higgins advised he could see. I explained and demonstrated the task to Higgins. During the instructions Higgins was unable to maintain the instructions stance, stepping out of the position several times. After completing the instructions Higgins advised he understood and had no questions. During the task Higgins missed heel-to-toe steps and stepped off the line, several times. Higgins used his arms for balance, paused to steady himself. Higgins did not turn as instructed.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the task to Higgins. After completing the instructions Higgins advised he understood and had no questions. During the task Higgins exhibited a sway, and used his arms for balance. Higgins put his foot down several times prior to 30 seconds elapsing.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the task to Higgins. After completing the instructions Higgins advised he understood and had no questions. During the task, on the first left Higgins failed to return his hand to his side, after touching his nose, and asked if he was supposed to keep his finger on his nose. Higgins missed touching the tip of his nose several times, and used the pad of his finger to touch his nose. Higgins failed to keep his eyes closed throughout the task. Throughout the task Higgins exhibited a sway and separated his feet for balance.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Prior to beginning Higgins confirmed he knew the entire alphabet, in order. Higgins stated that he knew the alphabet but not the English alphabet. Higgins then confirmed that he knew the alphabet in English. I explained and demonstrated the task to Higgins. After completing the instructions Higgins advised he understood and had no questions. During the task Higgins exhibited a sway. Higgins failed to recite the alphabet correctly stopping after letter "V". Higgins then started again at letter "S" and completed the alphabet.

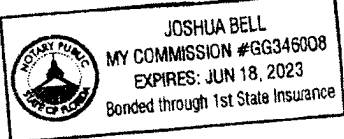
