In my marked PBSO vehicle, I activated my emergency lights and conducted a traffic stop on said vehicle.

I made contact with the driver of the vehicle identified by his Florida driver s license as Todd Charles Hautamaki D.O.B 11/05/92. I asked Todd if there was a reason he didn't wait for the light to turn green. He replied by saying "he didn't know". The front seat passenger was identified verbally as Nikki Barnes W/F D.O.B 02/02/1996. Based on my prior training and experience, I could smell the odor of alcohol and burnt marijuana smell emitting from Todd's person. Todd's speech was slurred and his eyes were glassy shiny. I asked Todd if he had consumed any alcoholic beverage tonight and he stated "I had a few" Based on my past training and experience, I believed that Todd Charles Hautamaki was intoxicated. I then call DUI 11 who arrived on scene and conducted a DUI investigation.

## PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On Wednesday, April 8, 2020 at approximately 01:53 hours, I responded to a traffic stop involving a possible impaired driver, located at the intersection of State Road 80 and Seminole Pratt Whitney Road in unincorporated Palm Beach County. Upon my arrival, I observed a black Dodge Charger bearing Florida tag "KFB U14" and several Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) patrol vehicles parked directly behind with their emergency lights activated. I exited my patrol car and met with Sergeant Nandlal #8483 who told me the following, "while conducting regular patrol, I was stopped at a solid red light at the intersection of Seminole Pratt Whitney and State Road 80, getting ready to turn eastbound onto State Road 80. Once the light turned green, Next to me in the number 1 lane, I observed a black Dodge Charger slowly began making a left turn on the red light and began to drive eastbound on State Road 80. In my marked PBSO vehicle, I activated my emergency lights and conducted a traffic stop on said vehicle. I made contact with the driver of the vehicle identified by his Florida driver's license as Todd Charles Hautamaki, D.O.B 11/05/1992. I asked Todd if there was a reason he did not wait for the light to turn green. He replied by saying "he didn't know". The front seat passenger was identified verbally as Nikki Barnes W/F DOB 02/02/1998. Based on my prior training and experience, I could smell the odor of alcohol and burnt marijuana smell emitting from Todd's person. Todd's speech was slurred and his eyes were glassy shiny. I asked Todd if he had consumed any alcoholic beverages tonight and he stated "I had a few." I believed that Todd Charles Hautamaki was intoxicated so I requested a DUI investigator. (Refer to supplement P.C)

## OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I observed the driver was still seated in the vehicle and was wearing black shorts, black shirt, along with white socks and blue shoes. While speaking to the driver I positively identified him as Todd Charles Hautamaki by his valid Florida driver's license. I asked Hautamaki if he was aware why he was being stopped and he answered "yes." He explained to me that he ran a red light and that was why he was stopped. I observed Hautamaki's eyes appeared red and glossy. I observed that he was slurring his words. Hautamaki was explained, that Sergeant Nandlal was under the suspicion that he may have consumed an unspecified amount of an unknown alcoholic beverage and also smoked an unspecified amount of marijuana which may have impaired his ability to operate a vehicle safely. I explained to Hautamaki that I could smell a strong odor of unknown alcoholic beverage and later explained I also detected a strong odor of marijuana based on my training and experience. I asked Hautamaki to exit the vehicle to perform standardized field sobriety tasks which he agreed to.

## DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

I asked Hautamaki if he had been drinking or used any drugs. Hautamaki stated he drank a few Mikes Hard Lemonade and smoked marijuana. I asked Hautamaki if he had any medical problems and/or previous injuries and he stated he had two rods installed in his lower back. I asked Hautamaki if he wore any glasses or contacts to correct his vision. Hautamaki answered "no." I asked Hautamaki if he takes any medications? He answered "yes, I take Klonopin."

Obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage

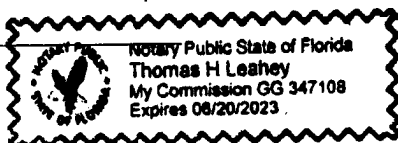

**HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS:**

- LT EYE-LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT
- RT EYE-LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT

**Other Observations:**

HGN: I continued my investigation. I instructed Hautamaki to keep his hands by his side, stand with his feet together, and follow a blue light stimulus with his eyes not turning his head. I asked him if he understood my instructions. Once Hautamaki verbally stated he understood my instructions, the task began. Hautamaki swayed while standing stationary. I observed both eyes to be red, bloodshot, and glossy. His left and right eye displayed equal pupil size, equal tracking, and a lack of smooth pursuit. I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus was present in both his left and right eye at maximum deviation during two separate four second evaluations. While conducting the task, I had to remind him to keep hands by his side, not turn his head and follow the stimulus multiple times.

**WALK & TURN:**

I positioned Hautamaki on a yellow line created using yellow duct tape, which was on a smooth and level surface, free of any debris and well lit by the headlights on my vehicle. I instructed Hautamaki to place his left foot on the line and his right foot in front of the left touching heel to toe. I instructed him that he was to keep his hands at his side and stay in this position until I instructed him to do otherwise. Once placed into the instructed position, I explained and demonstrated the rest of the task. During the task, I observed Hautamaki swayed while balancing, started too soon, stopped walking to steady self, did not touch heel to toe, stepped off the line twice. Used arms to maintain balance (+6"), did not turn properly(loses balance while turning(staggers or stumbles, turns other way than I explained.) Incorrect number of steps.

**ONE LEG STAND:**

I placed Hautamaki with his feet together and arms at his side. Once Hautamaki was placed into the instructed position, I explained and demonstrated the rest of the task. Once Hautamaki stated he understood, the task was performed. During the task, I observed, Hautamaki could not maintain the instructed position, he started too soon and swayed while standing stationary. While raising his foot he swayed while balancing, hopped, put foot down twice within 30 seconds. .

**FINGER TO NOSE:**

I instructed Hautamaki to stand with his feet together, make each hand into a fist keeping, extended his index fingers and to place his palms facing up. He was instructed to lower his arms by his side. I instructed and demonstrated the proper hand and arm position and for him to remain in this position while I demonstrated the rest of the task. I instructed and demonstrated him to tilt his head back approximately 45 degrees and close his eyes while waiting for a verbal command of left or right. On the command of "left" or "right", he would raise the requested hand, touch the tip of his finger to the tip of his nose, then bring his hand immediately back down to his side. During the instruction and demonstration of the task he swayed heavily while standing in the instructional position. I asked him if he understood the instructions I provided and he verbally stated he understood. I instructed him to start the task as explained. During the task, I observed the driver did not keep eyes closed, failed to return arms to side, correct finger did not touch tip of nose, used wrong hand.

**ROMBERG ALPHABET:**

I verbally inquired if Hautamaki could recite the entire English alphabet. He answered "yes", I instructed him that upon starting he was to tilt his head back approximately 45 degrees and close his eyes. He would begin to state the alphabet in a slow and methodical manner without singing or rhyming it. I asked him if he understood the instructions and he verbally replied he understood. During the instructions he continued to sway while standing stationary. I instructed Hautamaki to start the task as explained. During the task, I observed Hautamaki did not keep eyes closed, swayed more than (+2") from side to side, from front to back, used arms for balancing, did not touch tip of nose. Did not count right. Missed several letters, refer to in car camera.

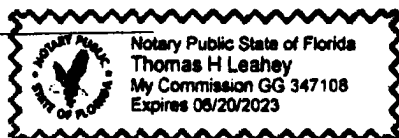

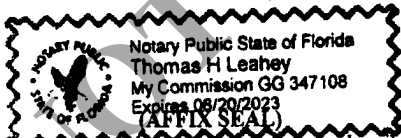
