The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

On August 19, 2020 at approximately 0041 hours, numerous concerned citizens called H.C.S.O. regarding a silver Nissan Pathfinder bearing Florida tag: JLEP52 (V.I.N.:5N1DR2CN2LC579498) stopped at the traffic light with a male passed out behind the wheel. The vehicle missed numerous cycles of the traffic light. Deputy D. Goff was flagged down by a citizen on the roadway who brought his attention to the stopped Nissan. As Deputy Goff made contact with the driver/defendant he observed him passed out behind the wheel with the engine on and the gear selector in drive. When Deputy Goff woke the defendant by tapping on the driver side window, he woke and released his foot from the brake and the Nissan rolled forward and hit a fully-marked H.C.S.O. patrol vehicle's front bumper. After Deputy Goff ensured the defendant was not having a medical emergency, he detected indicators of impairment. The affiant responded to the scene and on contact with the defendant, she observed indicators of impairment to include bloodshot glassy eyes with droopy eyelids and eyelid tremors, he could not stand still, he spoke with slurred speech and had cotton mouth, and he had an overall lethargic appearance. The affiant requested the defendant perform field sobriety exercises which he agreed to do. Throughout the field sobriety exercises, the defendant displayed additional indicators of impairment and was subsequently arrested for Driving Under the Influence. After a proper twenty-minute observation period was conducted, the defendant provided two lawful breath samples of .000/.000% B.A.C. respectively. Given the indicators of impairment did not match the level of impairment observed, the affiant requested the defendant provide a lawful urine sample which he refused to provide even after Implied Consent was read at 0229 hours. A DAVID inquiry yielded the defendant has one prior Driving Under the Influence offense and one prior Driving While License Suspended offense. The defendant identified himself via United States Passport.

Pursuant to Florida Statute §92.525 and under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing document and the facts stated in it are true to the best of my knowledge. For Notices to Appear, I also certify that a complete list of witnesses and evidence known to me is attached.
