The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

I was traveling east on State Road 674 west of Cypress Village Blvd, when I observed a grey Ford SUV, also traveling east roll through the steady red traffic signal at Cypress Village Blvd. I activated my emergency lights and the vehicle eventually pulled over to the right shoulder of State Road 674 west of Cortaro Drive.

I approached the vehicle on the driver's side and observed a white male with no shirt seated in the driver's seat. The male, who I later identified as Thomas Rahaw by his Florida DL, responded slowly to commands. I watched as he fumbled looking for his driver license, even though it was clearly visible in his wallet. I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle. I listened to him talk and his speech was slurred. I asked Mr. Rahaw to exit the vehicle and to walk towards the rear of his vehicle. While Mr. Rahaw was outside his vehicle, I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath.

I conducted a DUI investigation on Mr. Rahaw and his results were consistent with that of an impaired person. I placed him under arrest and transported him to the Hillsborough County Jail.

All events were captured on in-car video.
